Impact of New Circular

- Preliminary Planning
 - Determine the Activities and grouping
 - Obtain workload data
 - Develop work units
 - Identify quantifiable outputs of activites
 - Develop performance standards
 - Develop data collection systems







- Relationships
- Trust but verify
- Learn the business under study & the Corporate mission
- Learn what the business does versus what Corporate thinks it is doing
- Workforce is important, but management decides



- Learn the outputs
 - How are they measures
 - What data can you capture
 - Can they be gamed
 - Are you measuring the right outcome
 - Can the actual versus systemic be checked



- Learn the language
 - Everyone brings their own dictionary
 - Determine the words of art
 - Use a neutral language if necessary
- Detective Colombo
 - Play a little dumb, but let them know your not
 - Always ask one more question

 - Services
 - Training
- Security
 - Responsibility versus Impact
