The One For All® 4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning remote control is our latest-generation universal remote control, designed specifically for controlling video components.


Its sophisticated technology will allow you to finally consolidate the clutter of the original remote controls in your home entertainment system. Moreover, it's packed with easy-to-use features such as:

- Preprogrammed technology for easy setup of video components in your home entertainment system
- Preprogrammable Master Power key for master on/off control of all of your equipment with a single keystroke
- A unique Video Configuration key that allow you to access home theater keys from various modes without changing device modes
- Keymover for mapping (copying) keys from one mode to another
- Menu function to navigate and choose on-screen menu items for a selected component
- Learning capability to store and recall additional remote control functions.
- Color-coded keys to quickly locate popular functions
- · Code library for video components
- Code Search to help program control of older or discontinued components

Before using your new remote control, you will need to program it to operate the specific home entertainment components you wish to control. Please follow the instructions detailed in this manual and then enjoy your new One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus Plus With Learning remote control.

| POWER          | Press POWER once to turn on (or off) a selected home entertainment component.  |
| (N) (MS) (MS)  | Press TV, DVD, VCR, or CBL/SAT once to select a home entertainment video component to control.   |
|                | Use the learning keys, L1, L2, L3, or L4, to store and recall additional remote control functions. Also see page 30.                                       |
| EHT            | Use EXIT to exit out of your cable converter's menu and guide.   |
| MENU           | Press MENU once to display the selected component's screen menu. Use the VOL +/- and CH +/- keys to navigate menus and press the MUTE key to select items. |
| Trino          | Press TV/VID to switch viewing between TV and video sources.   |
| VOL VOL +      | Use VOL + (or VOL -) to raise (or lower) the sound volume.   |
| CH+            | Use CH + (or CH -) to select the next higher (or lower) channel.   |
| MUTE<br>SELECT | Press MUTE/SELECT once to turn sound off or on. Also, use MUTE/SELECT to select items from the selected component's screen menu after pressing MENU once.  |

#### FEATURES AND FUNCTIONS

#### **Key Charts (Continued)**

Press PIP once to view or turn off the picture-in-picture feature.



Press SWAP once to exchange the PIP with the main TV picture.



Use MOVE to the picture-in-picture position on the TV screen.



Press SLEEP once to enable (or disable) a selected component's sleep timer (if available).



Use DISPLAY to view a selected component's information on the TV.

 Use the keypad  $(0 \sim 9)$  to directly select channels (e.g., 09 or 31).

ENTER

Press ENTER once after entering channel numbers on some TV models.

PREV.CH

Press PREV.CH once to recall the last-viewed channel.




Use V.CONFIG to custom program and recall video configuration modes for home theater use. Also see page 32.



In the TV, DVD, or VCR mode, use the FWD SCAN, REW SCAN, PLAY, STOP, and PAUSE keys to control your VCR or DVD (or LD) player. To record a program on, the VCR, press REC twice.

#### **INSTALLING BATTERIES**



- 1. On the back of the remote control, press the recess and slide the battery cover off (see above).
- 2. Obtain two (2) fully-charged AA alkaline batteries. Match the + and - marks on the batteries to the + and - marks in the battery case, then insert the new batteries.
- 3. Align the cover keys with the case openings and slide the cover on until it locks.

Test the unit by pressing POWER and any mode key (e.g. TV, DVD, VCR, or CBL/SAT). If batteries are inserted correctly, the LED will blink once.

NOTE: When batteries need replacement, the One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus remote control will cease to operate. Simply replace the batteries and the unit will be restored to its full functionality, complete with your favorite settings.

- 1. Turn on the TV.
- 2. On the remote control, press TV once. Press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.

NOTE: The remote control will exit programming if more than 10 seconds elapse between key presses.

 Enter the first four-digit code for your TV. If you perform this procedure correctly, the LED will blink twice.

NOTE: If the LED emits a long blink, the code is invalid. Repeat steps 2 through 3 and try entering the same code again.

4. POWER

Aim the remote control at your TV and press POWER once. The TV should turn off. If it does not respond, repeat steps 2-3, trying each code for your brand until you find one that works. If it still does not work, try searching for the code (see Searching For Your Code on page 23).

