
- Current MILS Process

## **MILSCAP**

- Uses 80-Character MILS Formats
- Constrains Functionality
- Curtails Use of Commercial Standards
- Prohibits UID Tracking
- Impedes Business Transformation Goals
- Restricts Use of New Data Requirements






