
∧CAUTION




Auto lock functions

Automatic door locks can be programmed to operate in 3 different modes, or turned OFF.

- -Doors lock when shifting from Park.*
- -Doors unlock when shifting into Park.*
- -Doors unlock when the ignition switch is turned from ON to ACC or LOCK and driver's door is opened.
- * Automatic transmission only

"S" (Sequential) mode


Push shift lever to the left from "D" position.

"S" position:

- +: Upshift (Push and release)
- -: Downshift (Pull and release)

Downshifting increases power going uphill, or provides engine braking downhill. For best fuel economy during normal driving conditions, always drive with the shift lever in the "D" position.

- Push and hold the switch on the "OPEN" side until the convertible top is completely lowered.



Window operation


Automatic operation (Driver side only) Push the switch completely down or pull it completely up and release to fully open or close*. To stop window midway, lightly push the switch in the opposite direction.


Window lock switch Deactivates all passenger windows. Driver's window remains operable.




Seat belts




If belt is fully extended, then retracted even slightly, it cannot be re-extended beyond that point, unless fully retracted again. This feature is used to help hold child restraint systems securely.




Tire Pressure Warning System reset




If tire pressure becomes low on any of the tires (including spare/excluding compact spare), indicator comes on. Pushing reset button should not turn off the light. Correctly adjusting tire inflation will turn off the light after a few minutes. Push and hold reset button until the indicator light blinks 3 times, after replacing tire or wheels.

Removing the spare tire



- 1 Loosen and remove the nut.
- 2 Remove the spare tire cover.
- 3 Loosen and remove the bolt.
- 4 Remove the spacer.
