
Lessons Learned for MS 3



- Working together early:
 - Builds essential relationships
 - Allows communication channels to mature
- Demonstration sites played crucial role in reviewing key documentation procedures
- Brings resolution to issues Via problem reports
- PMO support team key (right arm to resolve realtime issues)
- On site for extended period of time
 - Had it right in MS 1&2 Support structure & relationships were effective
 - Use same strategy for MS 3



MS 3 VIOC Expected Outcomes




Rock Drill and SIT already completed by time of VIOC

- Test functional process and systems changes in a live, linked, tactical environment
 - AC and RC participants
 - Garrison and field environment (deployed)
 - Supply/Maintenance/Financial
- Evaluate tactics, techniques and procedures
- Build Army understanding and confidence
- Refine course, correct for full fielding





Key MS 3 Changes



- RON/DON:
 - Functionality restored in SARSS
 - Enable CCSS to see/record backorders in RON/DON environment
- SSF changes in SARSS 2AD
- Partial issues enabled at field or National level
- SARSS-1 to SARSS 2AC/B reconciliation



Total Package Fielding


- Meeting being held 6 Feb 01
- Participants: HQ DA, AMC, CEAC, ASA (FM&C), TRADOC, FORSCOM
- 12 Identified Issues
- Bottom Line: SSF does not negatively impact on TTP process or funding

HAZMAT

- Working with DA ODCSLOG and MACOMs
- Potential issues involving stockage/issue of non-NSN items
- Evaluating Procedural changes and 2d/3d Order Impacts to the field Army to include MACOM unique procedures
- Will continue to identify potential procedural changes and solutions
 - -- Joint CASCOM-DA ODCSLOG chaired SSF Rock Drill
 - -- III Corps and COSCOM/Division level meetings in prep for VIOC



Summary



- MS 1&2 implementation well underway, efforts now shifting to MS3
- Deliberate process culminated in GOWG approval of MS3 goals, schedule, and location
- Continue to refine MS 3 conversion and process flows
- Continue to work closely with MACOMs, CASCOM and the VIOC organizations
 - Identify issues impacting VIOC
 - Incorporate solutions
