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
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OPERATION

BASIC FUNCTION

THE DISPLAY On-Hook Status:




Installing (or Replacing) the Battery

Use screwdriver to remove the screw in the battery compartment cover on the bottom of the base unit.

IMPORTANT — before removing the battery compartment cover, always make sure the base unit is disconnected from the telephone line.

* Install 3 Alkaline AAA batteries into the battery compartment and re-fit the cover before use.

Warning : The unit will not work without batteries fitted.



Connection and conditions for use

You can connect your D33, to public networks in the UK; or to an approved PBX using DTMF signalling. Each item of telephone equipment (phones, fax machines, etc.) has a **ringer equivalence numbers (REN).** The RENs of all equipment connected to an exchange line **must not add up to more than 4** otherwise, one or more phones may not ring and/or answer calls correctly.

D33 has a REN of 1, and most other telephones have a REN of 1 unless marked otherwise.

Note :

Subscription to the Caller ID Service is required for the phone to display the callers number. Please contact your line Provider. If you do not subscribe to Caller ID, the Caller Display will not work but the phone will work.

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MAKING AND ANSWERING CALLS

To make a call

- 1 Lift the handset or press A and wait for Dial tone
- 2 Dial the telephone number using the keypad

LAST NUMBER REDIAL

- 1 Lift up the handset or press (1) to get a dial tone
- Press the LNR button CALL BACK / PAUSE 2

SECRECY

While you are on a call, to mute the mouthpiece so that your voice cannot be heard.

1 Press and hold

USE ON A PBX

If you are using your D33 on a PBX, and the PBX User Gulde tells you to press RECALL, press the on your D33.

When making calls on some PBXS, you need to wait for a second Dial tone after dialling the outside line access digit (e.g."9"). If your PBX is of this type, you can use the "Pause function" when making calls, so that last Number Redial will work later.

TO MAKE A LNR CALL ON A PBX :

- 1. Key in the outside line access digit then press CALL BACK/PAUSE
- 2. Dial the telephone number.
- 3. Now you can redial (Lift handset & Press CALL BACK/PAUSE) and the phone will dial 9, Pause and then dial the number.

PHONE BOOK

* Phone book can store 20 numbers (up to 16 digits) and 20 names (up to 16 characters).

ADD NUMBER AND NAME TO THE PHONE BOOK

- 1. Press CTORE
- 2. Press > or < to go to the last entry
- 3. Press
- 4. LCD will display a flashing '_'
- 5. Input the number
- 6. Press $\stackrel{\text{ENTER}}{\bigcirc}$ to confirm
- 7. LCD will display a flashing '_' under the number
- 8. Input the name through numerical button with letters
- 9. Press to confirm
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DELETE NUMBER AND NAME FROM THE PHONE BOOK

- 1. Press STORE
- Press or to find the number you want to delete
 Press or 1 second
- 4. LCD will display '-EMPTY-' when there is no number

MODIFY NUMBER AND NAME FROM THE PHONE BOOK

- 1. Press
- 2. Press) or (to find the number and name you want to modify
- 3. Press
- 4. The last digit of the number will be flashing
- 5. Press 4 to modify the flashing number or press DELETE to delete flashing number or press the number key you wish to add
- 6. Press to confirm
- 7. The last letter of the name will be flashing
- Press to confirm
 Press to confirm

DIALLING FROM PHONE BOOK

- 1. Under On-Hook status, press STORE, the phone book reviewing status has been entered
- 2. Press) or 4 to find the number you want to dial out. The LCD will display the number and name
- 3. Press CALL BACK/PAUSE and the number will be dialled

COPY NUMBER FROM CALL LOG TO THE PHONE BOOK

- 1. Press) or (to select the number you wish to copy to the phonebook
- 2. Press CTORE
- 3. LCD will display "COPY TO ?"
- 4. Press "0 9" to store the number to the memory

You must contact your line provider and subscribe to Caller Display with them before the Caller ID function on this phone will work.

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OUTGOING CALLS LOG

REVIEW DIALLED NUMBERS

- 1. Under On-Hook status
- 2. Press
- 3. Press) or (to review the dialled numbers and the conversation time
- 4. LCD will display '-EMPTY-' when there is no number in the memory

Remark: No.1 is the last number dialled out and No.30 is the oldest number dialled out.

