


- Display must have a minimum of 369 lbs. (163.3 kg) of added ballast located as shown in instructions to keep pole assembly upright.

- Adjust leveling bolts to ensure a level display surface.
- If technical assistance is required, contact Huffy Sports' Sample and Display Technician.
- Minimum operational height is 6'6" (2 m) to the bottom of backboard.
