Remaining time indication

The length of time the programme has left to run will be clearly displayed in the text window, leaving you in no doubt as to when the programme will end and you can go out.

Overflow protection

Your dishwasher has an overfill protection program which could automatically shut off the inlet valve and start the drain pump if the water Overflow.



Intelligent Control System

The intelligent control system could be adaptive to different conditions, such as temperature and voltage, then correct the remaining time automatically.

Memory Function

Rinse Aid Warning Indicator


If the rinse aid are running low, there will be clearly displayed on the panel alerting you to top them up, to ensure that the machine continues to operate at optimum performance.

7 Wash Programs

You can ct.oose desired program according to the soiled It vel. Such as, intensive wash, normal wash, econ amy, rinse, glass, rapid and pre-wash etc, than you can change temperature of wash.



Do not abuse, sit on, or stand on the door or dish rack of the dishwasher.

Do not touch the heating element during or immediately after use.

Do not wash plastic items unless they are marked dishwasher safe or the equivalent. For plastic items not so marked, check the manufactures recommendations.

Use only detergent and r nse additives designed for an automatic dishwasher. Never use soap, laundry detergent, or hand washing detergent in your dishwasher. Keep these products out of children

Keep child away from detergent and rinse aid, keep

there could still be some detergent left inside.

The door should not be left in the open position since this could present a tripping hazards.

During installation, the power supply must not be excessively or dangerously bent or flattened.

To reduce the risk os injure, do not allow children to play in or on a dishwasher.

Do not operate your dishwasher unless all enclosure panels are properly inplace. Open the door very carefully if the dishwasher is operating, there is a risk of water squirting out.

Do not place any heavy objects of stand on the door when it is open. The appliance could tip forward.

When loading items to be washed:

- 1) Locate sharp items so that they are not likely to damage the door seal;
- 2) Load sharp knives with the handles up to reduce the risk of cut-type injuries.

When using your dishwasher, you should prevent plastic item from contacting with heating element.

If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or its service agent or a similarly qualified person in order to avoid a hazard.

Please dispose of packing materials properly.

Use the dishwasher only for its intended function.

Remove the door to the washing compartment when removing an old dishwasher from service or discarding it.

Do not tamper with controls.





NOTE: If you open the door when washing, the machine will delay start for several seconds, which will make the dishwasher work much better.








Filling the Dispenser

The rinse agent dispenser holds 3.5 oz. of rinse agent. Under normal conditions, this will last approximately one month. Try to keep it full, but do not overfill.


- Make sure the dishwasher door is fully open.
- Turn the dispenser knob to the left and lift it out.
- Add rinse agent until the indicator window looks full.
- Clean up any spilled rinse agent with a damp cloth.
- Replace the dispenser knob.

Rinse Aid Setting

The amount of rinse agent released into the final wash can be adjusted. The factory setting is at the midpoint. If there are rings of calcium (hard water) snots on dishes, try a higher setting.

To adjust the setting

Remove the dispenser knob; then turn the adjuster counterclockwise to increase the amount of rinse agent.





User-Maintenance Instructions Cleaning the Filters



Filter assembly

For best performance and results, the filter assembly must be cleaned.

The filter efficiently removes food particles from the wash water, allowing it to be recirculated during the cycle. For this reason, it is a good idea to remove the larger food particles trapped in the filter after each wash cycle by rinsing the semicircular filter and cup under running water. To remove the filter assembly, pull on the cup handle in the upward direction. The entire filter assembly should be cleaned at least once a month

To clean the coarse filter and the fine filter, use a cleaning brush. Then, reassemble the filter parts as shown in the figures left and reinsert the entire assembly in the dishwasher, positioning in its seat and pressing downward.

The dishwasher must never be used without the filters. Improper replacement of the filter may reduce the performance level of the appliance and damage dishes and utensils.

▲ WARNING!

Never run the dishwasher without the filters in place.
