This tree is more frequent than any other in the swampy ground, and with rines, is found also in the dryer land near swamps and also occasionally with other trees on the hill slopes. Fire usually kills the younger trees. Stumps sprout well but not as freely as the chestnut or red oak and the sprouts are not as likely to make good trees in dry land! they are overtopped by the

other trees, in wet land they grow because other trees can not.

The finest single trees are on the knoll on the south side of Pine Tree Brook valley and the finest Forest trees are in Balster Brook valley from the pools to the edge of the reservation.

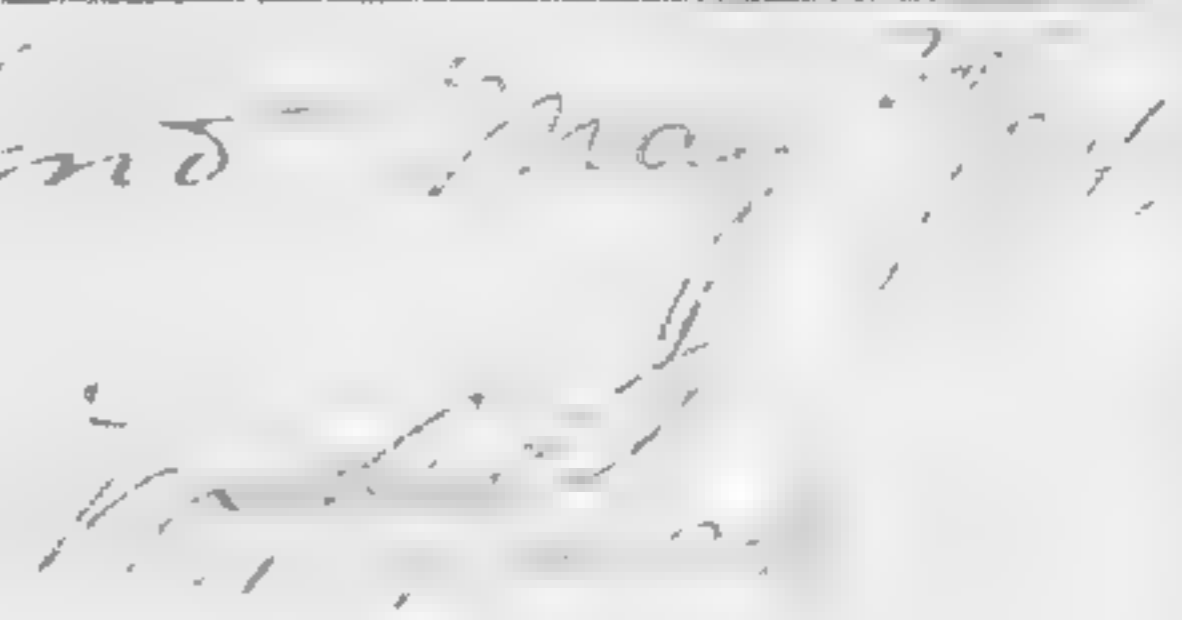
