Quick Start Guide

1 Insert the battery.

2 **Attach the lens.**
Align the lens' white or red index with the camera's index in the matching color.

3 **Set the lens focus mode switch to <AF>.**

4 **Open the cover and insert a SD card.**

5 **Set the power switch to <ON>, and while holding down the button at the center of the Mode Dial, turn the dial to <□> (Full Auto).**

6 **Flip out the LCD monitor.**

7 **Focus the subject.**
Aim the viewfinder center over the subject and press the shutter button halfway to autofocus.

8 **Take the picture.**
Press the shutter button completely to take the picture.

9 **View the image.**
The captured image will be displayed for about 2 sec. on the LCD monitor.

The ☆ on the right of the function indicates that the function is available only in Creative Zone modes (P, Tv, Av, M, B, C).

- Press the <MENU> button to display the menu.
- Press the <◀▶> key to select the tab, then press the <▲▼> key to select the desired item.
- Press <SET> to display the setting.
- After setting the item, press <SET>.

Image-recording Quality

- Select [Q] **Quality**.
- Select the image-recording quality with the <◀▶> dial or <◀▶> key.

Image-recording quality

Quality: RAW (18M 5184x3456 [514])

RAW: Turn the <◀▶> dial to select the quality.

JPEG: Press the <◀▶> key to select the quality.

Picture Style

- Select [Q] **Picture Style**.
- Press the <▲▼> key to select the Picture Style, then press <SET>.

Style	Description
Standard	Vivid colors and sharp images.
Portrait	Nice skin tones and slightly sharp images.
Landscape	Vivid blue skies and greenery and very sharp images.
Monochrome	Black-and-white images.

- For <Neutral> and <Faithful>, see the camera's instruction manual.

- The Quick Control screen will appear.

- Press the <▲▼> <◀▶> key to select the function, then turn the <◀▶> or <◉> dial to set it.
- In Basic Zone modes, the selectable functions may differ depending on the Basic Zone shooting mode.

- Each time you press the <INFO.> button, the screen display will change.
- Display the electronic level.

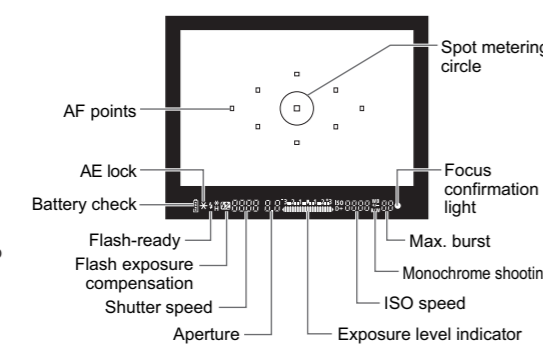

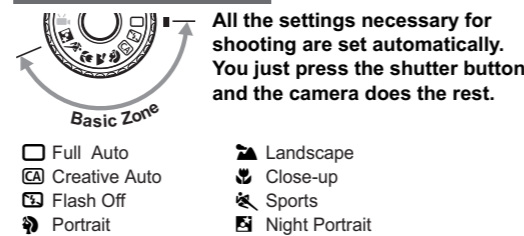

Basic Zone Modes

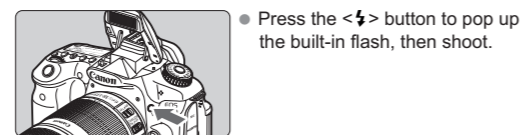


- Pressing the <Q> button will display the Quick Control screen. In the [CA]/[P]/[L]/[C]/[S]/[N] shooting mode, press the <▲> key to select the function, then press the <◀> key to set it as desired.

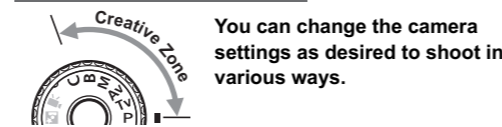
Using the Built-in Flash

Basic Zone Modes
If necessary, the built-in flash will pop-up automatically in low-light or backlit conditions (except in the [S], [L], [C], [S], [N] modes).

