Depot Maintenance Marking Strategy

- **Short Term Strategy (FY04-FY07)**
 - **Phase approach to marking**
 - **Mark items that are serial tracked items that have data plates**
 - **Mark all manufactured items that have data plates**
 - **Task Components to provide marking strategy for in-service parts**
 - **Tailoring UID guidelines for in-service parts**
 - **Develop funding strategy and alternatives**
 - **Identify and recommend marking methods**
 - **Develop metrics for part marking**
 - **Establish business rule/requirements**
- **Long Term Strategy (FY08 - beyond)**
 - **Require marking of all serialized parts including DPM items**

Depot Maintenance Marking Challenges

- **Funding**
 - **Must be in the SPG for the 06 POM**
 - **Competes with other programs**
 - **Engineering drawing changes**
- **UID and part marking are not core competencies at the Depots**
 - **Training and resources**
