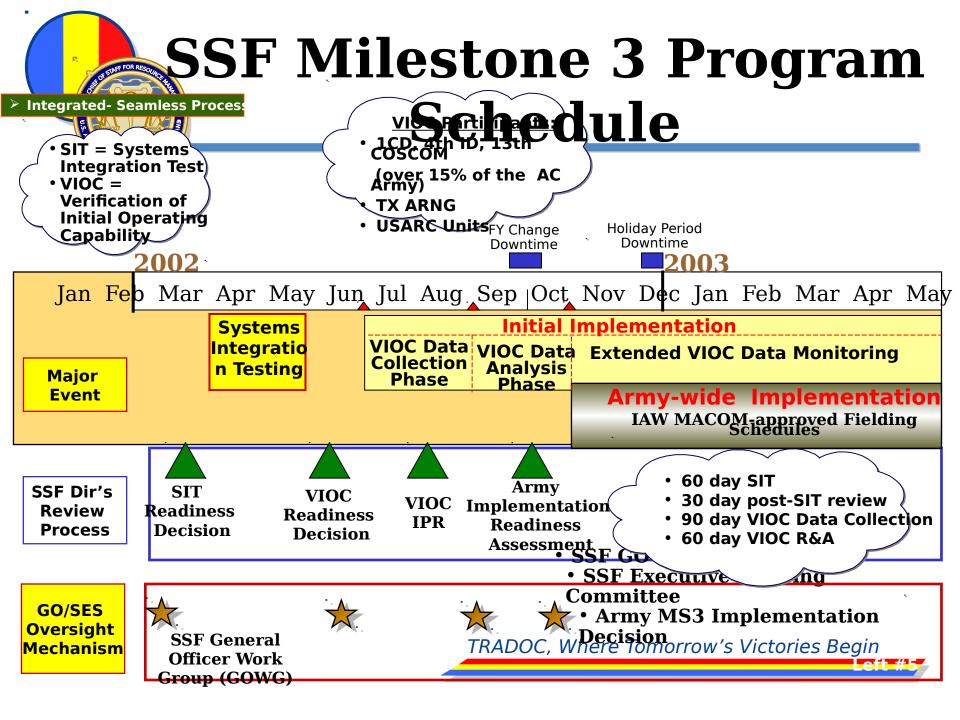
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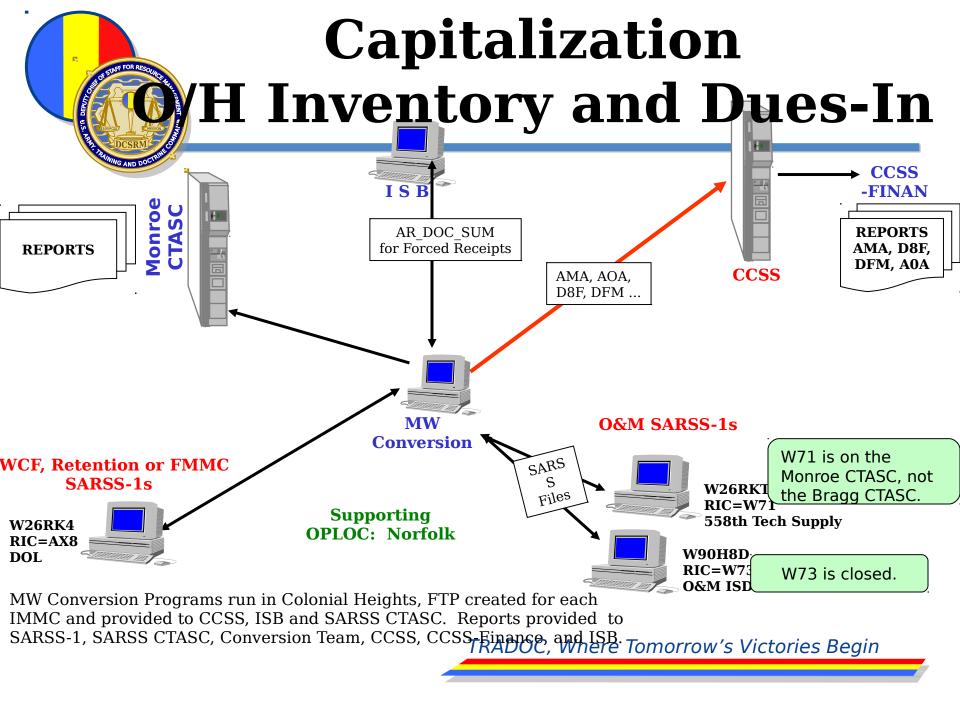

