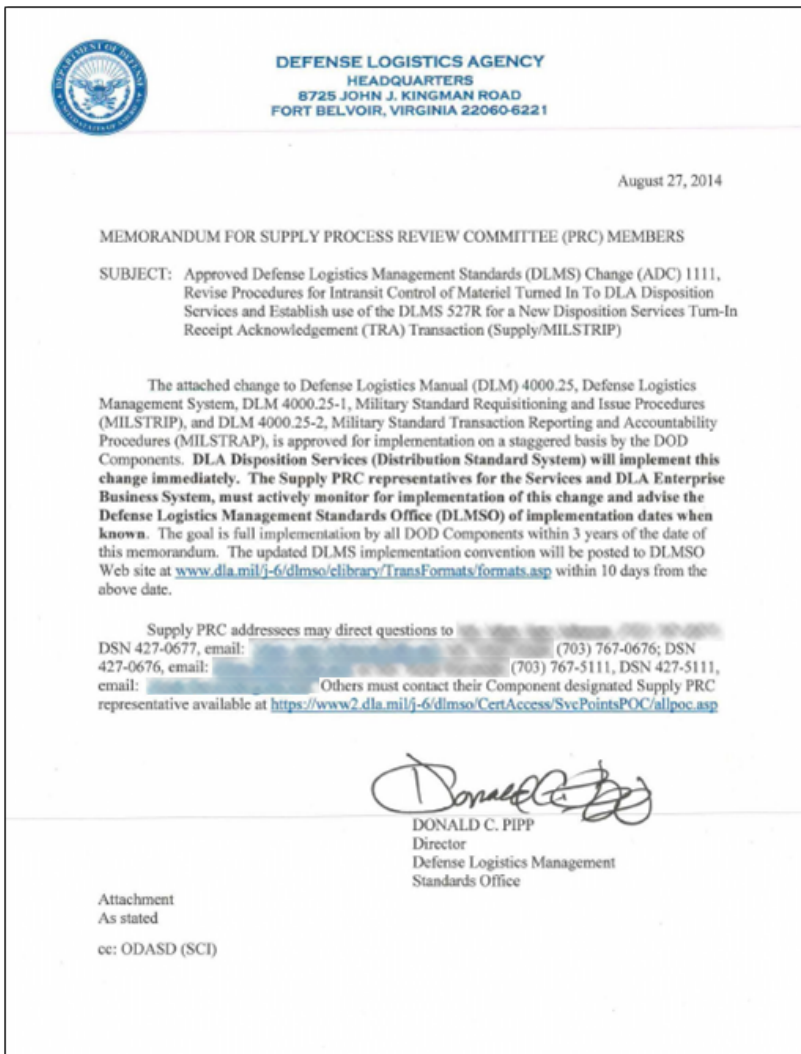

DLMS ADC 1111 Revise Procedures for Intransit Control of Materiel Turned In To DLA Disposition Services May 11, 2015



What Is Approved DLMS Change (ADC)



- 11 • New automated DLA-DS Turn-In Receipt Acknowledgement (TRA) transaction.
- TRA transaction is systemically triggered by processing DLA-DS Field Office when processing disposal turn-in documents (DTID) receipts into DSS.
- The new DLMS 527R TRA is confirmation that DLA Disposition Services field offices processed a receipt for the materiel turned in by DTID into the DSS.
- DOD Component customers would use the new DLMS 527R TRA transaction to document that DLA Disposition Services processed a Receipt transaction for the materiel to DLA Disposition Services ownership to close out the DOD Component customer's intransit property records.
- **NOTE:** TRA does not apply to materiel turned in to DLA Disposition Services via the Recycling Control Point (RCP)

527R TRA Rollout Timelines

527R TRA mapping and routing completed Nov 2014

DOD Component	Implementation Date
DLA Disposition Services (DSS)	Immediately.
DLA Transaction Services	DLMS 527R TRA mapping and routing implementation date to be provided. The WEBVLIPS visibility functionality is targeted for April 2015. Delayed implementation for the Logistics Data Gateway (LDG) enhancements is authorized, pending modernization of LDG to support DLMS transactions.
DLA EBS	DLA cannot provide implementation date for EBS until prioritization has occurred. The impact on audit readiness is noted and will be part of the prioritization consideration.
Army	Army cannot provide implementation date until prioritization has occurred.
Air Force	Unknown at time of ADC release. Air Force believes it will implement this calendar year for Air Force Retail Supply (Integrated Logistics Solution-Supply (ILS-S)).
Marine Corps	Target implementation date is no sooner than October 2017. AIS will need modification to receive and process the new 527 TRA transaction to update transit records as described in the ADC. The impact on audit readiness is noted and will be part of the prioritization consideration.
Navy	No implementation information provided at time of ADC release.




