# INSTRUCTION MANUAL

## Installation Warnings

Ventilation slots and openings in the case are provided for ventilation to ensure reliable operation of the video product and to protect it from overheating. 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# INTRODUCTION

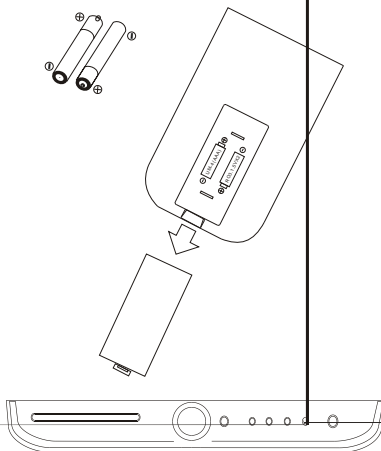
## Loading batteries to the remote control

- Remove the battery compartment cover.
- Load two AAA (UM-4 ) batteries into the battery compartment.
- Make sure that the batteries have been inserted in the correct polarities matching to the symbols +, - marked in the battery compartment. Close the battery compartment cover.
- When replacing batteries, replace both batteries. Do not mix new and used batteries operating together, otherwise, the operation lifetime will be much shorter than normal.
- Remove the batteries if the unit will not be used for a prolonged period of time.

The remote control transmits a directional infrared beam. Be sure to aim the remote control directly at the infrared sensor of the unit during operation.

If the sensor has been covered or there is a large object between the remote control and the sensor, the sensor will not respond.

The sensor may not be able to receive the remote signal when it is exposed to direct sunlight or a strong artificial light (fluorescent or strobe light). In this case, change the direction of the light or reposition the unit to avoid direct lighting.

### Care of disc

- Hold the disc with fingers. Hold the disc's outer edge and/or the center spindle hole. Do not touch the disc surface.

- Store discs in cabinet vertically, in dry condition.

Prevent exposure to:

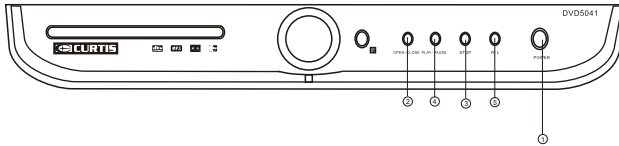
- Direct sunlight

- Do not apply thinner, alcohol chemical solvent, or sprays when cleaning. Such cleaning fluids will permanently damage the disc surface.

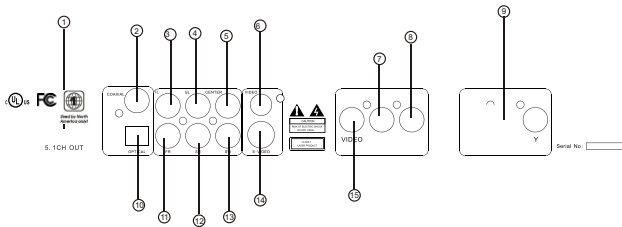

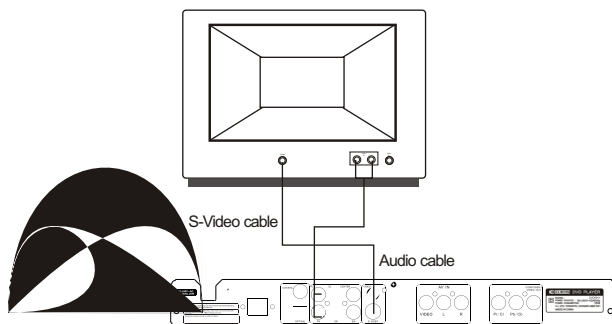
# CONNECTION

## TV SET CONNECTIONS

**CONNECT DVD PLAYER TO TV**  
Connect the Composite video cable



**CONNECT DVD PLAYER TO TV**  
Connect the S-VIDEO cable(not supplied) to connect DVD player and your TV.



# GETTING STARTED

- Unpack the unit.
- Read through this owner's manual before installation and use.
- Load batteries into the remote control unit.
- Connect the system, make sure the connections are secured.
- Connect the power plug to the AC power outlet.

## REMARK

Some features contained in this DVD player are related to the DVD disc's software. Some features cannot be performed if the disc does not support the feature, or requires special settings. Check the features printed on the disc's packing or follow the instructions of the Disc's on screen menu.

## Play a disc

### Switch on the player

Push the main power button to turn on the DVD unit. Power on the TV set and the amplifier if connected.

### Set up the system

Select the corresponding setting of the TV set (A V1, A V2, S-Video etc.) and the amplifier, until the DVD Logo appears on screen

### Load a disc



EJECT

Press **EJECT** button on the remote control (or front panel open/close) to open the disc tray. Load a disc and press **EJECT** to close the disc tray  
(Note, place the disc's label side up, blank side down)

### Automatic Play

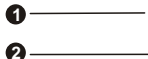
The unit will take a few seconds to download the disc initial data, display the disc type logo in the left upper corner of the TV screen, and then start playing automatically.

### If a DVD Disc Menu appears on screen

Press **PLAY** button on the remote (or on the unit) to start playing.

Or

Press **CURSOR** buttons to select the desired feature in the menu,



And then press the **ENTER** button to confirm a selection.

