# INSTALLATION & ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: The velke sulky must be installed correctly for best performance. Follow carefully starting at STEP 1.

### STEP 2

In most cases the handlebars will need to be raised as high as they will go for comfort. If your mower's handlebars are supported by threaded rods, use the extra length to raise them higher. Many mowers have hidden holes for the adjustment of the top section of the handlebars. Use the highest setting. You may need to readjust the control linkages of the mower after changing handlebar height.

## STEP 4


Transport chain: (note: changing handlebar position after setting chain length prevents proper operation.)
Attach the chain somewhere centered to the mower and when possible toward the rear of the dash panel. See the examples shown below. If you need to drill, be careful not to damage hidden parts.(5/16" hole)
Attach the hook so that the Velke hangs up as high as possible using the more compact method with just enough slack for unhooking it. Cut off excess chain.

### STEP 3

The preferred method for folding the X2 up under the handlebars is shown at right. This method is used to lock the Velke in a more compact position to prevent it from swinging wildly.

TO FOLD COMPACTLY:
Lift the platform and rotate it on

its rearmost pivot until the left wheel reaches the 2 o'clock position (see arrow 1). Next rotate the platform on the middle pivot (see arrow 2) until the v-notch engages with the arm. Now rotate the X2 up the rest of the way (arrow 3).

STEP 1

Some Velke models are available with a 15" or 18" forward arm. See reverse if you are unsure of your purchase. Do not remove the polyurethane protective tape that is on the forward arm. It will protect the paint when folded up. Attach the arm assembly to the platform with a washer against each bronze bushing and install the cotter pin. Bend both ends of both cotter pins. Install each wheel with the washer under the linch pin. Attach the hitch (and adapter plate if needed) to the rear face of the mower (never on top face) with the center of the hitch pin at 11 1/2 inches from the ground using existing bolt holes or vise grips if you need to drill holes. Hitch can be turned over giving more increments for height. See "MORE HELP" on reverse for unusual applications. If you need to drill holes, make sure you don't damage parts behind drilling surface. Mark with center punch, drill 3/8" holes. Face bolts out when needed to avoid contact with pulleys, belts, etc. Tighten all bolts. Attach the Velke to the hitch with the hitch pin always installed from the right. This allows the pin to turn on the bushings only.






The Velke will work on most any walk—behind mower if attached correctly. You may have to do a little more work than usual if your mower is like one of these shown.


Note: Correct hitch height must be obtained for the Yelke to work correctly. See "HITCH HEIGHT' below.

















#### THE ARM QUESTIONS

Q: What arm is recommended for my mower?

A: Some mower Makes are known to nearly always take the same Yelke arm no matter what model or year the walkbehind is.


Example: All Scage take the 18"
All Toros take the 15"
All Gravelys take a 15"

Rarely does anyone prefer the other size arm for those mowers.


Some mower Makes often take a particular size arm based on the model, year, or type (hydro, gear drive, loop handle, pistal grip, etc.) Also if custom spacers are needed behind the hitch in order to fold the Velke up and to obtain the correct hitch height. Your equipment dealer can often give you the best advice as to which arm is usually preferred for your mower.


Many times a mower could use either size arm equally well and would be chosen by personal preference. Keep in mind that the handlebar position if changed can make a difference in your choice (highest handlebar setting is recommended in most cases).

- Q: What do I do If I install the Velke to try It and decide that the other size arm would be better?
- A: First ask your dealer what they will do for an exchange.
  You may exchange the arm with us for a new arm of the other size if it is clean, unsoratched, unused and in saleable condition.
  Slightly used or scratched arms can be exchanged for equal (or slightly lesser) quality if it is available. Call first!




- Q: Why would I use the 18" arm?
- A: The 18" arm may be desired if the 15" arm causes you to get jabbed by the handlebars as you turn or if the X2 wheels come in contact with the back end of the mower while it turns for backing. You may only need to space the hitch out 1/2" or mon to use the 15" arm on mowers with the lower back end as low as 7 inches from the ground(See above).





- Q: Why would I use the 15" arm?
- A: The 15" arm may be desired if the 18" arm causes you to lean forward to reach the handlebars as with the mower shown below.




#### HITCH HEIGHT

The hitch height determines the angle of the foot platform and the reaction it has when it rotates to 180 degrees for a quicker and more manuverable reverse.


If the hitch is mounted too high, the Velke is likely to be run over by the mower when backing up over uneven ground.

If the hitch is mounted too low, the rear of the platform will hit the ground and may act as a plow when going forward again.

The recommended height from the hitch pin to the ground for all movers is 11 1/2 inches.












Optional SHORT 15" arm

# **VELKE SAFETY WARNINGS**

- Do not use the Velke Sulky until you are completely familiar with the operation of the particular mower that it is attached to. We recommend at least one month experience walking behind the mower before riding.
- 2. Make sure all safety equipment provided with the mower is in operating order. This includes operator presence devices that will shut the mower off in case you let go of the handles.
- 3. Wear thick-soled, high-top leather work boots. No bare feet!
- 4. Do not attempt to operate the mower in reverse gear while standing on the Velke sulky.
- 5. Operate the mower at slower speeds until you become familiar with how the Velke sulky handles. It won't be long before it becomes natural. Some users compare it to skiing.
- 6. Do not operate the mower faster than you could walk comfortably. Speeding is dangerous even when trotting (or running) behind a mower. Sudden stops from excessive speed may cause serious injury. The Velke will make you more efficient by just maintaining a healthy pace through the day without speeding.
- 7. Never use any mower near and by-standers in case you lose control or objects are thrown from the mower.
- 8. Do not allow inexperienced people to use the Velke until they have read and understand this sheet, and have significant experience walking behind a commercial/industrial mower.
- 9. Do not use the Velke sulky if any parts become loose. Examine the moving parts each time you use it. Look for loose or missing bolts, cotter or hair pins and replace immediately.