#### SEARCHING FOR YOUR CODE

If your video component does not respond to the One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning remote control after trying all of the codes listed for your brand, or if your brand is not listed at all, try searching for your code.

For example, to search for a code for your TV:

- 1. Turn on your TV. Set it to the TV mode.
- 2. (set) On the remote control, press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 3. Fig. Enter 9 9 1. The LED will blink twice.
- 4. POWER Aim the remote control at the the TV and slowly alternate between pressing POWER and TV.
  - Štop when the TV turns off.

NOTE: In the search mode, the One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning remote control will send IR codes from its library to the selected component, starting with the most popular code first.

- 5. (set) Press SET once to lock in the code.
- 6. To search for the codes of your other components, repeat steps 1 through 5, but substitute the appropriate key (i.e., DVD, VCR, or CBL/SAT) for the (DVD/LD, VCR, or Cable/Satellite) component you are searching for.

#### CHECKING THE CODES

If you have set up the One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning remote control using the *Searching For Your Code* procedure, you may need to find out which four-digit code is operating your equipment. For example, to find out which code is operating your TV:

- 1. Turn on your TV. Set it to the TV mode.
- 2. (st) On the remote control, press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 3. See Enter 9 9 0. The LED will blink twice.
- 4. Diview the code for the first digit, press 1 once. Count the number of LED blinks (e.g., 3 blinks = 3) and write down the number in the leftmost TV Code box below.

NOTE: If a code digit is "0", the LED will not blink.

- 5. Repeat step 4 three more times for remaining digits. Use 2 for the second digit, 3 for the third digit, and 4 for the fourth digit. Finish writing
  - down the code in the TV Code boxes below.
- 6. To check for the codes of your other components, repeat steps 1 through 5, but substitute the appropriate key (i.e., DVD, VCR, or CBL/SAT) for the (DVD/LD, VCR, or Cable/Satellite) component you are checking. Write down the codes in the appropriate boxes below.

# PROGRAMMING THE MASTER POWER KEY FOR ALL ON/OFF

With the One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning, you can program the M. POWER key to turn your TV, VCR, DVD (or LD), and Cable (or Satellite) components on and off with the press of one button.

- 1. (SET) On the remote control, press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 2. See Enter 9 9 5. The LED will blink twice.
- 3. M.POWER Press M.POWER once.
- 4. Enter the following sequence\*:
  - (TV) a. Press TV once.
  - vcr b. Press VCR once.
  - (DVD) c. Press DVD once.
  - d. Press CBL/SAT once.
- 5. (SET) Press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 6. Now, when you press M.POWER once, the remote control will direct power to your TV, VCR, DVD (or LD) player, and Cable/Satellite component and leave the remote control in the TV mode.
- \* NOTE: If you do not want all of your equipment to power up all of the time, you can shorten step 4 to include only those devices you want to turn on or off. For example, to just power up your TV and DVD (or LD) player, enter the following sequence for step 4:
  - a. Press TV once.
  - b. Press DVD once.

Now when you press M.POWER once, the One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus remote control will only direct power to your DVD (or LD) player and TV, and still leave the remote control in the TV mode.

#### **RE-ASSIGNING DEVICE KEYS**

The One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning remote control can be set up to control a second TV or VCR, or any combination of four video components. For example, to have the unit control a TV, a Cable Converter, and *two* VCRs, you will need to re-assign the unused DVD key to operate the second VCR as follows:

- 1.  $\bigcirc$  On the remote control, press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 2. See Enter 9 9 2. The LED will blink twice.
- 3. (VER) (WER) Press VCR once, then press DVD once. The LED will blink twice.
- 4. Program the DVD key as a second VCR. See *Programming VCR Control* on page 12.

To re-assign other device keys, repeat steps 1 through 4 by substituting the key sequence from the following chart for a desired component:

| DVD back to DVD:         | SET - 9 - 9 - 2 - DVD - DVD        |
| CBL/SAT as 2nd TV key:   | SET - 9 - 9 - 2 - TV - CBL/SAT     |
| CBL/SAT as 2nd DVD key:  | SET - 9 - 9 - 2 - DVD - CBL/SAT    |
| CBL/SAT as 2nd VCR key:  | SET - 9 - 9 - 2 - VCR - CBL/SAT    |
| CBL/SAT back to CBL/SAT: | SET - 9 - 9 - 2 - CBL/SAT- CBL/SAT |

Upon completion of a re-assignment, the LED will blink twice to confirm your selection. At that time, you will also need to program the remote control to control the new component (see previous sections on *Programming VCR Control*, or *Programming Cable Converter or Satellite Receiver Control*, or *Programming DVD Player Control*).

