

# Proper Planning Prevents Poor Performance⁵(P)

- What is the purpose of survey
  - A scheduled event
  - A purported problem that requires validation
  - A political necessity

# **Proper Planning Prevents** Poor Performance (P)


- Anticipate problems with distribution and collection
  - Accurate email addresses
    - ► School registration process
    - >ATRRS Data (School Registrars)
  - Strategize distribution process
    - ➤ Define if possible, the location of your sample
    - ➤ Cover memo with link
    - ➤ Personalized email from CM with link
    - ➤ Use of AKO
    - ➤Use of ARI Server
    - Contacting units
      - ❖Use of CMD SGM
    - Survey returning Soldiers to the School (i.e., BNCOC, ANCOC, CCC)
  - Test your link
    - ➤ Does the survey appear?
    - ➤ Can you collect data?
  - Best practices we ALL want to hear from y














# llaborate or Punish....the Role of QA


- Collaborate early on in the planning with TD/CM
  - Best source of information concerning the course
  - Collaborate on information possibly needed by TD/CM
  - Not a white glove inspection
    - ➤ Goal should be to make the course the "Best Course" possible for the Soldier
    - Provide draft executable of survey for comments (Pilot)
    - Provide official copies of all correspondence to your stake holders (i.e., EXSUM)
    - Communicate candidly and often














- Graduate bias
  - Do Soldiers know if they can perform a task to a specific standard?
    - ➤ Bias may be less for evaluation of BNCOC, ANCOC, CCC, etc.
    - ➤ Survey burden would be too great if conditions and standards were provided to Soldier
  - Do graduates represent your sample?
    - > TDA vs TOE
    - Deployed vs non-deployed





#### Supervisors of Graduates





- Supervisor bias
  - Do supervisors know if Soldiers who recently graduated from courses (AIT, BNCOC, ANCOC, etc.) can perform a task to a specific standard?
    - ➤ Bias may be less for supervisors evaluation of AIT, BNCOC, ANCOC, CCC, etc.
    - ➤ Survey burden would be too great if conditions and standards were provided to supervisor
  - Survey responses are not weighted



# **AUTOGEN Key Dates**

- Mandatory use of AUTOGEN (27 Jan 04)
- Version 2.5 released (29 Apr 04)
- Suspense for Version 2.5 comments (15 Jun 04)
  - 6 schools responded
  - ARI and TRADOC prioritized list
  - ARI/contractor negotiated costing
  - ARI and TRADOC finalized enhancements for Version 3.0
- Version 3.0 released (Oct/Nov 04)
- Usability testing of Version 3.0 (Oct/Nov 04)
- Suspense for Version 3.0 input for follow-on enhancements (Mar 05)




### Recent AUTOGEN Enhancements

- Functional course capability
- Common core capability (authorized use only)
- Spell checker on your local PC
- Determine who sees the optional questions
- Added statistical capability (EZ Report and Rapid Report)
- Survey respondents can see a list of all tasks in a subject area before responding
- AIT, BNCOC, and ANCOC can be single or multiple surveys
- Sample size calculator
- Data Tools: Deleting bad cases review
- Show counts in reports
- Printing option (other options being considered)






### Set Who Can See






### Set Who Can See (cont.)






## List of Tasks in Subject Area






### List of Tasks in Subject Area (cont.)




# Sample Size Calculator





# **Coming AUTOGEN Enhancements**

- Report for group differences between graduates and supervisors
- Number of bad cases will be reported
- Automatic date stamp will be added to the survey information page
- 3-way sort capability for analyzing bad cases
- Additional selection criteria will be added in the custom reports
- Appending data will be easier (1 button)



### **ARI Server Enhancements**

- Current features:
  - ARI Server Manual released (25 Jun 04)
  - Data is backed up twice daily and full system backup once a week
- Upcoming Enhancements:
  - Additional folders on server for EVL and JOB
  - New server is faster and provides more space
  - Download multiple survey files vs. one at a time
  - Survey end date notification change
  - Ability to add attachments in E-mail (i.e., letter from CG)
  - Automatic E-mail reminder
- E-mail will show the sender's name and school September
