

Leased Government Housing (LGH)

- Effective start date 1 OCT 01
- Program status is “Slow-GO”
 - Continuing Resolution Actions (CRA) is still finally concluded opening funding up in JAN02
 - Rental Facilities Management Information System (RFMIS) training recently completed
 - New online registration means now available for all soldier with internet access

Leased Government Housing (LGH)

- Online application process activated 11 FEB 02
- Routing and approval process is accomplished via the internet through program called LiveLink
- Letter of Instruction (LOI) is being developed by DCSPER/ASCIM.
 - LOI will provide guidance and cover contingencies for the entire process

Leased Government Housing (LGH)

- Recap
 - **DCSED will have 67 leases available FY02**
 - **Most leases will be under \$15,748.00**
 - **If between \$15,748.00 and \$18,373.00 it is considered a HIGH POINT lease.**
 - **DCSED will be final approval authority for the HIGH POINT leases**
 - **DCSED has 17 high point leases which is the maximum number it may have at any given time**

Leased Government Housing (LGH)

- Recap
 - TIE Jackson will have 29 leases
 - TIE McCoy will have 11 leases
 - TIE Sill will have 10 leases
 - TIE Lewis will have 2 leases
 - DCSED will hold 17 leases in reserve

Leased Government Housing (LGH)

- TIE Jackson- 43%
- TIE McCoy- 16%
- TIE Sill-15%
- TIE Lewis- 3%
