Transportation School "GMATS"

- GMATS is a wholly-owned government entity of the U. S. Department of Transportation which is funded without direct government support.
- Revenues to operate GMATS are generated through tuition and lodging fees.
- GMATS is designed to support the overall mission of the Academy in its service to the maritime and transportation industry.





The Challenge

- 1999 DOT- MTS Study shows a doubling of freight carrying demand on America's transportation system by 2020.
- 1998 The LATTS Report shows a tripling of trade volume with Latin America by 2020.
- The freight volume increase will cause a quadrupling of volume on land based systems.

Partnership in Education and Training

- Courses to be offered for AD and USAR/NG (some courses can be given in conjunction with drill weekends):
 - HAZMAT CFR 49 Shipping Certification Course
 - Web Development Course
 - Professional Development Courses
 (2 week ATs for Army Watercraft Personnel)
 - Courses as determined by USARC





- Our facilities can be utilized by Army personnel to teach the following computer courses:
 - Transportation Coordinator-Automated Command and Control Information System (TC-ACCIS)
 - Military Standard Transportation and Movement Procedures (MILSTAMP)
 - Army Training Requirements and Resources System (ATRRS)
