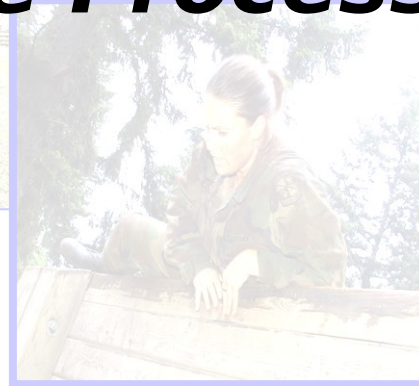
# Master List Selection Criteria

  - Allow DL redesign to be spread across several schools



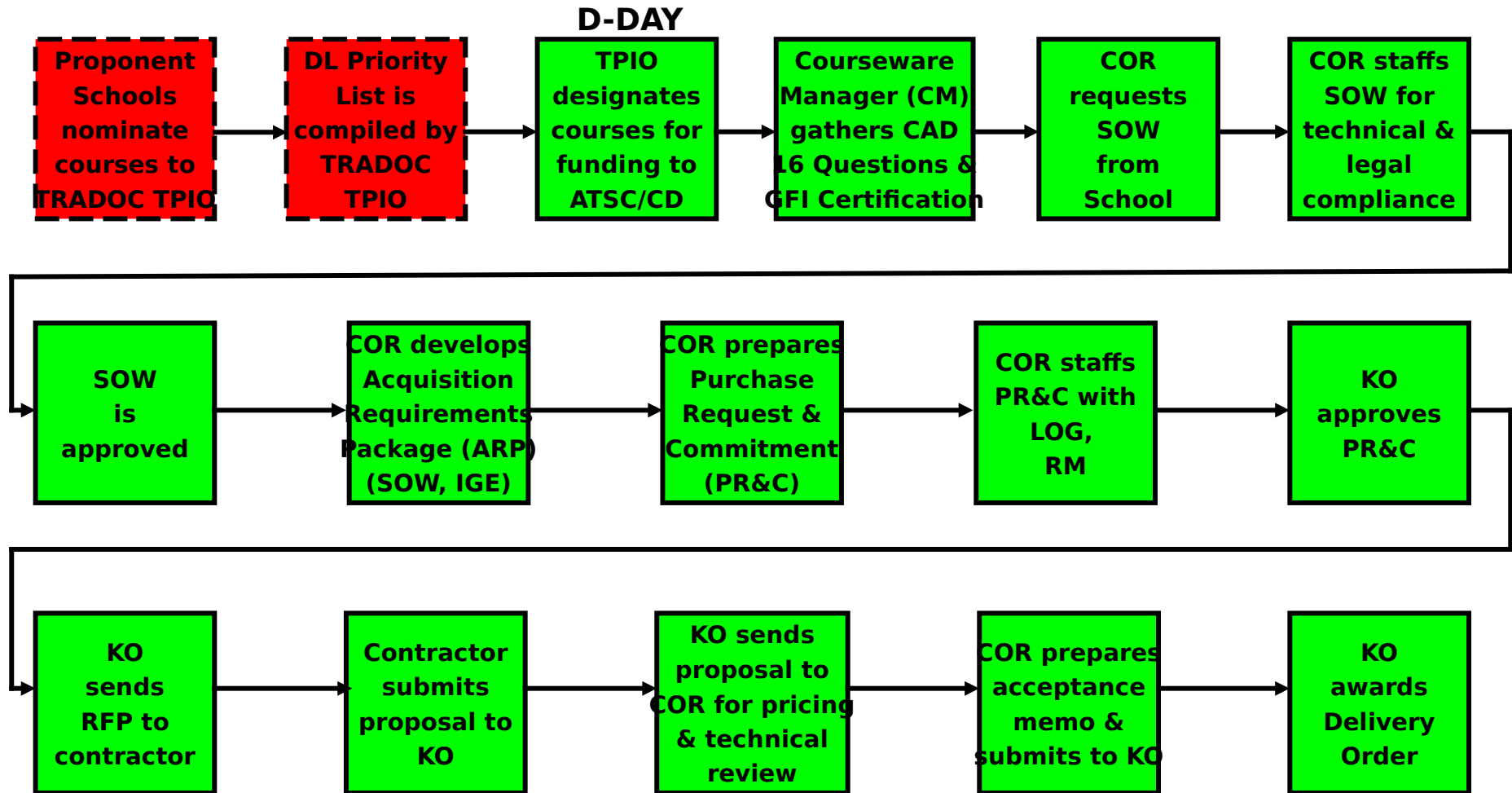

# AAA Recommendation A-1

## AAA Recommendation

- TRADOC initiate a complete review to update the distance learning CW master priority list.

## TRADOC Response

- Will revisit the original process on a periodic basis to confirm list is current beginning with the FY04 List

## AAA Recommended

### Actions

- Use a study group to include all MACOMs
- Validate that all courses listed in ATRRS are on the list and conducive to DL redesign
- Ensure that all nominations received from MACOMs are considered for the priority list
- Establish procedures and milestones to ensure reviews occur on a regular basis to ensure master list is current

### TRADOC Actions

- TRADOC will host a complete CW master priority list review in April 04 to confirm accuracy of the approved list.
- Review group will include the AAA minimum actions and that it meets the needs of the Army.

# AAA Recommendation A-2

## AAA Recommendation

- Establish controls over the process used to delete courses from the CW master priority list.

## AAA Recommended Actions

- Controls should include formal guidelines to the schools that define the factors that should be considered to determine if a course should be removed, the supporting justification required to be submitted and the procedures for reviewing requests to remove courses from the list to ensure they are appropriate.

## TRADOC Response

- Will develop policy to formalize the process for CW deletion and will publish NLT 3Q, FY03.

## TRADOC Actions

- TP 350-70-12 (Managing CW Production and Implementation) formalizes the process for CW deletion ~ Chapter 2, para 2-2.

# AAA Recommendation A-3

## AAA Recommendation

- TRADOC revise procedures to establish an integrated approach to CW prioritization that ensures the courses that provide the highest readiness and ROI payback receive the highest priority for funding.

## AAA Recommended Actions

- Methodology should include an analysis for the combined benefits of readiness that each course offers and the ROI based upon throughput data from ATRRS.

## TRADOC Response

- ROI is more than just dollars saved; includes intangibles: unit readiness, troop morale and training effectiveness. Together they combine to form the basis for leaders to make funding decisions each fiscal year.
- Funding is distributed based on command priorities. Funding is applied to courses so as not to overload the capabilities of a single school and to allow increased DL design to be spread across several schools.

## TRADOC Actions

- Adhere to current CW prioritization process.
- Adopting a funding process that considers ROI as the primary decision-making criterion ignores the decision maker's responsibility to ensure a trained and ready force.
