Unlike the other adaptations which went by quickly, the Mega Man 3 adaptation had plenty of time to develop. We got to see the origin of the stage 3 Robot Masters and got to know them before Mega Man jumped into battle with them. All the elements from the game, to Blues' backstory to Gamma, and even the DOC robots were explored nicely. I enjoyed this buildup greatly, and now it's really paying off.

It's certainly been a long journey leading up to this story! Happy to hear you're digging it!

It's nice to see Dr. Wily slowly, methodically plotting and scheming to forward his goals.

It's a lot more involved than "steal robots and conquer the world!" It's nice to see that he is a credible threat here, as he's staying one step ahead of the situation.

Indeed! Not to mention he's doing so right under Dr. Light's nose AND roof!

Kudos to Roll for catching on to him and stalling his plans, which also makes her a more solid character.

Roll is more than a house keeper, she can be just as heroic as her twin brother as displayed in Mega Man vol. 5 (which is available now btw)!

It was also nice to see the Robot Masters' perspective a little bit more. It adds a lot to the charm of the series. The audience can share Rock's grief more when he has to confront them.

This squad of Robot Masters all have very unique personalities and goals. We want to make sure we highlight their importance just as much as Rock.

But of course, since we all played Mega Man 3 before, we know this is only the beginning! I can't wait to see how Blues fits in to the whole plot!
