ATSC Mission

Serves as the Army's training support manager, planner, researcher, integrator, service provider, and proponent for the Army Training Support System (TSS), including the planning, integration, implementation, and sustainment of those programs, products, and services that support training across all training domains, TRADOC's core missions, and the Army.

➤ **ATSC, through TRADOC, has the following DA executive agent responsibilities for the G3:**

- **Graphic Training Aids (GTA) management**
- **Range modernization and standardization**
- **Integrated Training Area Management (ITAM)**
- **Training Mission Area (TMA)**
- **Army Training Information Management Program (ATIMP)**



Training Support Centers

- **Every installation has a TSC**
- **TSCs are the only organizations authorized to have TADSS**
- **TSC functions like a library**
 - **Distribution shortages - have 1 book to loan to many soldiers**
- **Redistribution & Cross level**
- **Stockage Levels at TSC determined by:**
 - **Changes in Force Structure**
 - **Force Modernization**
 - **MACOM requirements**
 - **Mobilization requirements**
 - **Contingency operations requirements**
- **Working to review POIs for all schools as the basis of TADSS requirements**
