NOTE: Each Corps:

**Responsible for allocating assets for the Air Defense Ambushes.

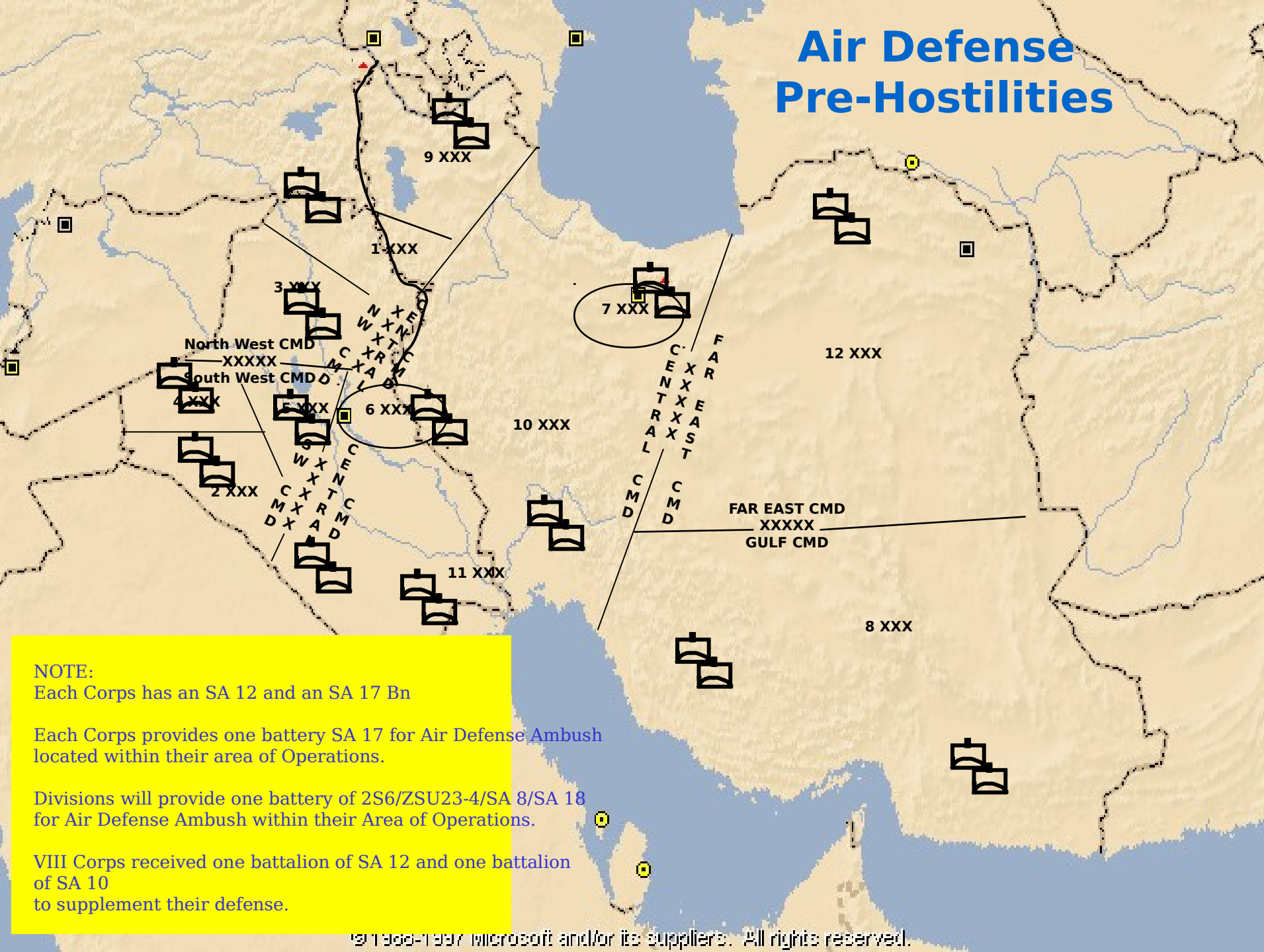
**Pass operational control of Air Defense forces to Air Defense Zone Commander when established.

