

Process Evolution



- As the process matures, the PWS has evolved and we modified the approach to meet the requirements.
- Providing efficiencies through competition and innovations in PWS development.



Challenges



Impacts on the PWS include:

- Level of Detail required
- Data Gathering
- Consistency with similar studies in the Agency



Level of Detail



- Gathering more detailed information
- Have definitive starting and stopping points for each requirement
- Developing more comprehensive language to explain some of the requirements that may be exceptions to the rule



Data Collection



- Identify Data Required
- Identify Sources of Data
- Establish Manual Data Collection Methods if Needed
- Gather Data
- Continue Throughout the Process



Current Initiatives



- Delineate Requirements
- Conduct Pre-Planning initiatives to prepare for 12-18 month length of study period
- Comply with J-33 Report requirements
- PWS Team representation on SSEB



Challenges of Lessons Learned



- Developed more depth in the PWS
- Categorized detailed workload and Acceptable Performance Levels (APLs)
- Emphasized transition planning and development
