## Your guide to catching crooks!

Detectives from all over the world talked about their tricks of the trade, comparing notes and exchanging ideas. Sausageroll, reporting for Mickey's Detective Club, wrote them all down and this week he presents his report on how all the world's master detectives operate...

Master detective Ali Karim reports from Egypt...

### Who's snooping at your secrets?

If you suspect an intruder is trying to snoop through your secret documents and you're not sure about it, place a single hair inside the front cover of the top document. If the hair has been disturbed next time you go to look, you know someone is spying on you. Then you know you'll have to start keeping all your secrets under lock and key.

### Seeing in the dark!

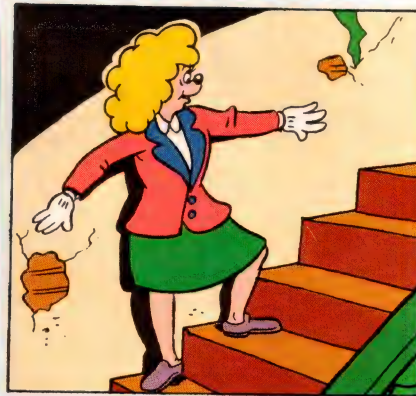
When you go from a light room to a dark room, stand in a doorway for ten seconds, looking into the dark. You'll be surprised how much better you can see after that!

### Carry-on luggage

A detective needs to carry lots of gear – notebooks, pencils, magnifying glass and so on. Sew a few big pockets into the inside of your overcoat so you're not hampered with a bag, and memorise which pocket each article is in. If it makes you look a bit bulky, remember it's the way Columbo does it – and he's pretty successful!

### Creeping without creaking!

If you ever have to creep up (or down) an old staircase without being heard, remember to walk as close to the wall as possible. Why? Because that's where the stair-treads are most strongly supported and therefore less likely to creak, giving your presence away. For complete silence, "slide" up the stairs with your back to the wall.

### Secret Handshakes

A handshake between two detectives can be more than just a friendly greeting – it can be a secret signal, too. All you have to do is agree with another detective that different handshakes mean different things. For example, pressing

### Disappearing message

This method of conveying secret information was voted "Trick of the Year" by the Congress delegates. Wet a sheet of white paper and press it against the bathroom mirror or similar hard, smooth, surface.

Lay a dry piece of white paper on top of the wet one on the mirror. Write your secret message with a biro pen on this dry piece of paper. Press firmly on the pen. Throw away the dry paper you wrote on. Your message should be impressed on the piece of wet



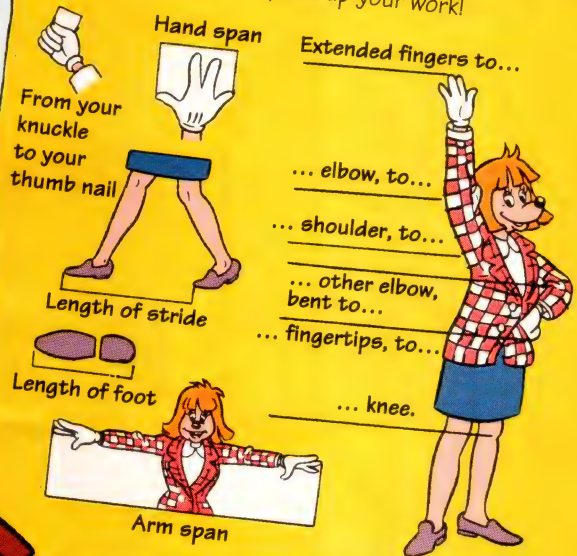
paper. Allow it to dry. The message will slowly disappear. Now give the paper to your colleague, and tell him that when he needs to read your secret instruction, all he has to do is make the paper wet again and the message will reappear!

### Your body's a tape measure!

At the scene of the crime and other places where you need to do some quick measurements you don't need a ruler - you can use your own body. Just get to know the distances between parts of your body, as in the diagram below. Measure the distances on your body first, then try to memorise them. You'll be surprised how this trick will speed up your work!

### What the suspect wrote

You can find out what a suspect has written by slipping a piece of carbon paper cut to size under the third or fourth page of his



notebook, where it won't be noticed. When he's torn off his note, go to the notepad and tear off the sheet immediately below the carbon paper. There you'll find a carbon copy of the suspect's message just as plain as he's written it!



your thumb hard on the back of his hand can mean, "Take care, we're being watched!" Or, if you offer your left hand to shake instead of your right, that means, "Don't hang around! There's trouble right here!" You need to work out with your Detective Club colleagues three or four secret signals that can be conveyed in a handshake, and then memorise them.

