FOREWORD

The Medicaid Bureau has extensively revised the graphs and tables which comprise the Medicaid Management Reports. A narrative summary of quarterly highlights has also been added to the reports. These changes were instituted to improve the readability, utility, and quality of these reports. We hope that you will like the new formats on which data on the Medicaid program are displayed.

INTRODUCTION

The Medicaid Management Reports are published by the Medicaid Bureau's Division of Analysis and Evaluation. These reports are designed to present some current data on State Medicaid programs and to identify program trends through a series of tables and graphs. They are prepared quarterly from data submitted by the States to the Federal government on forms OA-41 and NCSS-120.

The Medicaid Management Reports provide the Medicaid Bureau with national and individual State trends that are used to help identify States and program areas in which program monitoring activities should be centered. They also help the Medicaid Bureau fulfill its responsibility for making data on the Medicaid program available to Congress and others interested in the Medicaid program. In addition, it is hoped that publication of the data in this form will result in an improvement in the quality of the data submitted by the States to the Federal government.

Types of data presented in the Medicaid Management Reports include:

- Amount of State Medicaid Expenditures
- Amount of the Federal Share of State Medicaid Expenditures
- Amount and Distribution of Medical Vendor Payments by Type of Service
- Average Monthly Number of Medicaid Recipients for whom Medical Vendor Payments were made
- Average Monthly Participation Rate in Medicaid by Public Assistance Recipients
- Average Monthly Payment per Medicaid Recipient by Basis of Eligibility
- Number of Children Screened and Referred under EPSDT

The data presented should be used with caution for the following reasons. There is much variance between States in the types of medical services covered under Medicaid and in the designation of groups eligible for Medicaid. Data which are generated through State claim payment systems are affected by the time lag between the provision of medical services and payment for those services. Only data from the OA-41 report has been verified by the Federal government. Lastly, incomplete reporting by the States may distort the national totals and averages.

QUARTERLY HIGHLIGHTS
January - March 1977

Cumulative total Medicaid expenditures in the United States for the first and second quarters of Federal fiscal year 1977 (October 1976-March 1977) were \$8.3 billion, an increase of 10.3% from the corresponding quarters in fiscal year 1976. Medical Assistance Payments rose by 9.3% to \$7.8 billion while expenditures for State and local administration and training for Medicaid rose by 32% to \$426.9 million between these two periods. The unadjusted Federal share of total State and local Medicaid expenditures for the first and second quarters of Federal fiscal year 1977 was \$4.6 billion, an increase of 10% from the corresponding quarters of fiscal year 1976.

For the quarter ending March 31, 1977, total State and local Medicaid expenditures in the United States increased by 9.5% to \$4.2 billion as compared to the corresponding quarter ending March 31, 1976. Over the same period, the average monthly number of Medicaid recipients in the United States decreased by 6% to 8.6 million. Medical Assistance Payments rose by 8% to \$4.0 billion while expenditures for State and local administration and training for Medicaid rose by 25.4% to \$211 million between these two periods. The unadjusted Federal share of total State and local Medicaid expenditures for the quarter ending March 31, 1977, was \$2.3 billion, an increase of 9.4% from the corresponding quarter in 1976.

By type of service, inpatient hospital services and intermediate care facility services accounted for the largest proportion of Medical Vendor Payments made during the quarter ending March 31, 1977, accounting for nearly 32% and 22% of all payments made in the United States during this period. Outpatient hospital services was the service which experienced the largest percent increase in payments in the United States between the quarters ending March 31, 1976, and March 31, 1977, these payments increasing by 70% to \$188 million.

AFDC children comprised the single largest group of Medicaid recipients in the United States in the quarter ending March 31, 1977, representing nearly 31% of all Medicaid recipients reported.

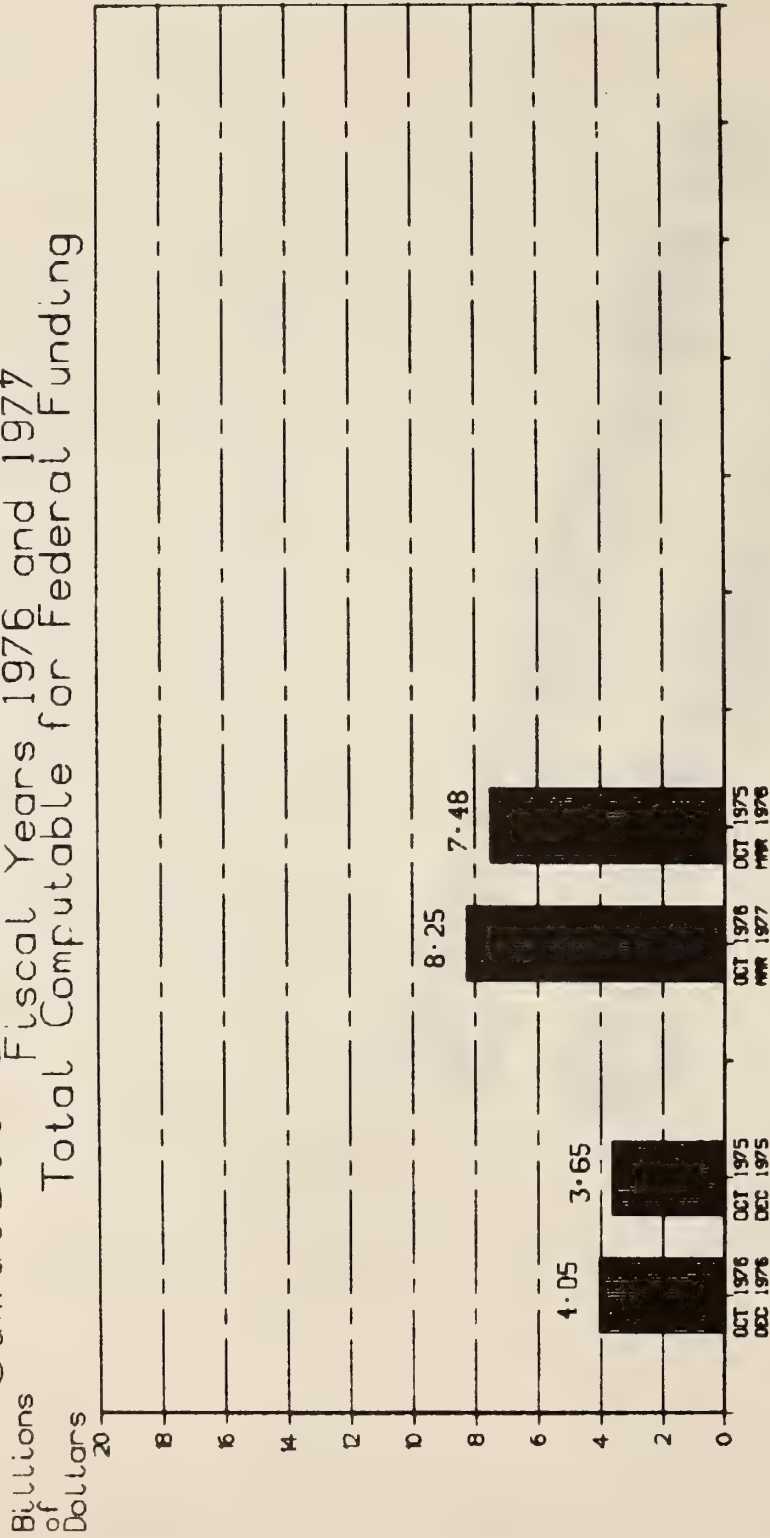
During the quarter ending March 31, 1977, 34% of all public assistance recipients in the United States used Medicaid services. Aged individuals who were also SSI beneficiaries had the highest rate of Medicaid use of all eligible groups on public assistance - 54%.