#### CHANGING VOLUME LOCK

The One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning remote control is preset to control the volume of a component through your TV.

If your TV is not remote controllable, or if you would like the volume to be controlled by a different component, you can change the Volume Lock setting to control a volume through a non-associated mode (e.g., through the *cable* in the TV mode).

#### To change Volume Lock to the CBL/SAT mode:

- 1. (SET) On the remote control, press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 2. Enter 9 9 3 and then press CBL/SAT once.

  The LED will blink twice.
- 3. Now, whenever you press VOL +, VOL -, or MUTE on the remote control, the volume will be controlled by your Cable Converter or Satellite Receiver.

#### To change Volume Lock to the VCR mode:

- 1. (st) On the remote control, press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 2. See Enter 9 9 3 and then press VCR once. (VCR) The LED will blink twice.
- 3. Now, whenever you press VOL +, VOL -, or MUTE on the remote control, volume will be controlled by your VCR.

#### To change Volume Lock to the DVD mode:

- 1. (st) On the remote control, press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 2. SEE Enter 9 9 3 and then press DVD once.
  - The LED will blink twice.
- Now, whenever you press VOL +, VOL -, or MUTE on the remote control, volume will be controlled by your DVD (or LD) player.

## CHANGING VOLUME LOCK (Continued)

To change Volume Lock back to the TV mode:

- 1. (SET) On the remote control, press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 2. See Enter 9 9 3 and then press TV once.

  The LED will blink twice.
- 3. Now, whenever you press VOL +, VOL -, or MUTE on the remote control, volume will be again controlled by your TV.

#### USING THE MENU KEY

On your One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning remote control, the MENU key works just like the MENU key of your original remote control and allows you to access the on-screen menu of the component you have selected (e.g., TV, VCR, DVD, or CBL/SAT).

When you press MENU, the VOL+, VOL-, CH+, and CH – keys will allow you to navigate and adjust the on screen menu settings just like you would with your original remote control. Also, the MUTE key becomes the Menu Select key.

To exit out of the Menu mode, press or EXIT to return to normal operation.

#### **USING KEYMOVER**

The One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning remote control includes a *Keymover* feature that allows you to map (or copy) keys from one mode (i.e., source mode) to another (i.e., destination mode).

NOTE: The following keys cannot be mapped: TV, DVD, VCR, CBL/SAT, SET, M.POWER, V.CONFIG, and learning keys L1 ~ L4.

For example, if your VCR does not have volume control, you can map the volume and mute keys from the TV mode to the VCR mode as follows:

- 1. On the remote control, press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 2. 994 Enter 9 9 4.
- 3. (N) For the source mode, press TV once.
- 4.  $\int_{\text{res}}$  For the source key, press VOL + once.
- 5. (VCR) For the destination mode, press VCR once.
- 6.  $\int_{v_L}^{v_L}$  For the destination key, press VOL + once.
- 7. O The LED will blink twice indicating the keymoved sequence is correct.
- 8. Repeat steps 1 through 7 twice more, substituting VOL and MUTE as source and destination keys in steps 4 and 6.

Upon completion of the above procedure, you can now use your One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning remote control to control the TV's volume and mute in the VCR mode, as well as in the TV mode.


#### **USING LEARNING KEYS**

Use the learning keys (L1, L2, L3, L4) to add functions that are unique to your home entertainment components (e.g., Tracking Up or Down for a VCR).

NOTE: Please have your original remote controls handy before programming learning. Be sure to press each key within 10 seconds of the previous entry. If not, the remote control will exit the programming mode.

#### Programming The L Keys

- 1. On the remote control, press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 2. 975 Enter 9 7 5. The LED will blink twice.
- 3. Press the component key once in which you want to learn a feature (e.g., TV).
- Press the L key once (e.g., L1) in which the new feature is to be learned. The LED will blink rapidly.
- 5. Place your original remote control head to head (about 2" apart) from the One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning remote con-



trol.

