



Former Secretary of Defense William J. Perry DMLSS - Best Example of Successful Outsourcing in DoD

Outsourcing: The purpose of the Department's outsourcing initiative is to sustain or improve readiness, generate savings for modernization, and improve the quality and efficiency of support to our men and women in uniform. It involves the transfer of a function previously performed in a government facility to an outside, private sector provider. Doing so offers us significant opportunities to generate savings and perform tasks more efficiently. For instance, a system in which medical suppliers deliver products directly to their DoD customers, rather than to a warehouse for storage and subsequent distribution, has cut delivery time by 75-90 percent and cut costs to taxpayers by 25 to 35 percent. There are, of course, limits. The Department will not pursue outsourcing activities that compromise our core warfighting missions.



Prime Vendor Business Practice -The Highest Payback Area For DMLSS




EDI Key To Government/Industry Partnership (One Hour Order To Confirmation)



Prime Vendor Order And Bill Payment Process





SUBJECT: Streamlining and Improving Medical Logistics Interfaces for Financial Management

Your memorandum of June 9, 1995, forwarded an issue paper on streamlining and improving standard interfaces between the Defense Medical Logistics Standard Support (DMLSS) system and the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS). To accomplish this objective, your issue paper recommended that a working group be established.

The working group would be chartered to improve electronic communications and eliminate redundancy between the automated systems used by the DMLSS and the DFAS. The product of the working group would include: (1) an identification of the minimum number of inter-system transactions needed to pay vendors and manage DoD accounts; (2) a reduction in the number of data elements exchanged between the two systems; and (3) the creation of a common format for computer-to-computer exchange of information.

I endorse your proposal to create a working group. Because the focus of the working group's efforts is related to operational (vice policy) issues, I have requested the Director of DFAS advise you of his nominee(s) to the working group.

A summary of the business practice changes and their impact on the DFAS operations are included in the attachment. In addition, a change in reopensibility for transaction processing is also detailed in the attachment.








Billing Code Universal Product Number (UPN)