The average monthly payment for all Medicaid recipients in the United States during the quarter ending March 31, 1977, was \$146, an increase of 10% from the corresponding quarter in 1977. Aged and disabled recipients with average monthly Medicaid payments of \$241 and \$261 respectively, were the eligible groups with the highest average monthly payments in the United States during this period.

During the quarter ending March 31, 1977, a total of 480,326 children were screened in the United States under the EPSDT program. This represented a 1.4% increase in the number of children screened from the corresponding quarter in 1976. Over 54% of all children screened in the United States were found to have referable medical conditions.

Cumulative Medical Assistance Payments Fiscal Years 1976 and 1977 Total Computable for Federal Funding

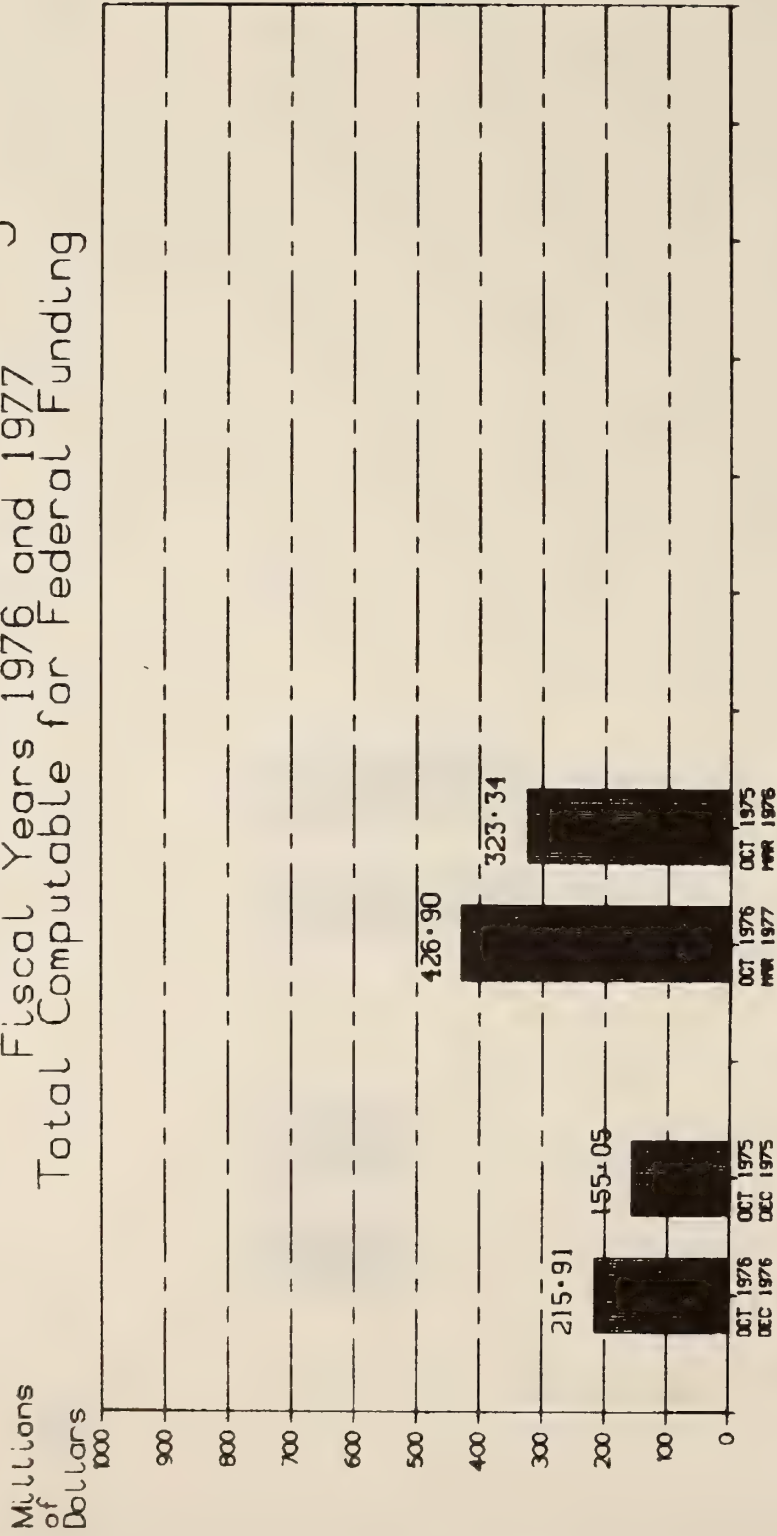

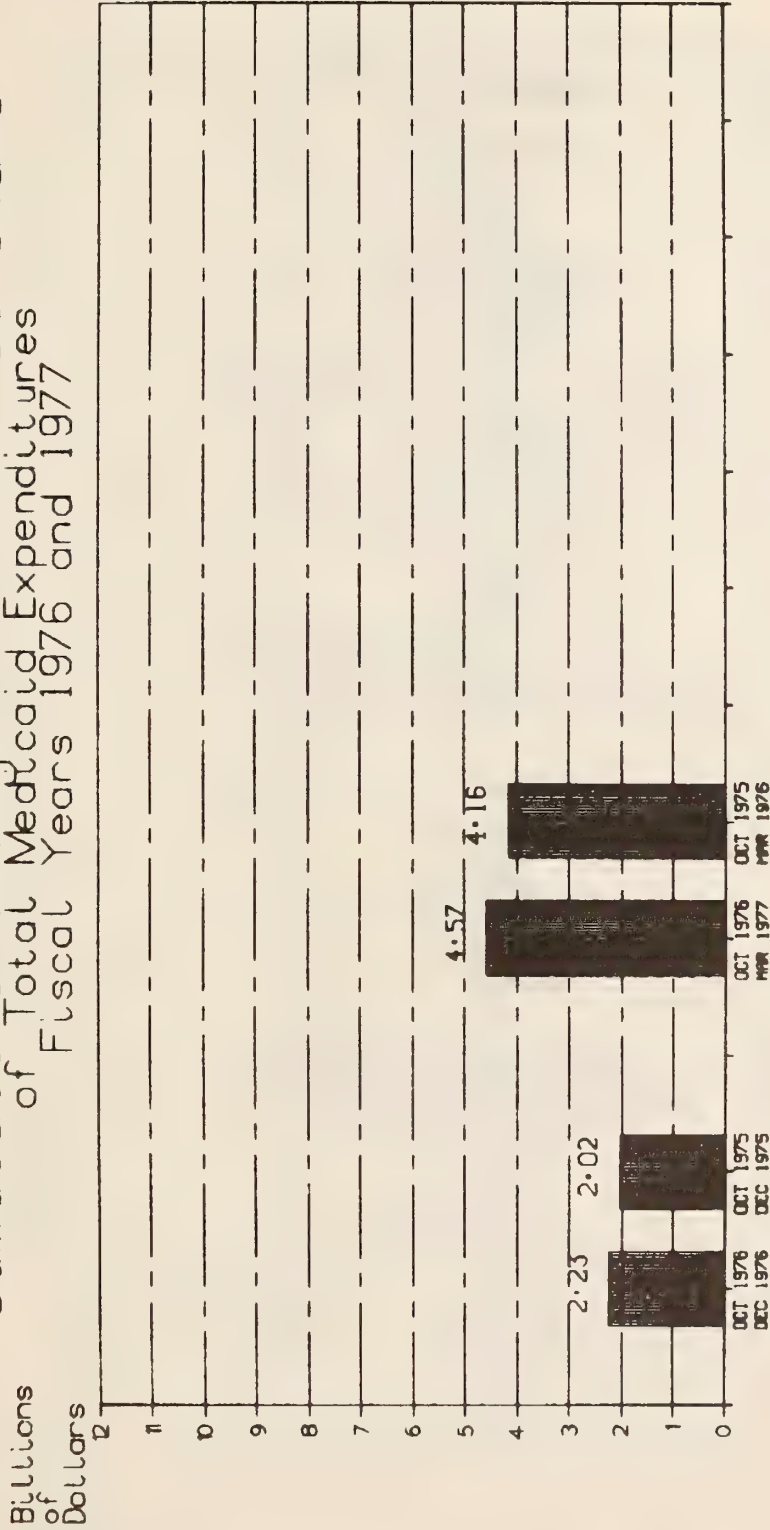
Cumulative Expenditures for State and Local Administration and Training Fiscal Years 1976 and 1977 Total Computable for Federal Funding

