A challenge indeed to each of us to tell the world of our Saviour, and a blessed surety that He is our faithful, unchanging Master.



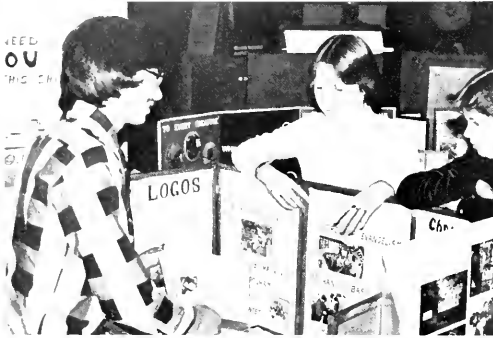
