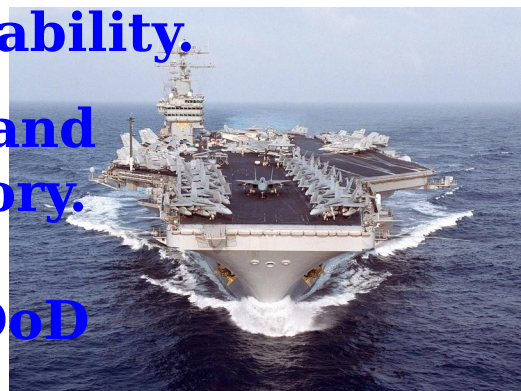

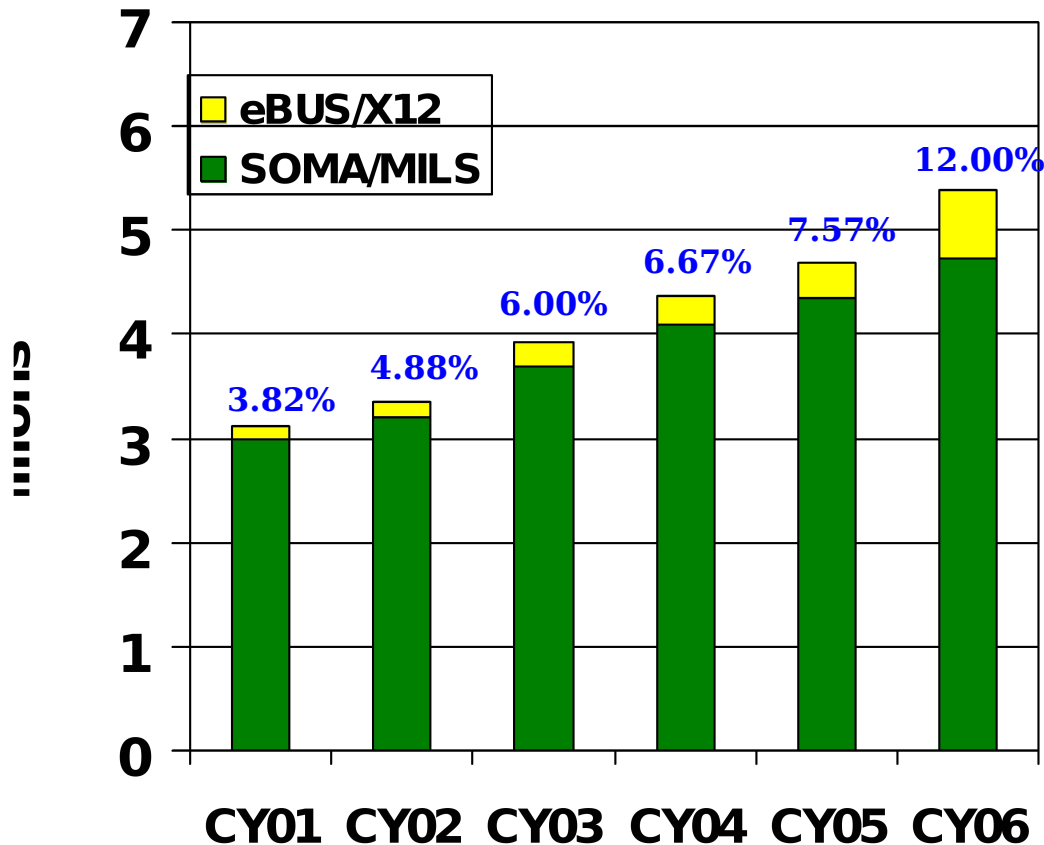

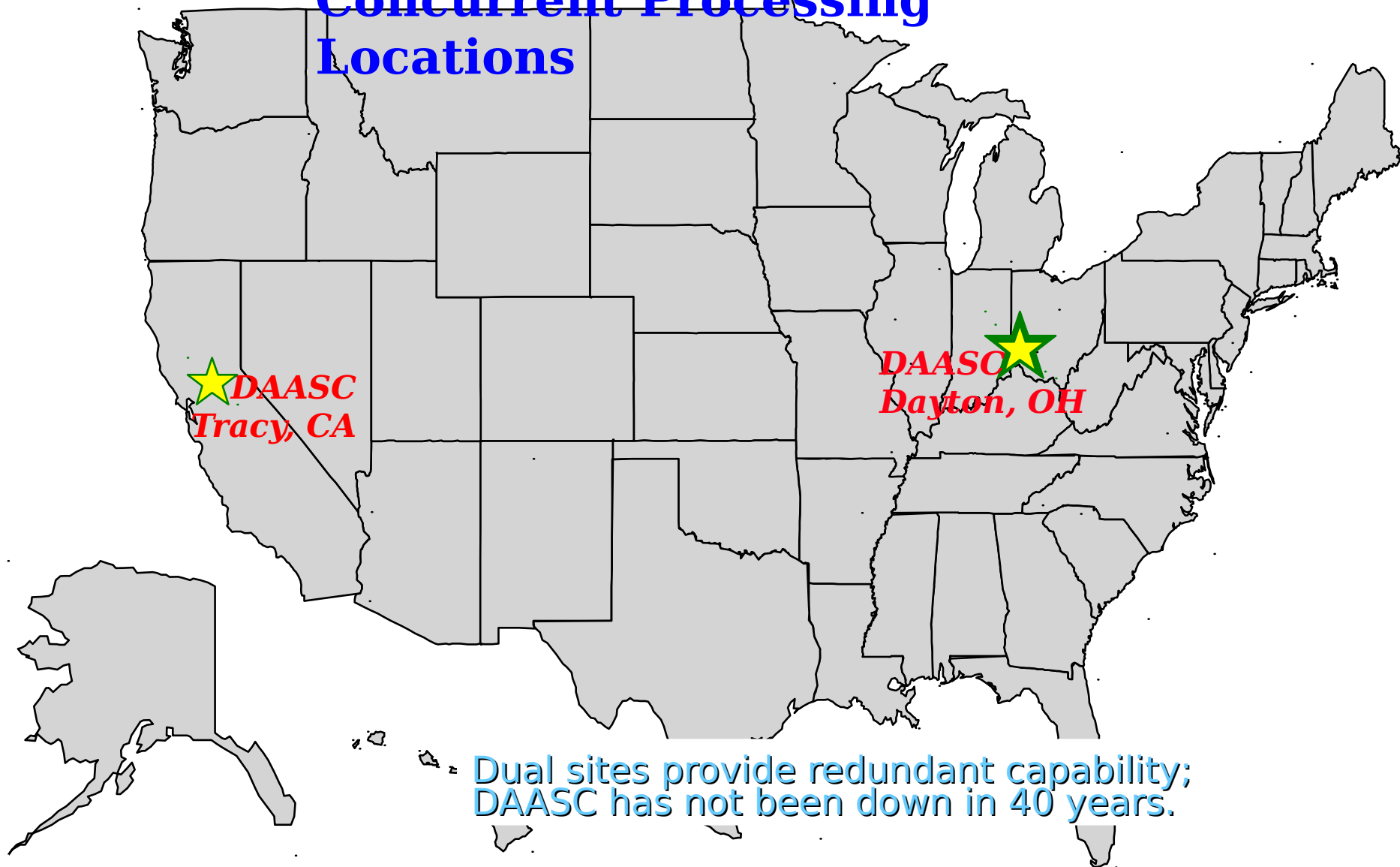

DAASC SUPPORT ROLE

DAASC Provides:

- Functional knowledge of DoD logistics processes.**

DAASC SUPPORT ROLE (Cont.)

DAASC Provides:

- **DLMS Program management support, to include:**
 - **Logical map development, maintenance, and testing**
(Custom map development as required).
 - **Support to individual Jump-Start initiatives.**
 - **Establishment and management of testing schedules.**
 - **Coordination of integration testing with Service PM and trading partners, prior to migration.**