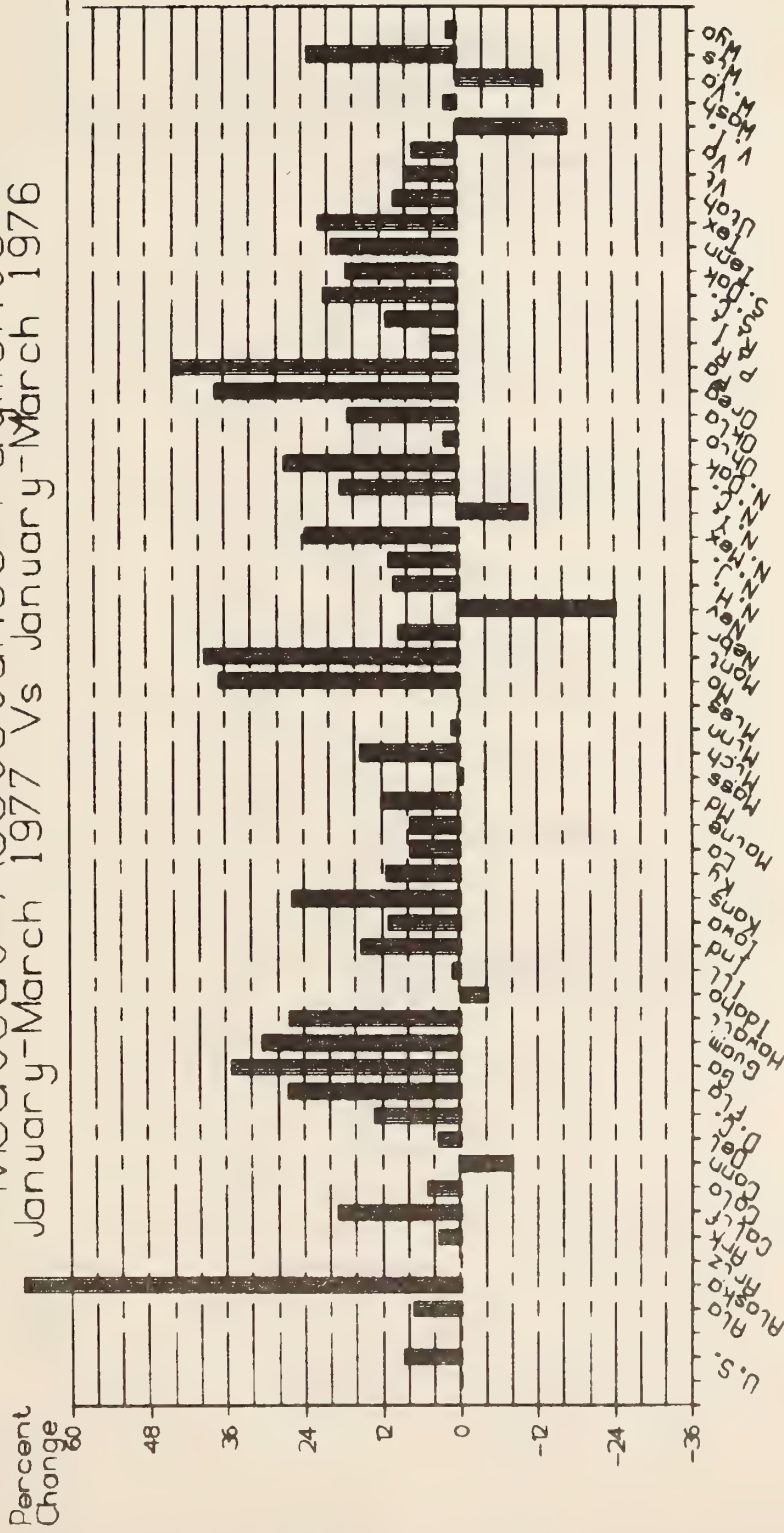
Percent Change in Total Medicaid Expenditures January-March 1977 Vs January-March 1976

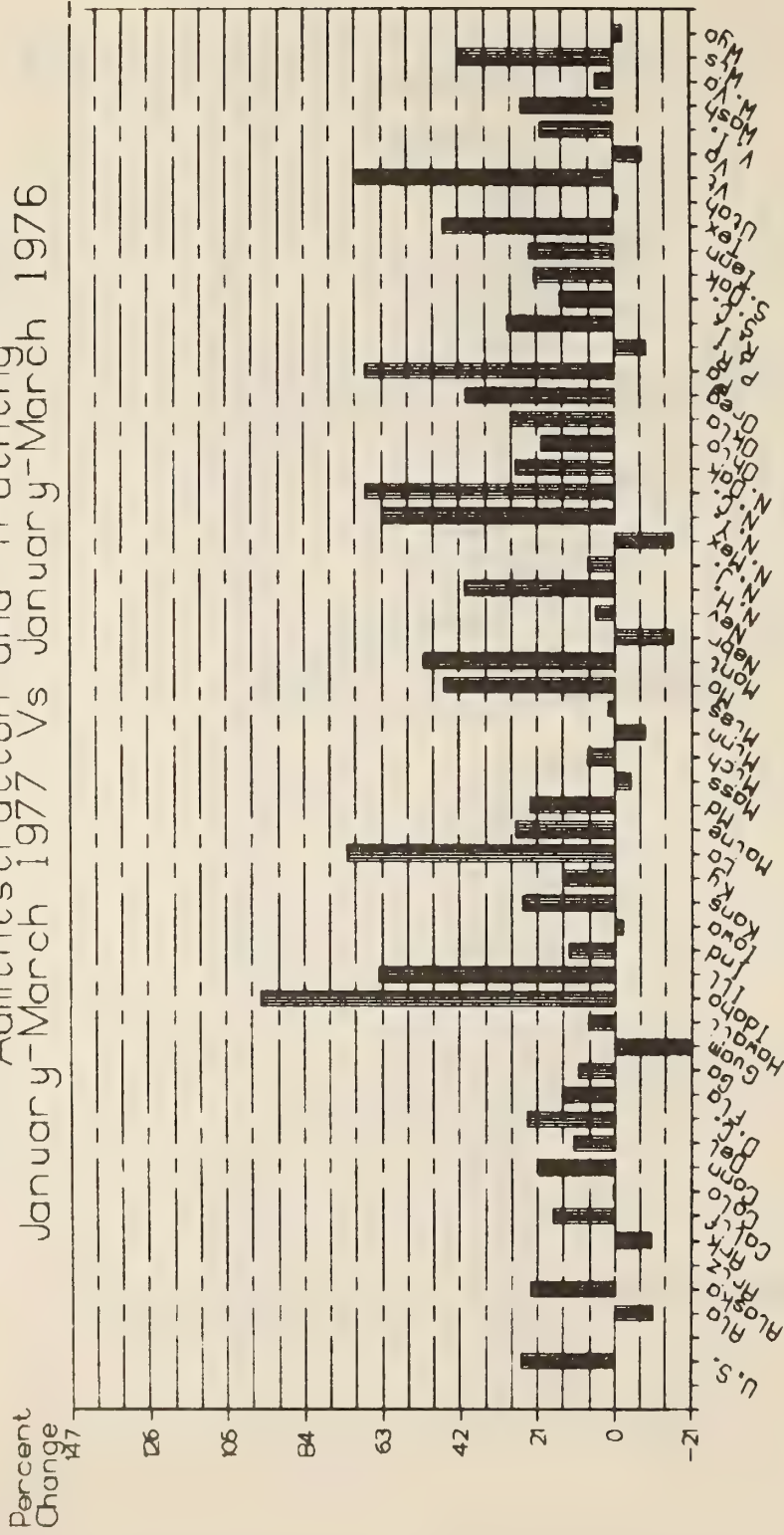
Percent Change in Medical Assistance Payments January-March 1977 Vs January-March 1976