**Responsible for providing Air Defense of Log Sites, MSRs, Staging and Marshalling Areas during movement of Phase I/Phase II Operations.

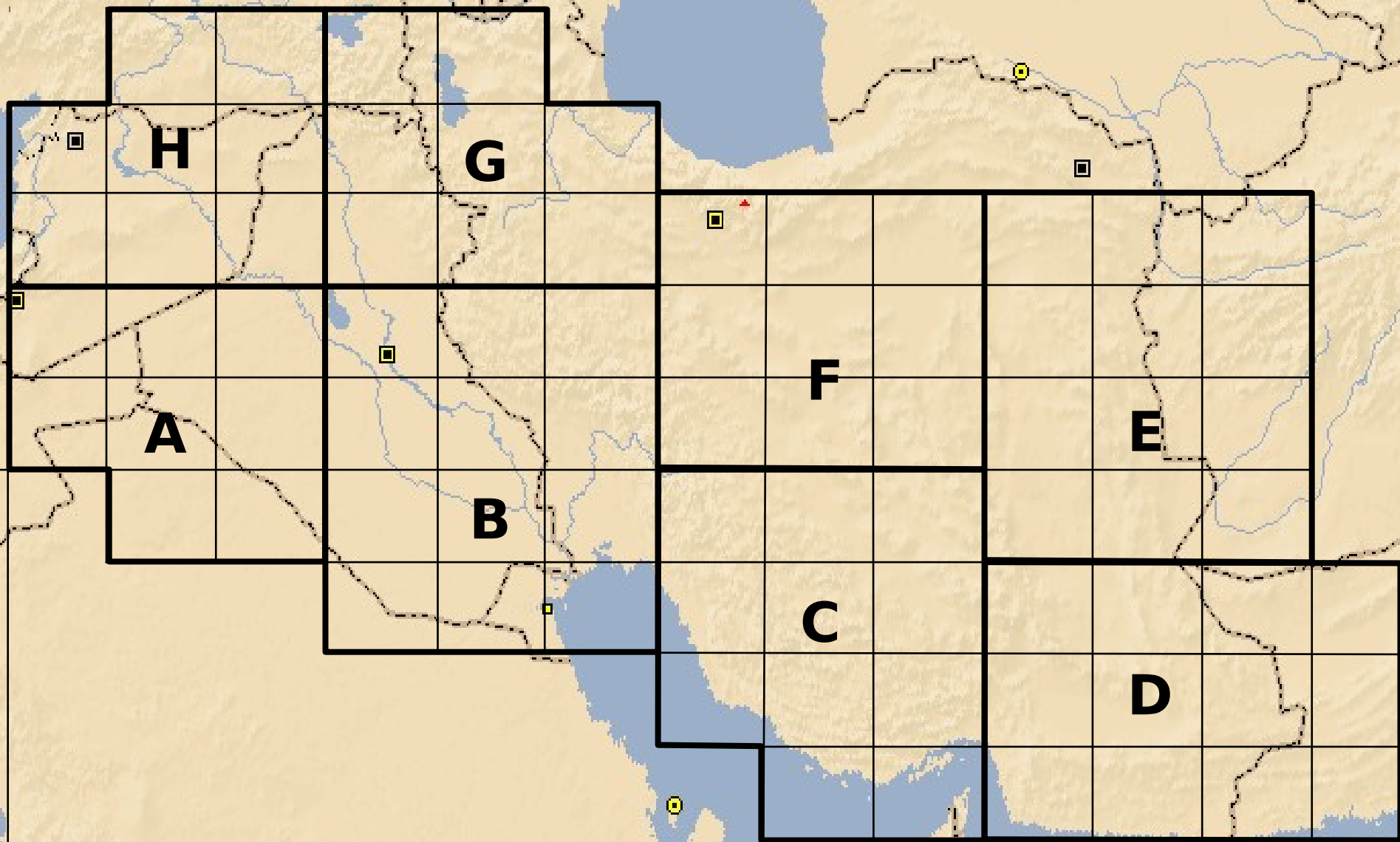
Each Corps has an SA 12 and an SA 17 Bn

Each Corps provides one battery SA 17 for Air Defense Ambush located within their area of Operations.

