

 - Don't overload the capabilities of a single school
 - Allow DL redesign to be spread across several schools





AAA Recommendation

 TRADOC revise procedures to establish an integrated approach to CW prioritization that ensures the courses that provide the highest readiness and ROI payback receive the highest priority for funding.

AAA Recommended

•Methodology shold in the combined benefits of readiness that each course offers and the ROI based upon throughput data from ATRRS.

TRADOC Response

- ROI is more than just dollars saved; includes intangibles: unit readiness, troop morale and training effectiveness. Together they combine to form the basis for leaders to make funding decisions each fiscal year.
- Funding is distributed based on command priorities. Funding is applied to courses so as not to overload the capabilities of a single school and to allow increased DL design to be spread across several schools.

TRADOC Actions

- Adhere to current CW prioritization process.
- Adopting a funding process that considers ROI as the primary decisionmaking criterion ignores the decision maker's responsibility to ensure a trained and ready force.

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