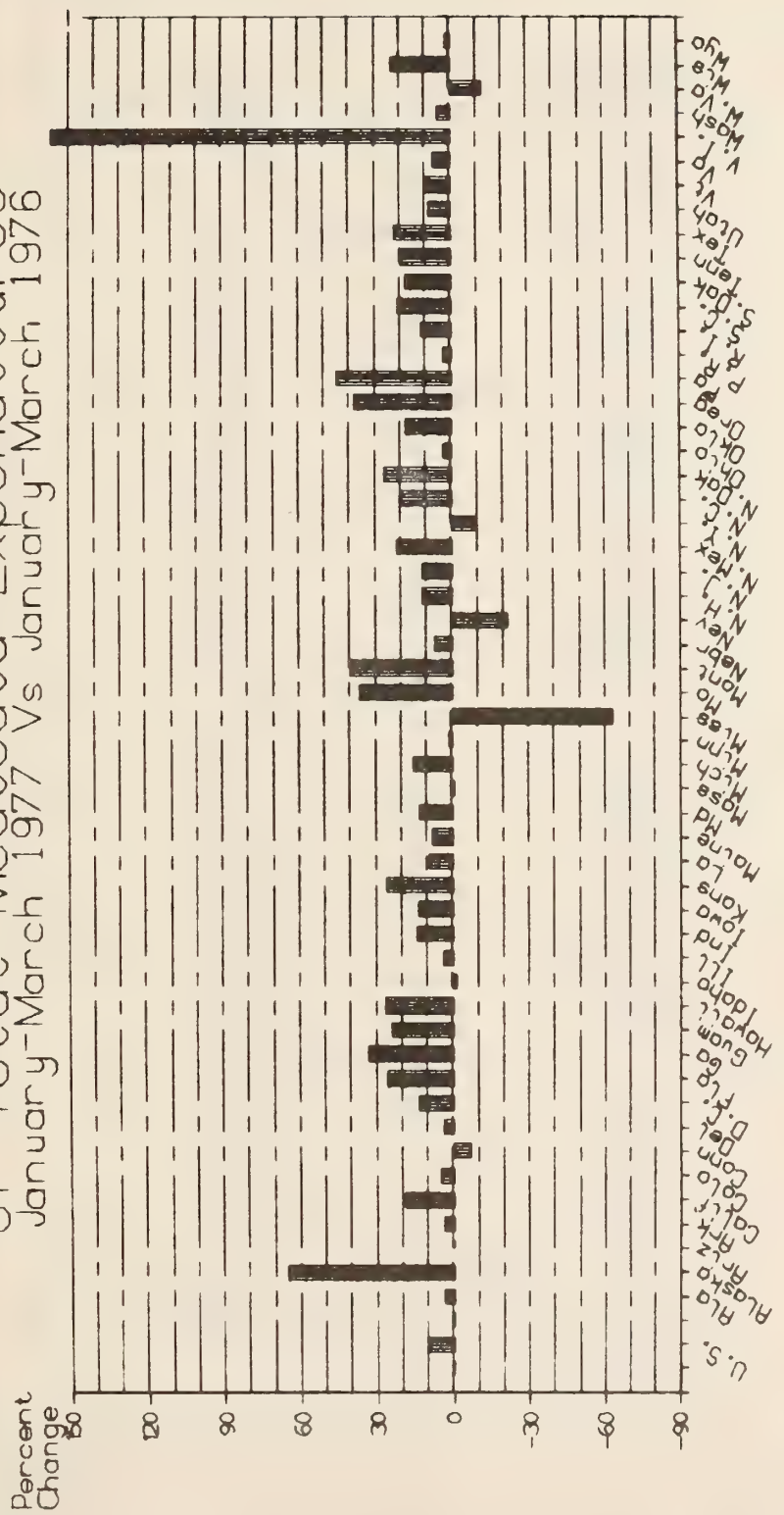

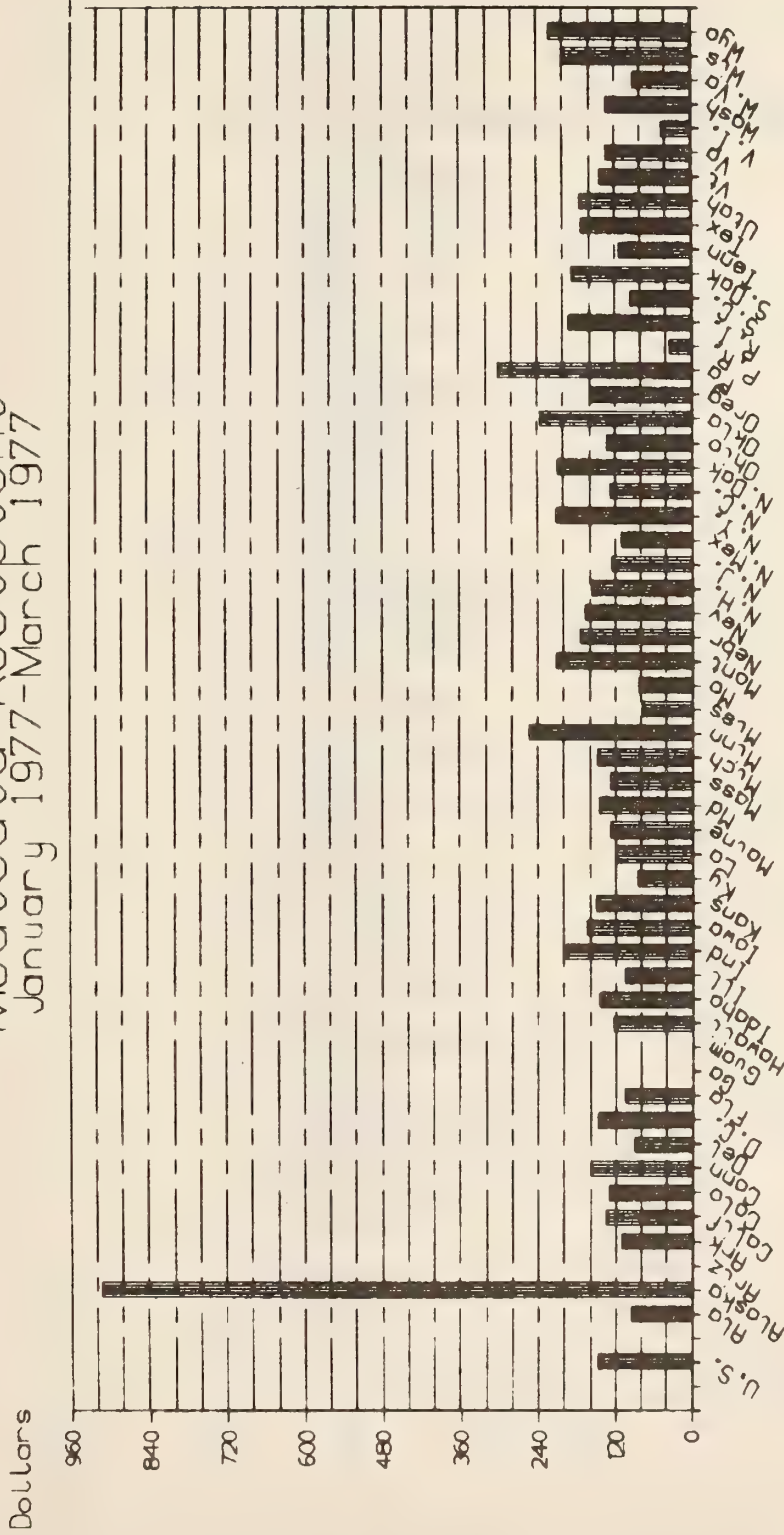
Percent Change in Unadjusted Federal Share of Total Medicaid Expenditures January-March 1977 Vs January-March 1976