DOD Financial Management

On hand and order inventories of supplies financed by other appropriations and funds shall be recorded as contributed capital as required by 10 U.S.C. 2208 when the Supply Management business area undertakes management responsibility for the items. Bills for inventories on order at the time of the transfer shall be paid by the appropriation or fund ordering the item. This is appropriate since the appropriation or fund ordering the item was funded through the budget process to procure the item. As provided in 10 U.S.C. 2208, credits may not be made by an Supply Management business area to an

Milestone 3 Automation Changes

- → Field systems to release partial issues without first going to the National system
- → DS/RX (Ft Rucker only): Enable field automated systems to hold both O&M and AWCF inventories
- Automated reconciliation capability, SARSS-1 & 2AC/B
- → Enable RON/DON to work through the suite of SSF systems

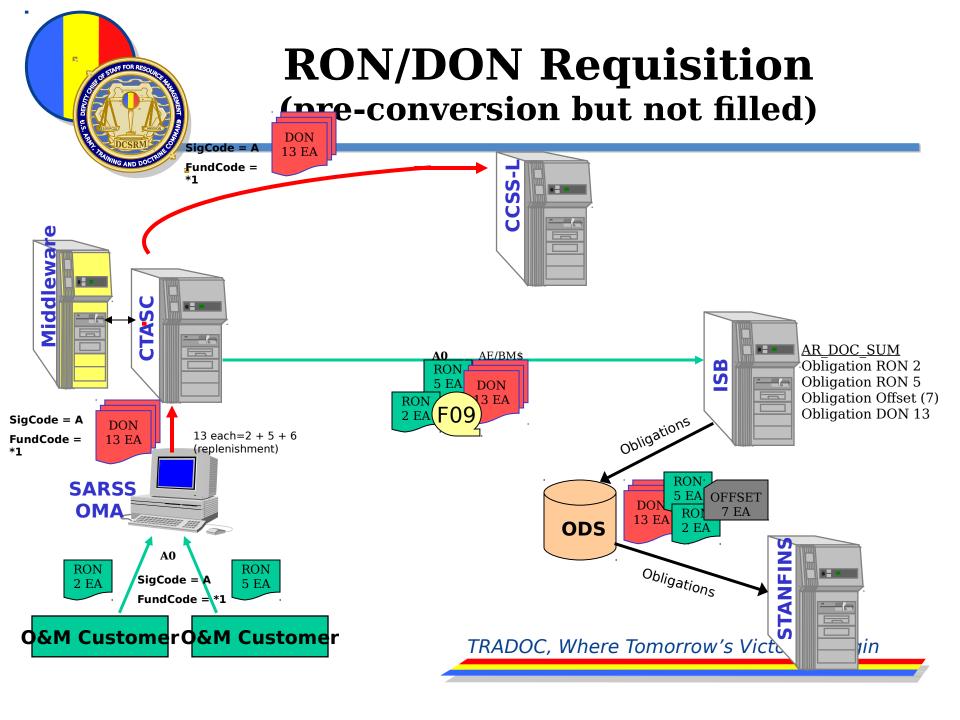


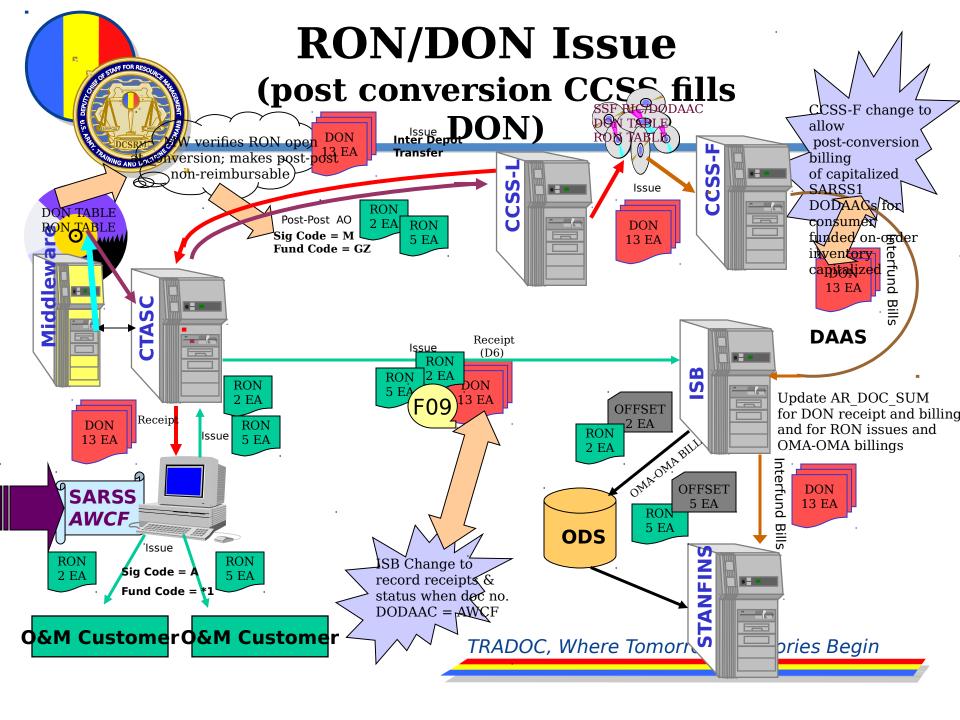

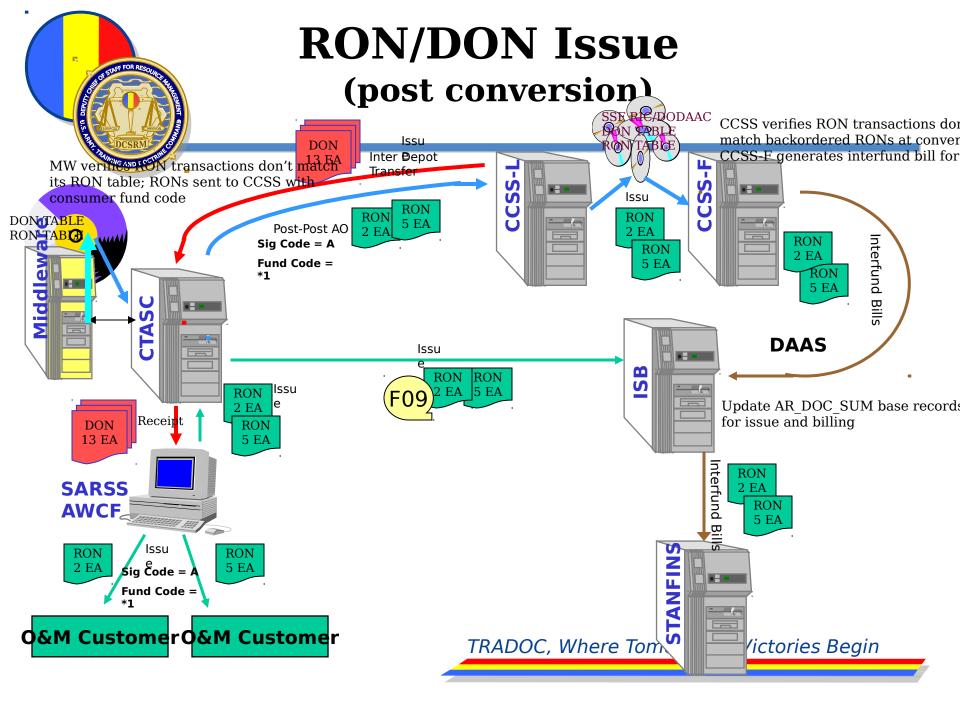
Requisition Order Number / Document Order (RON/DO)

- MSS business rule authorizes using NON/DON
- Tables for in-transit DONs and RONs are established during closed cycles and used by Middleware and CCSS to preclude "double billing"
- System changes to CCSS-F and ISB required to support business rule
- CCSS-F change