PLAY

**NOTE** Normally, when a MP3 disc is loaded, the unit will take longer time to download the initial data.

DVD disc that does not match the region code cannot be executed by this player.

Return to the disc main menu, press **MENU** button on the remote.

Prevent loading the disc upside down.

## Video port setup

The DVD player is equipped with the following video ports:

Composite Video (V) (Always active)  
S-Video (Default option)

**The DVD player has been pre-set at the factory to Composite Video (V) and S-Video outputs, as default settings.**

The player is equipped with the following video output ports:

**Composite Video** and **S-Video** always  
active, does not need setting.

## Screen saver

The player is equipped with an automatic screen saver, for the purpose of protecting the TV screen.

The TV screen will be black and a screen Saver will appear on screen if :

- No disc is loaded for 180 seconds
- In STOP mode and no button has been Pressed for 180 seconds, (except in the player or disc menu)

When any button is pressed, the player will resume to normal active mode.

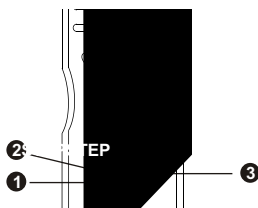

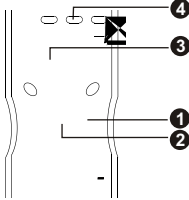

**Disc MENU** Disc menu is a DVD disc feature, allowing users to select functions on screen.

**Disc TITLE** Disc title is the beginning track of a DVD disc. Some DVD discs refuse the "TITLE" function.

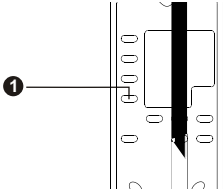
- 1 Input the desired Chapter or Track number using the Numeric key pad. Press ENTER button to confirm your direct access Chapter or key selection.
  - Chapter - when Playing a DVD disc, or
  - Track - when playing a CD or Mp3 disc

#### Numeric input - Function / Menu

- 1 Press the numeric Key pad to input data for disc or setup menu.


**NOTE** Program functionality depends on different DVD disc's format, some DVD discs do not allow direct access function.

## Multi-Angle



A DVD disc may contain up to 9 selectable viewing angles.

If a DVD disc contains Multi-Angle feature, viewing angles may be selected:

- 1 During in playback, repeat pressing **ANGLE** button  to select the desired viewing angle. Status will be displayed on screen..

1 To repeat playback of a desired section:

- 1) Press the A-B button at the beginning of the desired section, "A".
- 2) Press the A-B button again at the end of the desired section, "B".



The player will repeat playback of the section from A to B.

Press the A-B button again

to cancel the function and return to normal play .

### NOTE

- A-B repeat depends on different disc's production format, some DVD discs do not allow repeat function.
- A-B function does not apply to MP3 disc.
- The period between A and B should be at least 3 seconds.

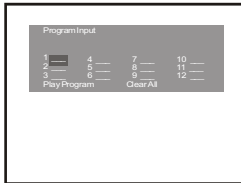

## TV screen

### 4:3 Pan Scan

The signal will fill the screen with the centre of the picture. The left and right edge of picture may be cut outside range of the screen.



**16:9 Wide Scr**

When you connect to a wide screen TV , this setting will allow the original aspect ratio will be display full screen.



**NOTE**



Depending on the DVD disc format, e.g. 2.35:1, the wide screen setting may still having black margins above and below the picture.

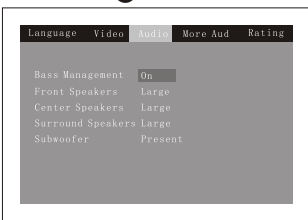

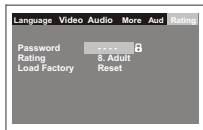

# TROUBLE SHOOTING

Should your DVD player develop a problem, please check below before requesting service:

Symptom	Check and Action
No Power	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check if the power cord has been properly connected to the power outlet.</li> <li>• Check if the main power has been switched on.</li> </ul>
Does not play	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No disc, load a disc.</li> <li>• Disc has been loaded upside down. Place the disc with the label side up.</li> <li>• Disc's region code does not match to the player.</li> <li>• Disc is not correct type for player.</li> <li>• Disc is damaged or dirty, clean the disc or try another disc.</li> <li>• Moisture may be condensed inside the player. Remove the disc and leave the unit power on for one or two hours.</li> </ul>
No Picture	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check if the TV set has power on, use TV remote to select A/V signal for DVD rather than broadcast.</li> <li>• Check if the system connection is proper and secure.</li> <li>• Check if the connection cables are damaged.</li> <li>• Clean the disc.</li> </ul>
Picture noise / distorted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The disc is dirty or damaged. Clean the disc or try another disc.</li> <li>• Reset the color system of the player or the TV set.</li> <li>• Try to direct the player to the TV set instead of via other components, such as a VCR.</li> </ul>
Picture not full screen	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Select the screen format from the player's SETUP MENU, see "SETUP MENU" of this manual.</li> <li>• Select the screen format from DVD disc menu.</li> </ul>
Malfunction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Should the player develop a malfunction, unplug the player for 30 minutes. After 30 minutes, power on the player and the restore function should reset the player.</li> </ul>
No sound	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• DTS disc used. Press the remote control "LANGUAGE" button  and re-select the audio setting on the remote.</li> </ul>