Average Monthly Payment per Medicaid Recipient January 1977 - March 1977

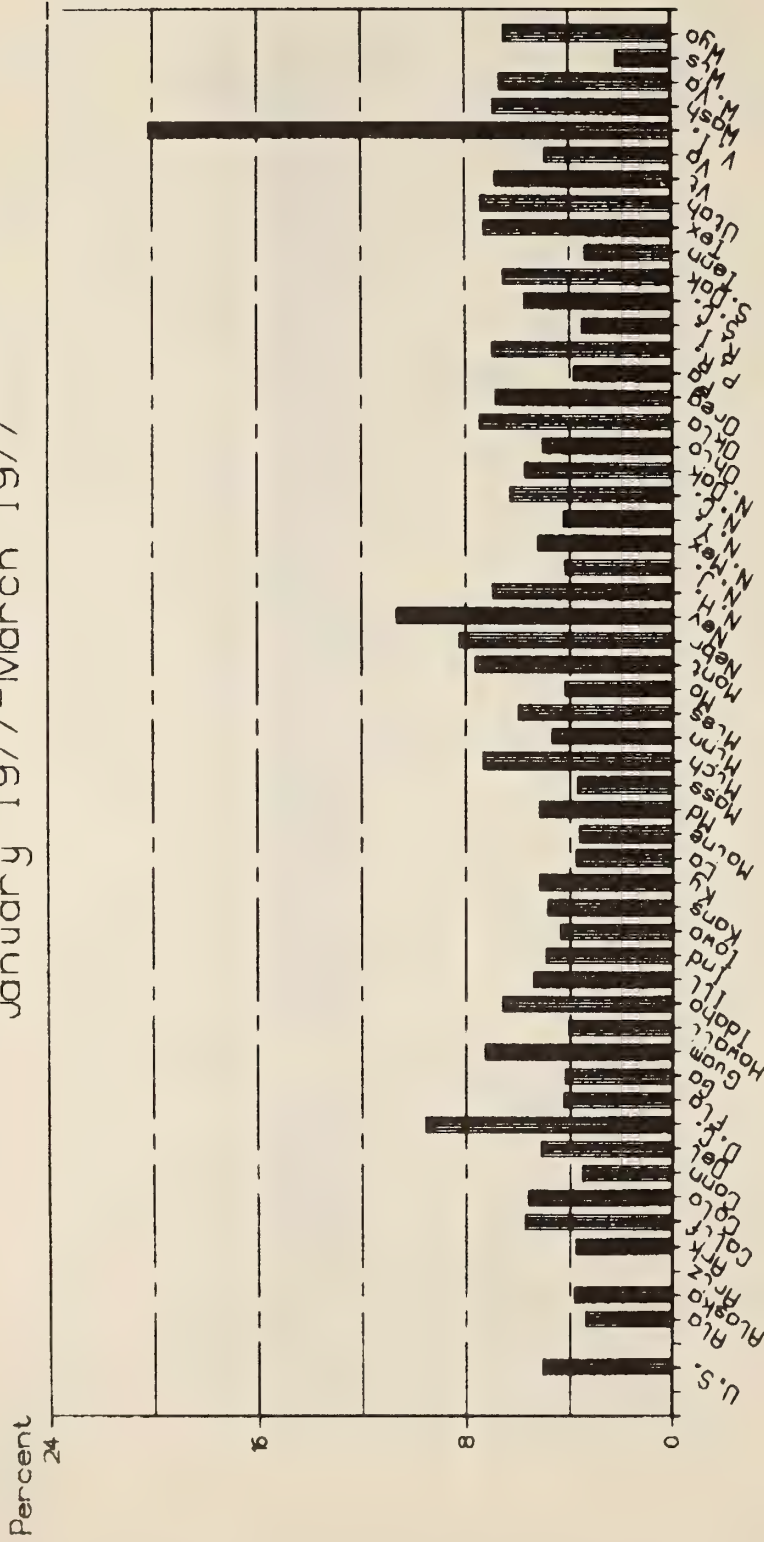

January 1977-March 1977

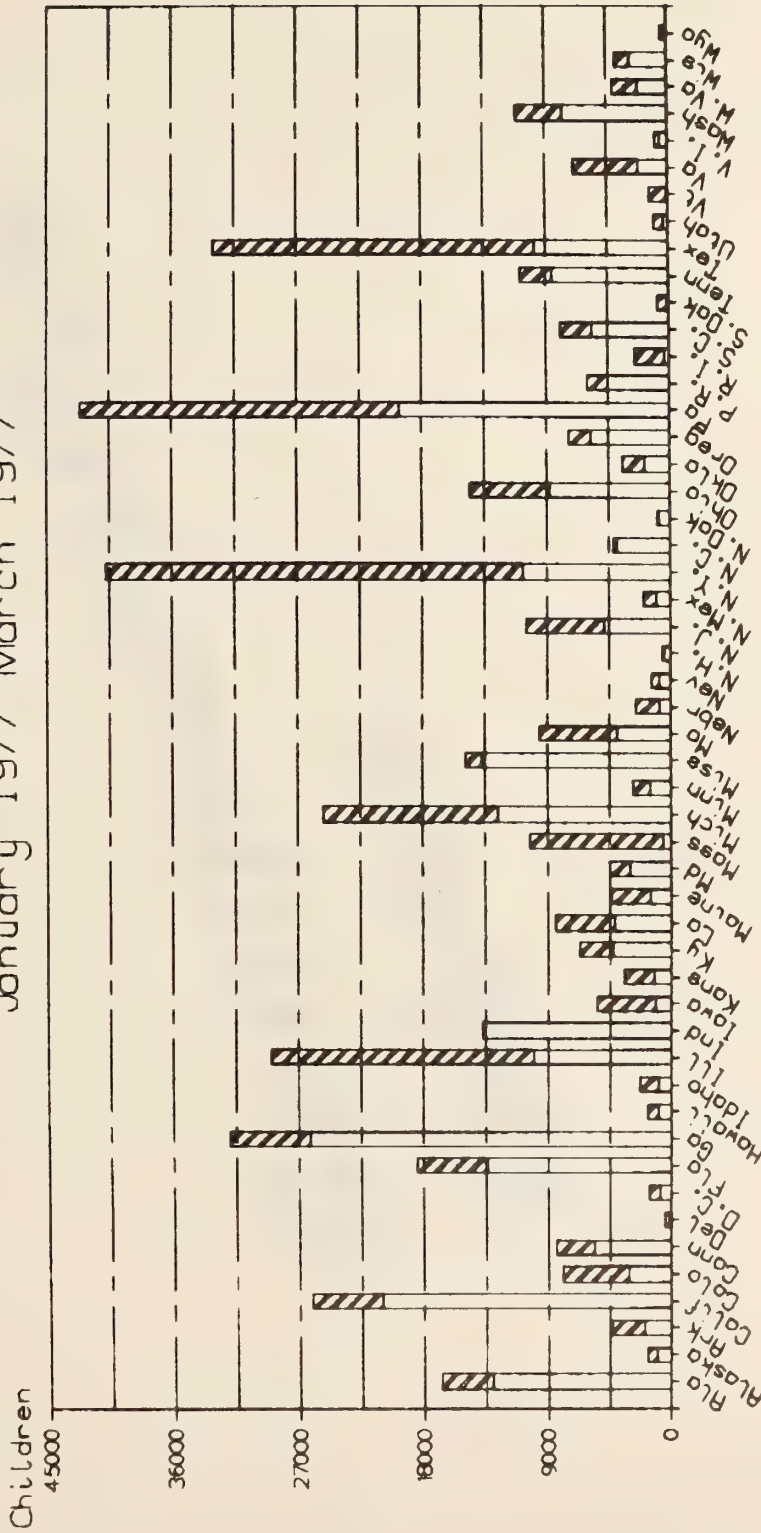

I. FINANCIAL DEFINITIONS

COMPUTABLE FOR FEDERAL FUNDING - Expenditures made by a State Medicaid agency associated with the operation of the Medicaid program which are matchable by Federal funds.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PAYMENTS - Those payments made for medical care by the State directly or on behalf of the agency by a fiscal agent. Such payments may be in the form of vendor payments made directly to providers of medical care or in the form of per capita premium payments made to HMOs, or other prepayment plans, and Medicare Part B (SMIB) premium payments, but does not include payments into a pooled fund arrangement.

TOTAL EXPENDITURES - Includes expenditures for Medical Assistance Payments and for administrative and training activities associated with the operation of the Medicaid program made by a State Medicaid agency. It does not include the costs of rural health, PSROs and Section 222 projects.

CUMULATIVE EXPENDITURES - All expenditures made Federal fiscal year to date.

STATE AND LOCAL ADMINISTRATION AND TRAINING - The administrative and training costs associated with the operation of the Medicaid program in a State which may include the functional costs of eligibility determination, policy formulation, direction, claims processing, payment process and training, and includes salaries and employee benefits, supplies, equipment, postage, travel, fiscal agent costs etc., associated with these functions.

UNADJUSTED FEDERAL SHARE - The Federal share of Medical Assistance Payments and administrative and training costs associated with the operation of the Medicaid program which are incurred by a State Medicaid agency and matchable by the Federal government per the various matching formulas for Medicaid expenditures. The unadjusted Federal share does not reflect financial adjustments that are made to the Federal share after the State expenditures are reported to HEW.

II. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Medicaid is designed to provide medical assistance to those groups or categories of people who are eligible to receive cash payments under one of the existing welfare programs established under the Social Security Act; that is Title IV, the program of Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) or Title XVI, the Supplemental Security Income (SSI) program for the aged, blind and disabled. Medicaid eligibility is available to people who fit into one of the categories of people covered by the cash welfare programs as aged, blind or disabled individuals, or as members of families with dependent children when one parent is absent, incapacitated or unemployed. Medicaid eligibles are classified as categorically needy or medically needy within the above categories. The categorically needy are those individuals who are receiving cash assistance or would be receiving such assistance if they applied under one of the cash welfare programs described above. The medically needy are individuals who would be eligible for welfare except that their income are too high. In addition, some States have exercised the option of including other needy persons in their Medicaid programs who do not fall into one of the above categories. Such individuals are classified as "other" Title XIX recipients.

III. DEFINITION OF SERVICES

INPATIENT HOSPITAL SERVICES - All items and services furnished by a licensed or formally approved hospital, which are provided under the direction of physicians or dentists for the care and treatment of hospital inpatients, and which are billed for by the hospital.

GENERAL HOSPITAL - A hospital maintained primarily for inpatient care of acute illness or injury and for obstetrics or tuberculosis.

MENTAL HOSPITAL - A hospital primarily engaged in providing psychiatric services for the diagnosis and treatment of mentally ill persons.

