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























Watch my little finger!

"Ferdy - which one is the Ace of Hearts?" Ferdy, having watched Morty's little finger, picked up the Ace immediately.




... Morty swirled the cards about again, having already noted a new one and keeping his little finger on it. This trick, performed quickly with your accomplice, looks very impressive to an audiencel


CHIEF O'HARA CALLING ALL COPS!




