


MODEL H6021 CONTROLS



- **A. INPUT**: Connect your guitar here, using a shielded instrument cable with a ½" jack.
- B. DRIVE SWITCH: Turns the Drive Channel ON and OFF.
- **C. MASTER VOLUME**: This knob controls the overall volume of the amplifier.
- D. 2 BAND EQUALIZATION: The main equalization of the Model H6021 is a classic 2-band passive network.
- **E. HEADPHONE OUTPUT**: For connection to almost any headphone with a ¼" jack.
- **F. POWER SWITCH:** This switch turns the power *ON* and *OFF*.
- **G. POWER LIGHT**: The power light illuminates when the power is *ON*.

Caring For Your Amplifier

- DO NOT remove the grounding prong to fit the plug into a two-pronged outlet!
- To keep the amplifier working properly, DO NOT expose it to rain or moisture.
- DO NOT pull or lift the amplifier by the power cord.
- UNPLUG the amplifier before cleaning, and only clean with a damp cloth (no chemicals).



SHOCK HAZARD! The amplifier must have a ground prong in the plug to help ensure that it is grounded. DO NOT remove this prong to fit the plug into a two-pronged outlet!
