





- "Both students and unit leaders responses were generally positive and described the course as an improvement over the previous paper-based correspondence course.

•Issues raised:

- Awarding of retirement points for successful completion of each phase of training.
- Develop policy for states to compensate students for time spent in synchronous training.
- •Restructure specific course material to separate long lessons into several shorter lessons.
- Provide asynchronous study material on CD ROM as an alternative to online coursework and downloads.
- Students reported nearly 100% of course time was spent interacting with peers and instructor.

 - The AC³-DL was awarded an excellence in DL programming award for its cutting edge use of distributed learning.



Other De Mitiatives

- Advanced Distributed Learning (ADL)—all converted courseware available to entire Army through an ADL server.
 Can be used for self-development, refresher, and sustainment training.
- Interactive Motor Pool (IMP)—developed to provide proof of principle that maintenance can be performed at a distance using a virtual environment. Prototype is complete as of Jan 02. The concept is workable and Knox is seeking funds to add all 9 families of vehicles to complete the virtual learning environment.
- Virtual Sand Table (VST)—being developed for training practical exercises and testing combat tactics for the Advanced Noncommissioned Officer Course. Will be used for AC and RC. If funds become available, additional course tasks will be added so that this virtual environment can be used across five courses, replacing outdated terrain boards.


Digital Training Facilities