INTERMEDIATE CARE FACILITY SERVICES - All services provided, and billed for, by an institution furnishing health-related care and services to individuals who do not require the degree of care provided by hospitals or skilled nursing facilities as defined under title XIX, but who because of their physical or mental condition require care and services above room and board. Intermediate Care Facility (ICF) services may also include ICF services for the mentally retarded receiving active treatment in certified institutions for the mentally retarded or persons with related conditions.

SKILLED NURSING FACILITY SERVICES - Skilled nursing or rehabilitative services provided under physicians' orders on an inpatient basis and billed for by a certified facility that meets standards for skilled care established under the title XIX program.

PHYSICIAN SERVICES - All services provided and billed for by an individual licensed under State law to practice medicine or osteopathy. Exclude all such services that are provided as a part of inpatient or outpatient hospital services, or of clinic or laboratory services, and billed for by the hospital, clinic or laboratory.

DENTAL SERVICES - Any diagnosis, preventive, or corrective procedures administered by, or under the supervision of a dentist. The term "dentist" means a person licensed to practice dentistry or dental surgery.

OTHER PRACTITIONER SERVICES - Services provided by and billed for by licensed practitioners other than physicians and dentists. Services of professional nurses (registered nurses or graduate nurses) should be limited to private duty services in a hospital or nursing home. Payments to optometrists, should include, where applicable, payments for eye glasses.

III. DEFINITION OF SERVICES - Continued

OUTPATIENT HOSPITAL SERVICES - All preventive, diagnostic, therapeutic, rehabilitative, or palliative items or services furnished to outpatients, by a hospital and by, or under the direction of, physicians or dentists.

LABORATORY AND RADIOLOGICAL SERVICES - Professional and technical laboratory and radiological services provided in an office or similar facility (other than a hospital outpatient department or clinic) or by a qualified laboratory.

HOME-HEALTH SERVICES - Includes the following items and services furnished to a patient in his home (excluding a hospital or nursing home) on recommendation of a physician: Intermittent or part-time nursing services provided by a home health agency, or by a registered professional nurse or licensed practical nurse when no home health agency is available to provide such services; medical supplies, equipment and supplies suitable for use in the home; and services of a home health aide.

FAMILY PLANNING SERVICES - Any medically approved means, including diagnosis, treatment, drugs, supplies, and devices, and related counseling which are furnished or prescribed by or under the supervision of a physician for individuals of child-bearing age for purposes of enabling such individuals freely to determine the number and spacing of their children.

CLINIC SERVICES - All preventive, diagnostic, therapeutic, rehabilitative, or palliative items or services furnished to outpatients by, or under the direction of physicians, or dentists in a facility which is not part of a hospital, but which is organized and operated to provide such services to outpatients. Services rendered by HMO's are to be reported by type of service. Services rendered by physicians in a general group practice are to be billed as physician services.

PRESCRIBED DRUGS - Any simple or compounded substance or mixture of substances prescribed by a physician, dentist, or other licensed practitioner for the cure, mitigation, or prevention of disease, or for health maintenance. For reporting purposes, prescribed drugs will be primarily those dispensed by licensed pharmacists. Drugs administered directly by a physician or other practitioner are to be reported as prescribed drugs if charges for them are separable from other charges of the practitioner.

OTHER CARE - Any type of medical care or services not classifiable under one of the items defined above.