Web Visual Logistics Information Processing System - Windows Internet Explorer
 controlled query system that is useable from any Internet browser. It is a Logistics On-line Tracking System (LOTS), a Transaction Services Information System (TSIS) that displays the life cycle of a logistics action. The WEBVLIPS system is used to track material into the DoD pipeline, until the material is posted to the destination depot or disposal. WEBVLIPS also has the capability to track reports of excesses to the destination depot or disposal. WEBVLIPS interfaces with the MILRI, Source of Supply, DoD Project Code, Port Code, Transaction Status, Issue Code, Signal Code, Hold Code, Advice Code, Condition Code, and Mode Code. It is the user in tracking a requisition or excess through its life cycle. Help is available to assist in understanding MILS data. Program management and subject matter experts are available to assist and continue to work with customers to ensure their requirements are satisfied.

WEBVLIPS CAPABILITIES:

- Provides a simple user interface, allowing the Transaction Services customer to track requisitions
- Provides quick response time to subscriber inquiries
- Query by: Document Number, Unit Activity, Project Code, TCN, or NSN
- Run pre-stored reports based on a document number, address/unit id, & part number
- User requested scans to perform studies of DOD-Wide usage
- Query Life Cycle of specific transactions
- Receive information about materiel management actions, such as requisitions, supply/shipment status and customer confirmations

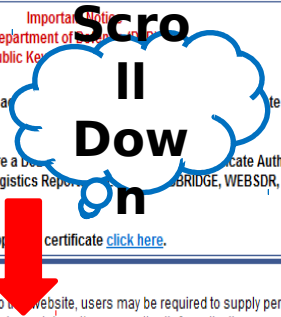

SAR TITLE	DESCRIPTION
DAMES	DAMES is a PC based software package that provides a means to input requisitions into the DoD Logistics pipeline and receive status transactions back along with the capability to transmit/receive narrative traffic. Users may use the fill in the blank forms or import data/messages through a Utilities menu.

WEBLOTS ** Agreement Required **	Machine-to-machine account owners have restricted permissions based upon the particular application. Accounts may be restricted to "read only" access (pull) or "read/write" access (pull/push). File contents and file naming conventions are application specific. PKI (Public Key Infrastructure) authentication is available. It is very important that you include who your DLA Transaction Services Point of Contact is in the SAR Reason. Failure to include the POC will result in a delay of processing your request. You must also include a specific reason for submitting the SAR.
WEBREQ ** CAC required **	Web-based requisitioning system (WEBREQ). Provides customers with access to the World Wide Web a means to input material requisitions into Transaction Services directly via the Web and receive status transactions via the same method.
WEBSDR ** CAC required **	The DoD Web Supply Discrepancy Reporting (SDR) system will provide a web-based entry method for SDRs, routing for web submissions and logistics transactions according to business rules, any-to-any translation to support unique and standard transaction formats, information exchange between the action office and the shipper, SDR resolution responses, capture of SDR and response management statistics and assimilation of SDR metrics along with Customer Wait Time/Logistics Response Time in support of perfect order fulfillment. This process reduces manual SDR form creation and provides an automated process for tracking SDR response information. This SAR will also allow an account on WEBVLIPS and DAASINQ. Please logon onto these systems every 30 days.
WEBVLIPS ** CAC required **	Web-based transaction tracking system for current, open transactions and completed transactions for up to 60 days after closure. Enables customers to track their requisitions or excesses through the entire life cycle. Has data from all services, agencies, ICPs, depots and vendors.

CONTRACTOR SPONSORSHIP REQUIREMENTS
 Contractors requesting access to must be sponsored by their U.S. Government Contracting Officer (KO) or Contracting Officer's Representative (COR). A SAR is required for each contractor user. In addition to a SAR, the KO or COR must provide a letter on their official activity letterhead that includes the KO or COR signature and KO or COR title in the signature block and the following information:

- Customer Name
- Last 4 digits of customer's SSN
- Telephone Number
- Fax Number
- Email Address
- Contract Number
- Commercial and Government Entity (CAGE) Code of company
- Contract beginning and ending dates

Current WEBVLIPS data elements are based off of "mandatory elements" required as per ADC 1111. Discussions are ongoing with DLA-TS regarding inclusion of optional data elements to VLIPS as listed in ADC 1111 or, wait for their inclusion into LDG

*527R TRA will incorporate small arms serialization info in mapped version of the transaction from DSS to DAAS. Query results in LDG probable.

NOTE: WEBVLIPS only stores transaction data for up to 6 months. Older queries will be visible via LDG once 527R TRA has been added to the system. Timeline not yet determined.