TO DELETE OUTGOING CALL

- 1. Press CHECK
- 2. Press > or < to find the number you want to delete
- 3. Press DELETE for 1 second
- 4. LCD will display '-EMPTY-' when there is no number

TO DIAL FROM OUTGOING CALL LOG

- 1. Press $\stackrel{\text{CHECK}}{\longrightarrow}$ and use the \blacktriangleright or \blacktriangleleft to select dialled number
- Press CALL BACK / PAUSE, the number will be dialled.
 Press CALL BACK / PAUSE again if the dialling is not successful UNP

COPY A DIALLED NUMBER TO PHONE BOOK

- 1. Press $\stackrel{\text{CHECK}}{\longrightarrow}$ and select number you want to copy by pressing **>** or **<** key
- 2. Press CTORE
- 3. LCD will display "COPY TO ?"
- 4. Press 0-9 to store the number to the memory

The display contrast is set too high and you can no longer see the Menu selections on the display. Please follow these key presses. - Press and release the \bigcirc^{ENTER} button twice - Press and release the $\bigcirc^{\text{PGM/ESC}}$ button. - Press and release the button - Press and release the 4 arrow button until the desired contrast is displayed and then press and release the button.

2. Display Is Blank:

The display contrast may be set too low so that you can no longer see the menu selections in the display. Please follow these key presses. - Press and release the button twice - Press and release the PGMESC button. - Press and release the button - Press and release the arrow button until the desired contrast is displayed and then press and release the $\stackrel{\rm ENTER}{\bigcirc}$ button.

CLI LOG (INCOMING CALLS LOG)

This phone can store up to 199 incoming numbers with time which can be reviewed, restored to Phone book and dialled out.

REVIEWING INCOMING CALLS

- 1. Under On-Hook status
- 2. Press) or (, enter into reviewing status
- 3. LCD will display '-ND CRLL-' when there is no message
- 4. When reviewing to the first or last number, the LCD will display '-END OF LIST-''



DELETING NUMBER FROM CALLER ID LOG

- 1. Select number by pressing \blacktriangleright or \blacktriangleleft key
- Press and hold DELETE for 1 second, the number will be deleted. The LCD display will show the next number and the total of calls will decrease
- 3. Press and hold of a seconds, all the numbers will be deleted

DIALLING FROM CALLER ID LOG

- 1. Press) or (to find the entry you want to dial.
- 2. Press $C_{\text{LNB}}^{\text{CALL BACK/PAUSE}}$ or $C_{\text{LNB}}^{\text{ENTER}}$, and the number will be dialled.
- 3. If the dialling is not successful, press CALL BACK / PAUSE to try again

MEMORY FULL

When the called ID log is full, the next incoming number will overwrite the most recent incoming number. The LCD display will display "-"E"DR9 FULL-" until you delete the numbers in the caller ID log.



LOW BATTERY INDICATOR FUNCTION

When the battery is low, the LCD will display the low battery symbol.

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SYSTEM MENU

- 1. Under On-Hook status
- 2. Press Conter into the menu
- 3. Press) or (to select one of the functions below that you wish to change and then press ENTER.

- SET LCD CONTRAST

- 1. Press > or < to adjust the LCD contrast from 1 to 8
- 2. Press PGMESC or to set and exit menu

Please note, if the display is faint, try adjusting the contrast as explained above.

SET OFF TIME - To limit Call Duration

- 1. Press I to set off time from 00 minute to 99 minutes
- 2. If you use this function we suggest you set it to more than 5 minutes. "Emergency calls are also affected by this function."
- 3. Press or to set exit menu

- SET DATE AND TIME

- 1. Press I to modify the flashing number
- 2. Press b to change the flashing digit
- 3. Press $\stackrel{\text{PGM/ESC}}{\longrightarrow}$ or $\stackrel{\text{ENTER}}{\longrightarrow}$ to set and exit menu

– SET AREA CODE

Set this to your local area code. When you receive a local call, your Caller ID will log the full number including the area code. When phoning back from the Caller ID log, the local area code will not be dialled.

- 1. Input the area code
- 2. Press

LONG PREFIX

Not used.

BROWSE DIALLED NUMBERS

Allows you to view and dial previously dialled numbers.

- 1. Press) or (key to select the "number"
- 2. Press \blacktriangleright or \blacktriangleleft key to browse the number and press $\stackrel{\text{ENTER}}{\longrightarrow}$ which ever dialling out and press $\stackrel{\text{DELETE}}{\longrightarrow}$

key can delete the number

SET DISPLAY LANGUAGE

- 2. Press Or or to set and exit menu

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■ While the unit is under Guarantee