IV. MISCELLANEOUS DEFINITIONS

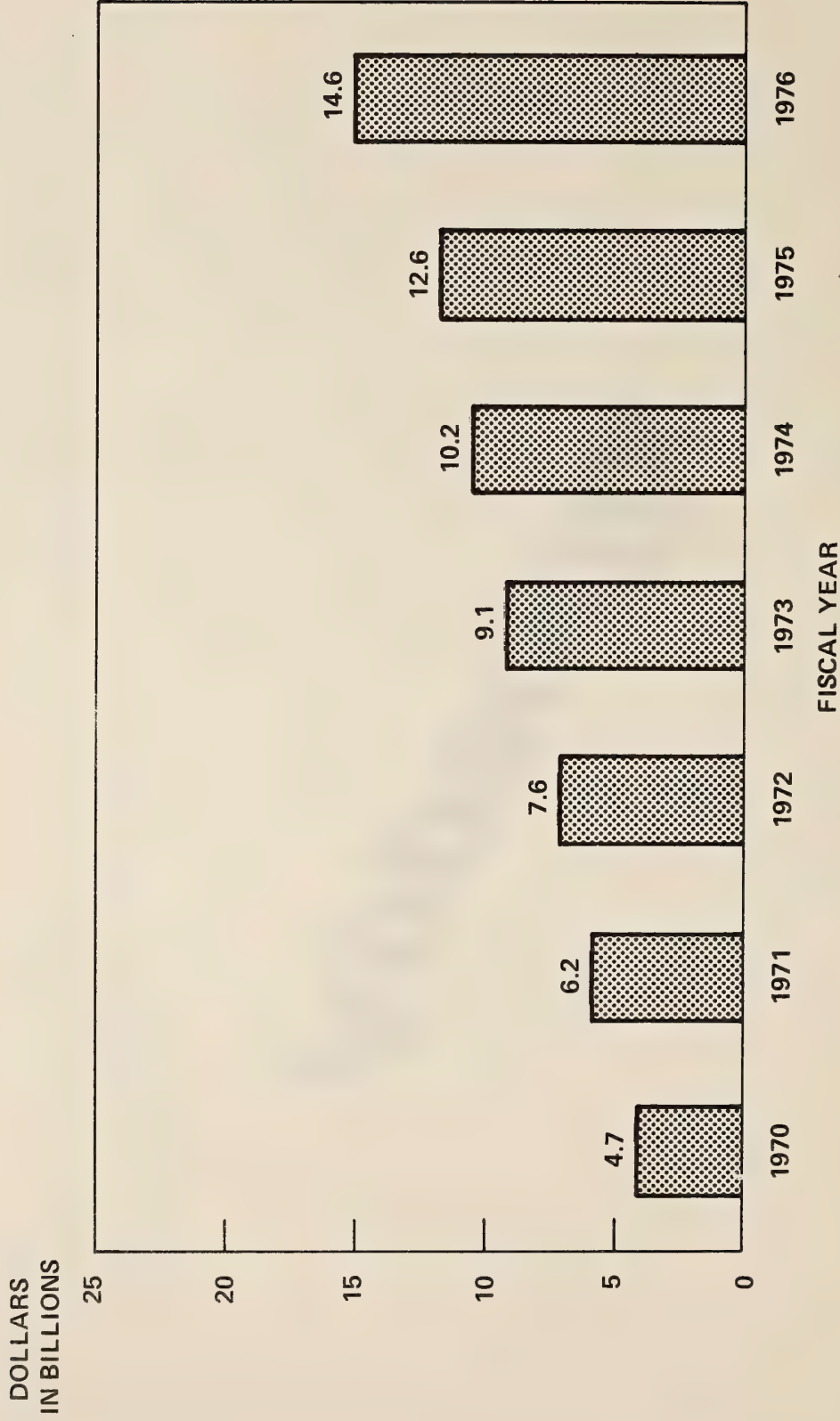
AVERAGE MONTHLY PAYMENT PER MEDICAID RECIPIENT - The average amount per month of all Medical Assistance payments made on behalf of a Medicaid recipient by basis of eligibility.

PARTICIPATION RATE IN MEDICAID BY PUBLIC ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS - The percentage of individuals who are receiving cash payments under the Aid to Families with Dependent Children (AFDC) or Supplemental Security Income (SSI) programs for whom a claim is paid this quarter.

EPSDT - A program of early and periodic screening and diagnosis of individuals under the age of 21 who are eligible under the State plan. The program ascertains their physical or mental defects, and provides health care, treatment and other measures to correct or ameliorate defects and chronic conditions discovered through screening.