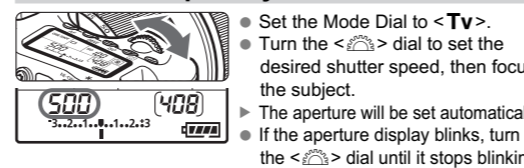


P: Program AE

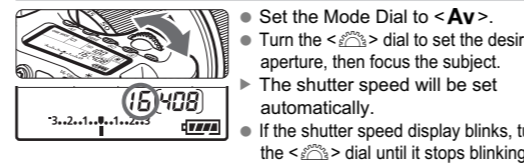
The camera automatically sets the shutter speed and aperture in the same way as the [Q] mode.

- Set the Mode Dial to <P>.

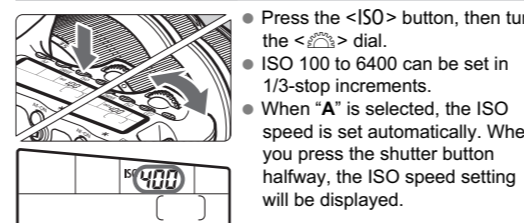
Tv: Shutter-priority AE



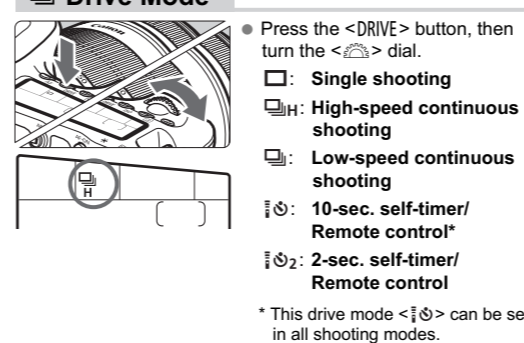
Av: Aperture-priority AE



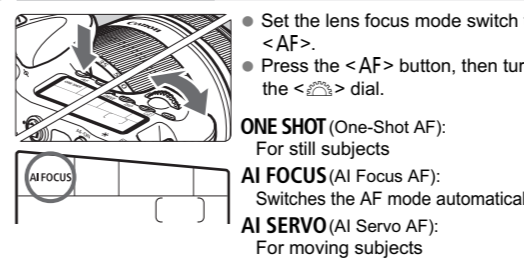

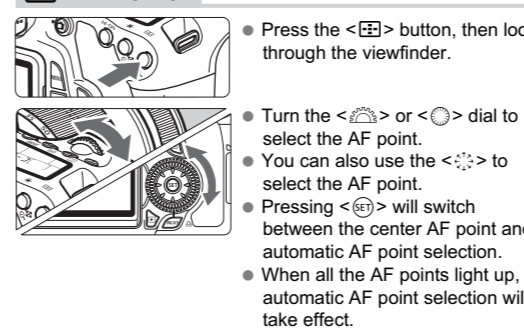

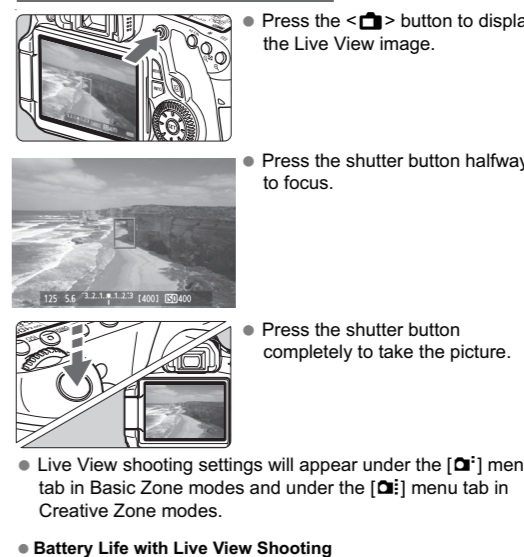
