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CLSP is designed to enhance the capability of Brigade and Battalion Unit Ministry Teams (UMT) to carry supplies in a consolidated package on the battlefield and to function as a workstation and portable altar







- It is designed to carry ecclesiastical, administrative and automation supplies:
  - two "Chaplain Kit, Consumable"
  - a laptop computer
  - portable printer
  - peripheral devices
  - manuals, bond paper
  - administrative supplies
- It is designed to be water and dust resistant.







- CLSP is designed to function as a workstation.
- As a workstation it can be used:
  - with the table attached to the desk section (2 legs) or
  - with the table in a freestanding configuration (4 legs).
  - Includes a folding chair
  - At desk height or enhanced desk height (for tall persons),









- CLSP is designed to function as a portable altar:
  - Legs extend to 40"
  - Includes a set of washable altar linens
    - Seasonal hangings (red, green, purple, white)
    - Fair linen
    - Carry bag attaches to the underside of the table/altar.
