

BCTP Exercise Standards



 "BCTP must engage all battlefield operating systems, encompass the entire battlespace, and simultaneously address asymmetric threats."

- Train to standard.
- Full BCTP coverage.
- Doctrine based AAR that guides leaders to accept responsibility.
- Stress of all BOS in decisive ground combat operations.
- Free thinking OPFOR with an equal chance to win.
- A tactical scenario where the outcome is not assured.
- The consequences of tactical decisions are fully played out.

BCTP Mission









WCOPFOR Impressions of the COE



- An OPFOR that fights with the aim of maintaining and expanding its regional dominance fundamentally changes the way that the OPFOR fights.
 - ✓ Tends to adopt more defensive posture; attacks on terms of own choosing
 - ✓ Applies combat systemology & exploits sanctuaries
 - Husbands forces

WCOPFOR Impressions of the COE



- An environment with complex terrain adds new variables which can not be neglected.
 Complex terrain affects: concealment, survivability, & trafficability.
- Non-echeloned, dispersed enemy with built in asymmetries and the other "complicators" found on the modern battlefield are presenting new challenges to the training audience.
- OPFOR component is the easiest to replicate.