# CRYPTIC CODED CLUES

How to communicate with your fellow sleuths using your special *Mickey and friends* Decoder!



Follow these instructions and with this special coding equipment you and your friends will be able to communicate secretly. You don't have to worry about your enemies getting hold of the messages - they won't be able to make head nor tail of them!

**B**efore you use your Decoder, you need a piece of paper measuring 75mm square to write your Secret Agent Pass and tear off section 1.

1. Fold your piece of paper in four (first in half, then in half again).
2. Find the corner of the folded paper that becomes the centre when the paper is unfolded.
3. Cut a small piece off the corner so that when the paper is unfolded, there is a small hole in the centre.
4. Pop up the four small tabs in the middle of the white circle on section 3 and place the paper over them so that the tabs come through the hole.

5. Secure the four corners of the paper in the coloured cut out slots 1, 2, 3 and 4.
6. Remove the Decoder Disc from section 1 and place on top of the paper, over the four tabs. Secure by pressing the tabs down.
7. Remove the Decoder from section 1 and put it through the slots next to the disc in section 3 so that the alphabet key shows through the windows.

## TO WRITE YOUR SECRET MESSAGE

1. Your message will be in four parts. To do the first part of your message, turn the disc until the pink band lines up with the pink slot.
2. Write your message in the normal way from left to right, line by line. Using the Decoder to see what each letter stands for in number code, write a number in each hole, starting with the top left hole and finishing with the bottom right hole. You should be able to read your message from left to right.
3. To write the next part of your message, turn the disc until the green band lines up with the green slot. Continue your number-coded message by writing in the holes as before.
4. Complete your secret message by turning the disc so that the red areas match up, then the purple areas.

## HOW TO READ A SECRET MESSAGE

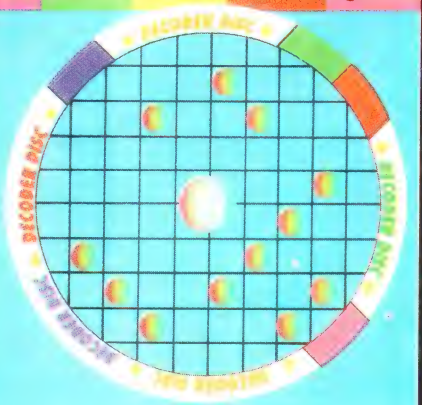
1. Place the paper with the message on in the disc as before.
2. Line up the pink areas and read the message, using the Decoder to crack the code.
3. Match up the green, then red, then purple areas to read the rest of the message.

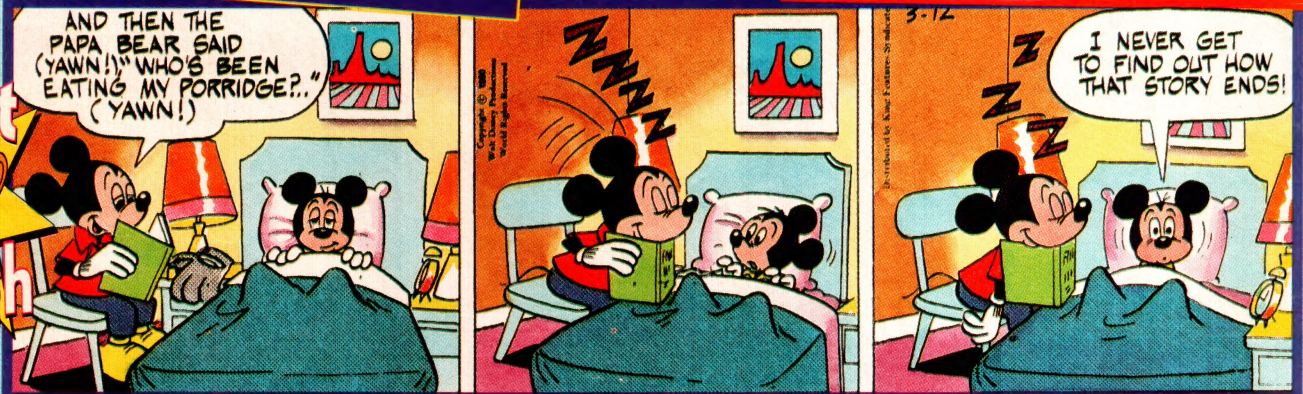
