Conclusions:

- a. Bonus bidding best for proven deposits of known technology.
- b. Bonus bidding not applicable where exploration of virgin territory or considerable research is necessary.
- c. Research expenditure bidding best where much research is needed.
- d. Exploration expenditure bidding might be used in exploration of virgin territory.
- e. Royalty rate bidding results in misallocation of resources and poor conservation of resources.
- f. Recommends research expenditure bidding for oil shale until technology is proved.
