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# Supplier Access – Account Establishment

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- All cFolders users must have a DIBBS account
- Upon account creation, Suppliers have access to non-restricted data (Distribution Statement A)
- Suppliers with US/Canadian Joint Certification Program (JCP) certification have appropriate access to restricted data (Distribution Statements C & D)
- Suppliers have the ability to download license agreement application forms from cFolders
- A DLA POC manually tracks and approves additional access to data covered by license

# Restricted Drawing Access

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- Requires certification through the Joint US/Canadian Certification Program (JCP)
- Establishes eligibility of U.S. and Canadian contractors to receive technical data under control of DoD or the Canadian Department of National Defense
- Limits access to military critical sensitive data
