



Getting Your Multifunction Back On Your Network After A Router Or Network Change

PIXMA MX432 Windows and Mac OS



If any of the following situations exist

- You have replaced your Router or Access Point
- You want to use a different wireless network
- Router settings have been changed.

Please complete the following steps to apply the new configuration settings to your multifunction.

Preparing to Connect My Multifunction To My Network

Network Requirements

Before connecting the machine to the network, make sure that configuration of the computer and access point or router is complete, and that the computer is connected to the network.



Wireless Connection

Before connecting the machine to the network, the computer needs to be connected to the network. Make sure that configuration of the computer and access point or router is complete.

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Connect the PIXMA MX432 to Your Wireless Network

To re-establish communication on the network after changing the router / Access Point or when connecting to a different network, the settings on the Multifunction need to be changed

Simply insert the Setup CD-ROM that came with your printer into your CD-ROM drive and proceed through the easy to follow instructions On the following screen, select the Start Setup Again option

Change Connection Method

Change the connection method between the printer and computer from USB to LAN or from LAN to USB.

Add Software

Select software to add or reinstall it.

Start Setup Again

Start again from the initial installation to connection.

Connecting to the Network



On the Connection Method Selection screen, be sure to select Wireless Connection



When the Printer Setup screen appears, click **Next**. You will be setting up the printer the same way as a first-time setup.



This section describes how to setup the printer on the **network** for the first time.

Follow the instructions until the Completion of Connection screen. It is not necessary to re-install the software. Click Next on the Completion of Connection screen, then click Back, then Exit. Setup is now finished

4)-7 Completion of Connection

The **network** connection setup is now complete. Click "Next", then wait until the next screen appears.

Connecting to the Network



If you can't find your CD-ROM, you may download the MX430 series Mini Master Setup, which includes the same step-by-step installation as the CD-ROM, by following the instructions below:

- 1. Click here to access the MX432 Drivers & Software page.
- 2. Select the operating system and version of your computer (see example below).
- 3. Expand the 'Drivers' section, if necessary, by clicking the red triangle.
- 4. Click on the 'MX430 series Mini Master Setup' entry
- 5. After reading the details and disclaimer, click 'I Agree Begin Download' and save the file to your computer.
- 6. Once the download is complete, double-click the file from its download location to begin the installation.