 - At MS3 conversion consumer funded on order inventories are capitalized
 - Use SSF RIC/DODAAC table and DON table to determine billing requirement
 - Allows post-conversion billing of capitalized SARSS1 DODAACs citing a consumer fund code
 - Release scheduled for June 02
- ISB changes for in-transit RON/DON records
 - ISB SCP 05-00, December 01
 - Continue to process status and receipt transactions for open OMA SARSS1 documents at conversion -- document number contains AWCF DODAAC
 - Process open RONs after conversion as OMA-OMA transactions TRADOC, Where Tomorrow's Victories Begin

A detailed write-up of system changes prepared by test;
 was provided to your installation via email. A brief describes changes are as follows:



Off Post Returns - CB3-ASSF-1025:

- -ISB logic changed to route D6A turn-in to AWCF transacti off post customers.
 - -- A new ISB output file, STFNS401 file, will be built daily automatically sent to ODS for routing to the correct of customer.



Obligations - CB3-ASSF-2003:

- -ISB logic changed to obligate for the amount and quantity commitment:
 - -- For customers of the AWCF, ISB **commits** on the initial
 - -- ISB **obligates** on the first status or receipt.
 - -- A0 quantity and amount is obligated and the commitment reversed.
 - -- Exceptions are the 4 following AE* status codes: BG, I B7 obligation will be for the amount and quantity o
 - -- Full amount of the order (A0) is obligated.



