

Your quick desk guide to enrolling and/or making changes

How do lenroll in TSP?

Are you a brand new employee to civil service and/or an employee who has been rehired?

You have three opportunities to elect TSP. They are as follows:

•You may complete a TSP-1 on your first day of employment and turn it into the CPAC office.

OR

•Within your first pay period of employment you may complete the TSP-1 and mail it to the ABC Office at:

SWCPOC, ABC 301 Marshall Avenue, Fort Riley, KS 66442-5004

OR

•Within 60 days from your Entrance on Duty (EOD), make election through ABC-C IVRS or **EBIS** automated systems, which may be accessed through the CPAC Home Page.

If you do not take advantage of these three opportunities.....next slide.

How do lenroll (Cont'd)

If the answer is **NO**, then:

•You must wait until Open Season which is twice a year:

•May 15th - July 31st and

•November 15th - January 31st

•Log into ABC-C IVRS or EBIS automated systems to make your election.

NOTE: The CPAC office is unable to accept any hard copy TSP-1 forms from other than new employees.



Before making any benefit elections/changes, you must first establish a POE account. Instructions for creating a POE account are located at hyperlink.



Thrift Savings Plan Information: TSP Open Season

During the TSP open seasons, you may start or change your biweekly contributions to TSP and/or indicate how you want your future biweekly contributions to be invested in the three TSP funds. You may also elect to stop your TSP biweekly contributions during an open season or any time outside of an open season. Go to <u>Stop Your TSP Contributions</u> for more information.

You may have only one projected TSP transaction at a time. If you have a projected TSP transaction, and want to make another election, you must first <u>Void the existing projected</u> <u>TSP transaction</u>.



THRIFT SAVINGS PLAN (TSP) OPEN SEASON


DO NOT USE THIS MODULE if you would like to stop your TSP contributions. You should use the Stop Your TSP Contributions module from the Thrift Savings Plan Personal Transactions Main Menu.

To begin TSP Open Season Business Transactions:



If you do not remember your PIN, click PIN on the toolbar.

NOTE: If you've never personalized your PIN, the default PIN is month and year of birth ex. **0568 for May 1968**. This was established in July 2000 when ABC use at Fort Monroe became mandatory. New password length has a minimum of 6 digits.



Once you get into this section the rest should be self-explanatory. Remember to print your completed form for your records.

TSP changes are effective IAW the charts located at: Pay Period Charts or CPAC TSP page.

New TSP Changes Effective May 2001 Open Season

Beginning May 1, 2001, Allocation of TSP contributions among the various investment funds will no longer be able to be processed through ABC-C. Allocations will have to be processed through the TSP web site (www.tsp.gov) or via their phone system (Thrift line 504-255-8777). There will be no limit on the number of contribution allocations that participants may request, but only one contribution allocation can be made effective on any given business day. Employees will be able to use electronic media (i.e. the TSP web site or the Thriftline) or by submitting an original* Form TSP-50, Investment Allocation. Participants are encouraged to use the more efficient electronic media to request contribution allocations. Electronic and paper contribution allocation requests will generally be effective no later than 2 business days after receipt. The new TSP Form 50, Investment Allocation, will be used for both contribution allocation and interfund transfer requests. TSP-50 will not be available at the TSP Web site to download because the form is designed to be read by an optical scanner. Photocopies of the form are not acceptable.