- 6. On your original remote control, press and hold the key (i.e., feature) to be learned until the LED on the One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning remote control blinks twice. If the LED does not blink twice, stop and repeat steps 1 through 5.
- 7. To learn functions on the other L keys, repeat steps 3 through 6.
- 8. To lock in new feature(s) on the One For All
  4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning
  remote control, press and hold SET until the
  LED blinks twice, then release SET.

- 9. To test a new feature, press the component key (e.g., TV) that was learned once.
  - Then press the L key (e.g., L1) where the component's feature was learned.

#### **Deleting Functions From The L Keys:**

- 1. (SET) On the remote control, press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 2. 975 Enter 9 7 6. The LED will blink twice.
- 3. Press the component key once where the learned feature to be deleted is stored (e.g., TV).
- 4. ① Press the L key (e.g., L1) to be deleted twice. The LED will blink twice after the second press.
- 5. To clear additional functions stored on other L keys, repeat steps 1 through 4.

### USING THE VIDEO CONFIGURATION MODE

The One For All 4-Device Video Expert Plus With Learning remote control includes a powerful *Video Configuration* feature that allows you to combine the most used functions of your Audio/Video equipment into one V.CONFIG mode. The features you can combine are organized into five groups and can be defined by specific modes as follows:

#### **Function Groups**

- Function Group 1 Transport Keys (Play, Stop, Fast Forward, Rewind, Pause, Record, Forward Scan, and Rewind Scan)
- Function Group 2 Volume Keys (Volume Up, Volume Down, and Mute)
- Function Group 3 Channel Keys (Channel Up, Channel Down, Digits 0-9, Enter, Previous Channel, Sleep, and Display)
- Function Group 4 Menu Keys (Menu, Up, Down, Left, Right, Select, and Exit)
- Function Group 5 PIP Keys (Picture-In-Picture, Swap, and Move)

#### Component (Mode) Groups

- Component Group 1 VCR and DVD
- Component Group 2 TV, VCR, and Cable/Sat
- Component Group 3 TV, VCR, and Cable/Sat
- Component Group 4 TV, VCR, Cable/Sat, and DVD
- Component Group 5 TV, VCR, and Cable/Sat

To enable the *Video Configuration* feature, you'll need to perform the following programming sequence:

- 1. (CONFIG On the remote control, press V.CONFIG once.
- Press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 3. 979 Enter 9 7 9. The LED will blink twice.

At this point, you'll assign *Component Groups* to *Function Groups* up to five times, depending on how many combinations you need. You can perform any of the following steps in any order, as long as you finish the sequence with

step 9.

- 4. Select a key from *Component Group 1* (i.e., VCR or DVD) and press it once. Press PLAY to assign
  - Function Group 1 (i.e., the transport keys). The LED will blink twice.
- 5. Select a key from *Component Group 2* (i.e., TV, VCR, or CBL/SAT) and press it once. Press VOL+
  - to assign *Function Group 2* (i.e., the volume keys). The LED will blink twice.
- 6. (v) Select a key from *Component Group 3* (i.e., TV, VCR, or CBL/SAT) and press it once. Press CH+
  - to assign *Function Group 3* (i.e., the channel keys). The LED will blink twice.
- 7. N Select a key from Component Group 4 (i.e., TV, DVD, VCR, or CBL/SAT) and press it once. Press
  - MENU to assign *Function Group 4* (i.e., the menu keys). The LED will blink twice.
- 8. (VCR) Select a key from *Component Mode Group 5* (i.e., TV, VCR, or CBL/SAT) and press it once.
  - Press PIP to assign *Function Group 5* (i.e., the PIP keys). The LED will blink twice.
- 9. (SET) To lock in the *Video Configuration*, press SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.

#### An Example Video Configuration

From one mode, you would like to play your DVD, use the Volume control on the TV, change channels on your Cable Box, control the Menu on the Cable Box, and use the PIP feature of your TV. To program this *Video Configuration* you would perform the following steps:

- 1. CONFIG On the remote control, press V.CONFIG once.
- 2. SET Press and hold SET until the LED blinks twice, then release SET.
- 3. STE Enter 9 7 9. The LED will blink twice.
- 4. Press DVD once and then press PLAY. The LED will blink twice.


