- Safety Goals
 - Prevent Accidents and Manage Risk
 - Safety Understranding and Risk Management Integration
- Core Competencies
 - Provide Technical SME safety & occupational health (SOH) and risk management support to entire organization; and
 - Advise and assist the commander on technical and managerial SOH and risk management issues.
- Essential Safety Support Functions / Processes:
 - Integration: SOH program staff management oversight, policy/guidance, safety awareness and risk management, career program.
 - <u>Information</u>: Collect, analyze, and advise / disseminate (education-- hazards, risks, controls / countermeasures, and lessons learned).
 - <u>Evaluate</u>: Independent and unbiased (inspect, investigate, assess).

Safety Staff Roles Support to Training

- Adequate safety staff coverage of training operations
 - Training site analysis: risk assessment and hazard

controls / countermeasures

- Inspections and review risk assessments
- Advise, assist and maintain situational awareness
 - Collateral Duty Safety Officer Program
- Training support infrastructure
- Preventive countermeasures-- Maintenance & repair
- Corrective actions-- Hazard tracking & abatement
- Capture all accidents FM 100-14, Risk management
 - Assess effectiveness of controls