Obligations - CB3-ASSF-2003, continue

-ISB logic is changing the sort sequence for incoming AE transactions so that they will process in the correct order accurately reflect obligations. Sort sequence is as follows:

- -- Positive status with RIC matching dodaac-tbl ric-sg
- -- Cancellation status with RIC matching dodaac-tbl r
- -- BM with \$
- -- Positive status with RIC not matching dodaac-tbl ri
- -- Cancellation status with RIC not matching dodaac-



AE* Referrals - CB3-ASSF-2005:

- -ISB will now obligate upon receiving a status from a refe a customer of the AWCF is referred to another AWCF.
- -If ISB has an AR-DOC-SUM record with a commitment of status transaction from the shipping AWCF SARSS-1 will the commitment and create an obligation for the amount of the commitment.
- -Exceptions are status transactions BG, BJ, BH, and B7. obligation will be created for the quantity/amount of the transactions.



Populating Quantity Collected - BOSA-200

- -ISB logic corrected so that when processing issue transactions in ISB, the quantity will populate in the AR-IF-BLL-DTL record and in turn post to the AR-DOC-SUM.
- -Problem created when programming system changes in previous change package ICP 05-00. Problem affected installations with OMA boxes.

<u>DS/RX</u> (This SCR is for MS 3...Fort Rucker is the only installation with DS/RX capability) - CB3-ASSF-1029:

- -Under MS 3, DS/RX items will remain OMA funded but v stocked on an AWCF box. ISB will need to process these items as OMA transactions.
 - -- For DS/RX items to process as OMA transactions, Middleware will overlay the supplementary address RIC-STG-SITE with the new DS/RX OMA SARSS-1 DODAAC/RIC for both customer document numbers SARSS-1 DS/RX replenishment document numbers.

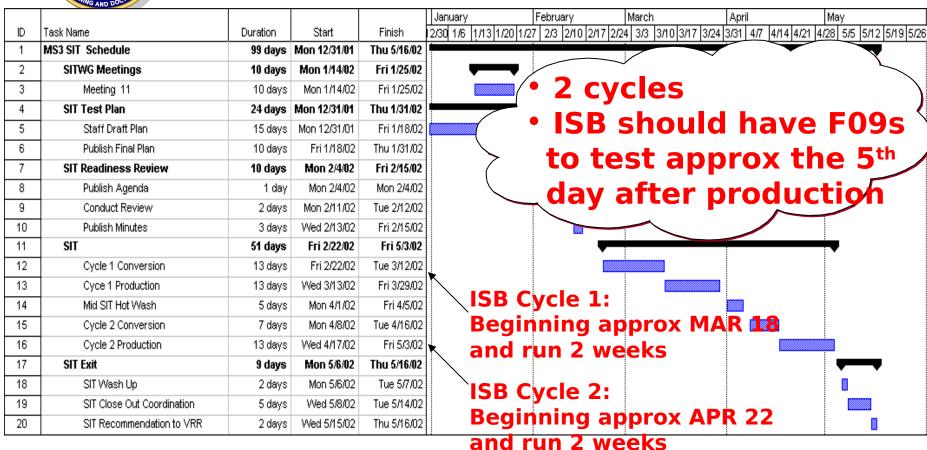

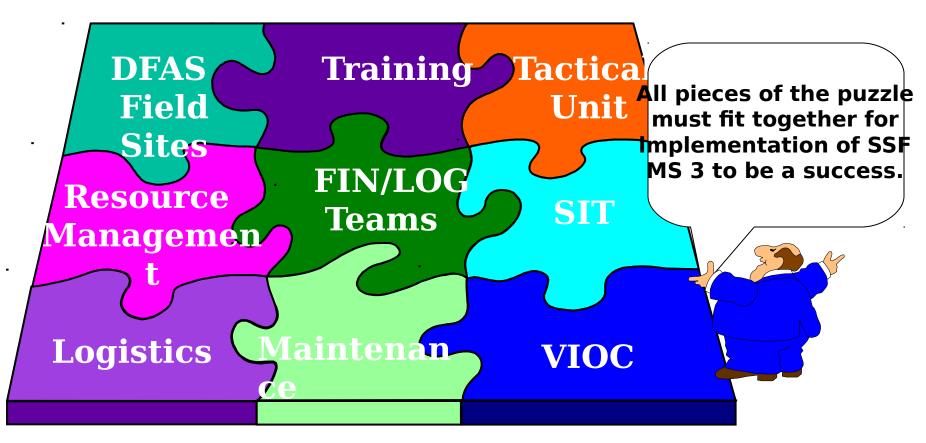

New Policy Credits \$50 or Less

- Write off overdue SSF credits (over 30 days old) as of the the fiscal year (30 Sep 01) with dollar values less than of \$50 per credit extended price.
- Elimination of credit for NIINs with a credit value of \$5
 is being implemented on a phased approach starting this
 - Effective 1 Feb 02, no credit will be granted for NAM
 - -- Not reflected in PB02, ABO to provide MSG.
 - Effective 1 Oct 02 (FY 03), no credit will be granted for
 - -- Reflected in PB03.