FISCAL YEARS 1970-1976



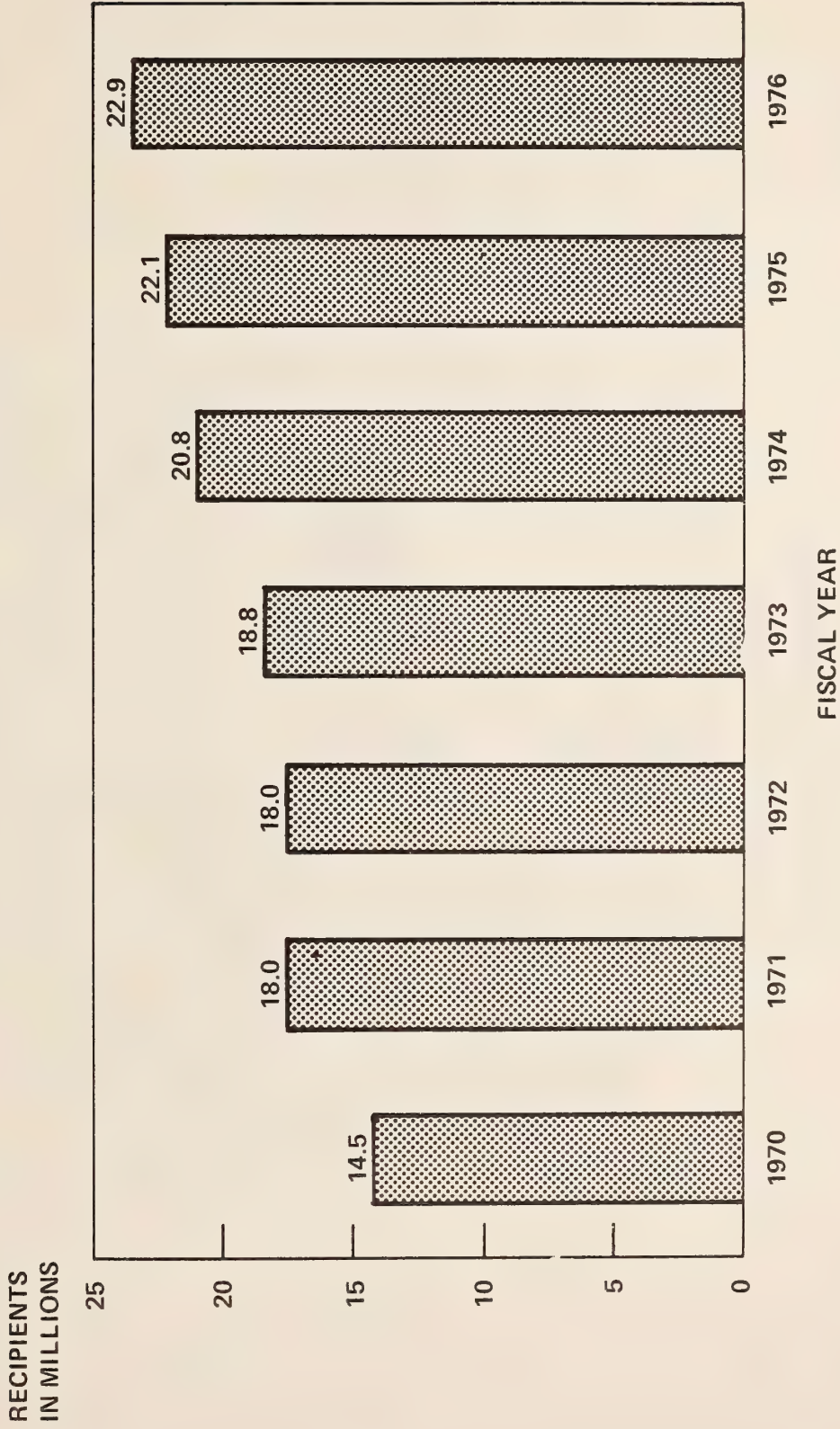

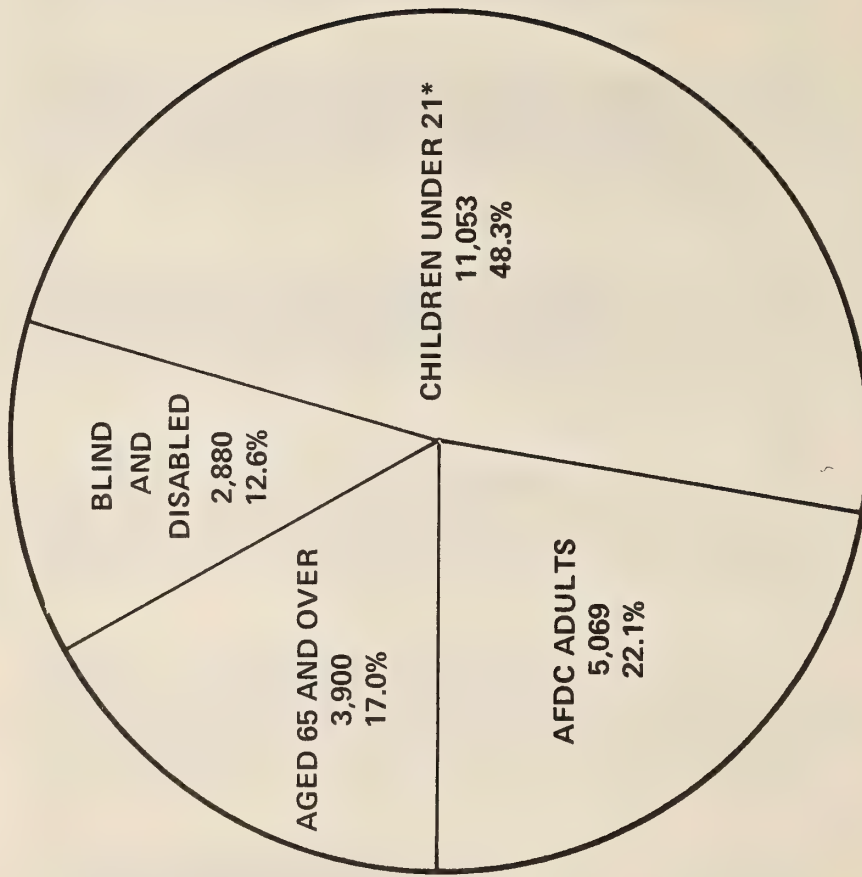

(Recipients in Thousands)



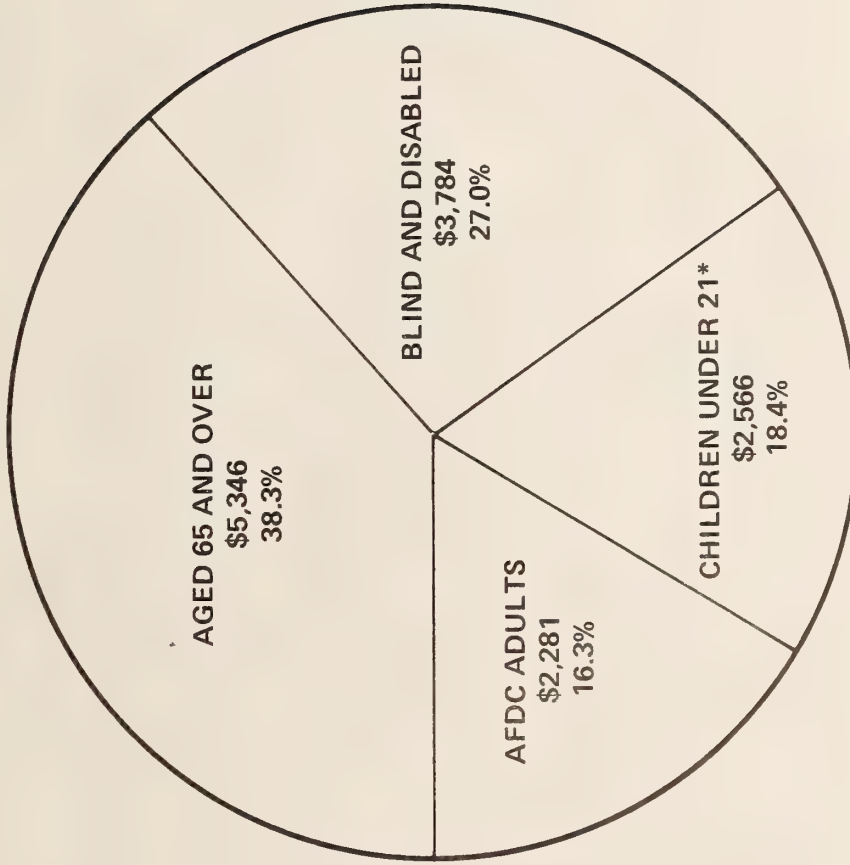

(Dollars in Millions)



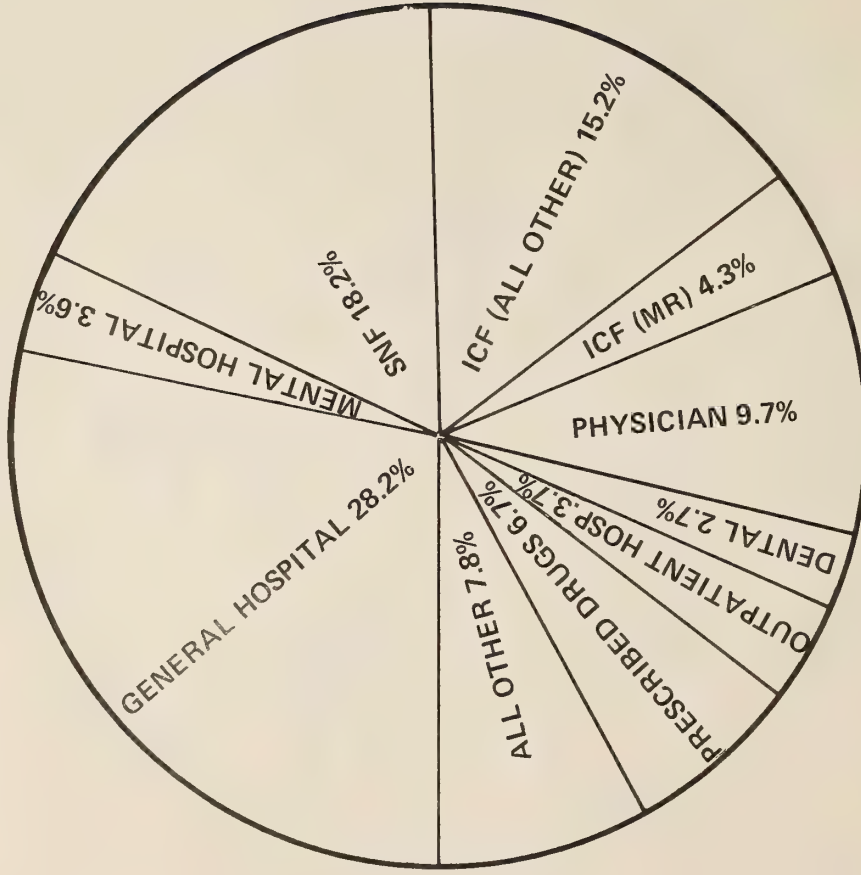
