


Hi, everyone!

have special magical powers, but she doesn't believe me - perhaps she will when I make her disappear!












Donald Duck thinks he has come up with a puzzle that will really keep you thinking! If you folded up the triangle, which one of the pyramids would you make?

Glue a plastic cup to the centre of a tray.

Cut a circle the same size as the mouth of the cup out of thin card. Glue the circle to the inside of a scarf or handkerchief.


> When your audience is ready, have your assistant bring you the tray with the cup glued on top. Pull out your scarf and drape it over the cup.

> > Hold your secret disc which gives the illusion that you are holding the cup. As you appear to lift the cup, your assistant should tilt the tray towards their body and walk off stage without looking down.


Take a couple of steps towards your audience. Keep looking at the scarf as if you are really holding the beaker.




Say some magic words, take one corner of the scarf and shake it. Presto - the cup has vanished!































