Instead of buying expensive fireworks, why don't you go to a fireworks display in your area! You'll save money, see much better fireworks - and keep safe, too!

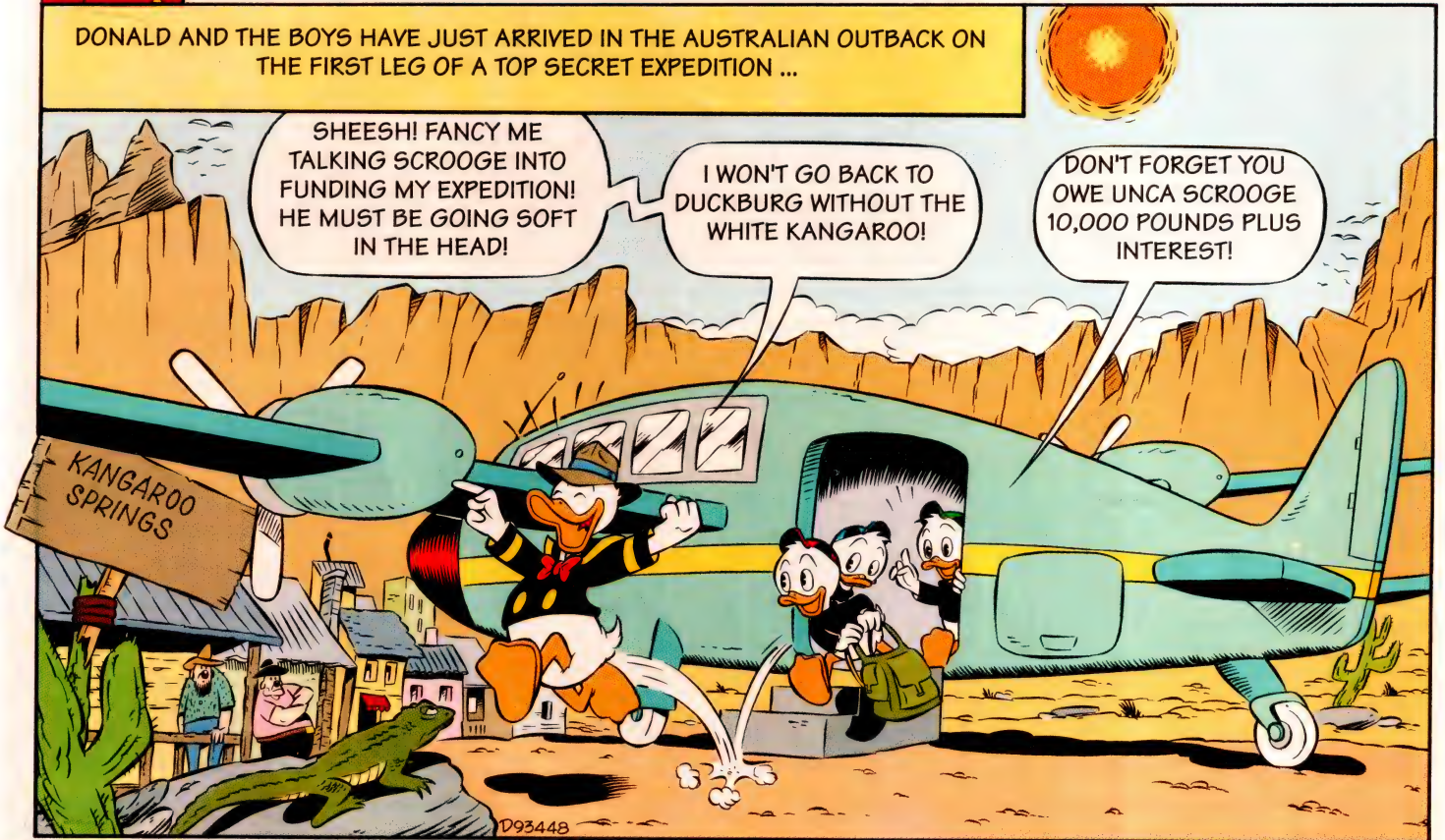