 - **Evaluation of test results and assistance with problem resolution.**
 - **Control and maintenance of customer profiles and routing tables.**
 - **Collection of MILS and DLMS transaction volume**

DLMS TRANSITION MANAGEMENT

DAASC Customer Profiles and Routing Tables:

- **Movement, distribution and disposition of data/transactions through DAASC processing is controlled by a system of Customer Profiles and Routing Tables that have been developed and refined over many years.**

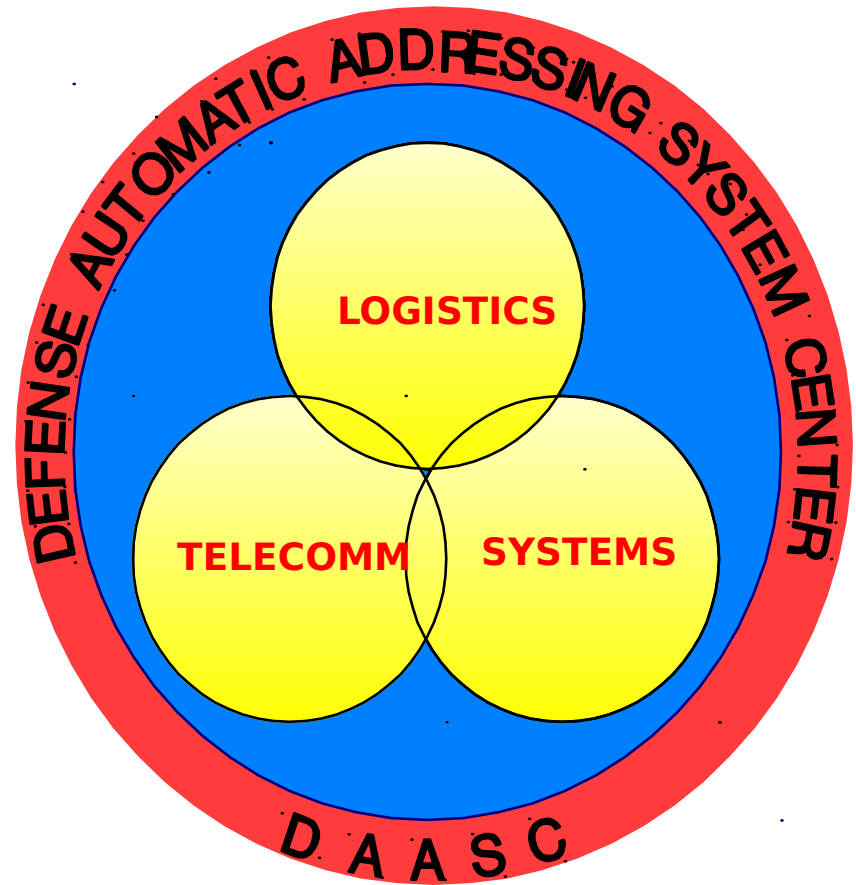
DAASC TESTING