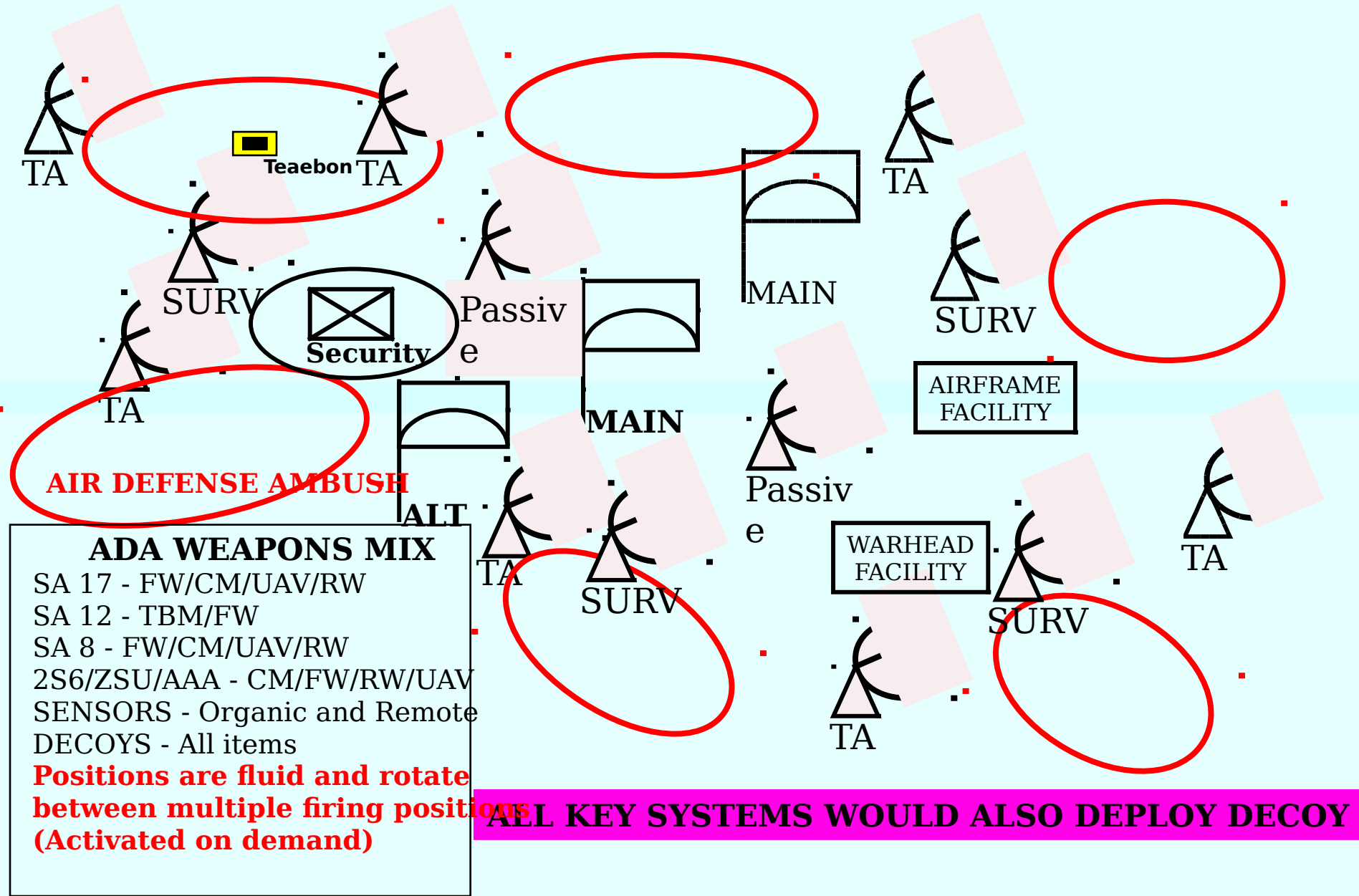
Divisions will provide one battery of 2S6/ZSU23-4/SA 8/SA 18 for Air Defense Ambush within their Area of Operations.

VIII Corps received one battalion of SA 12 and one battalion of SA 10 to supplement their defense.

AIR DEFENSE ZONES & SECTORS



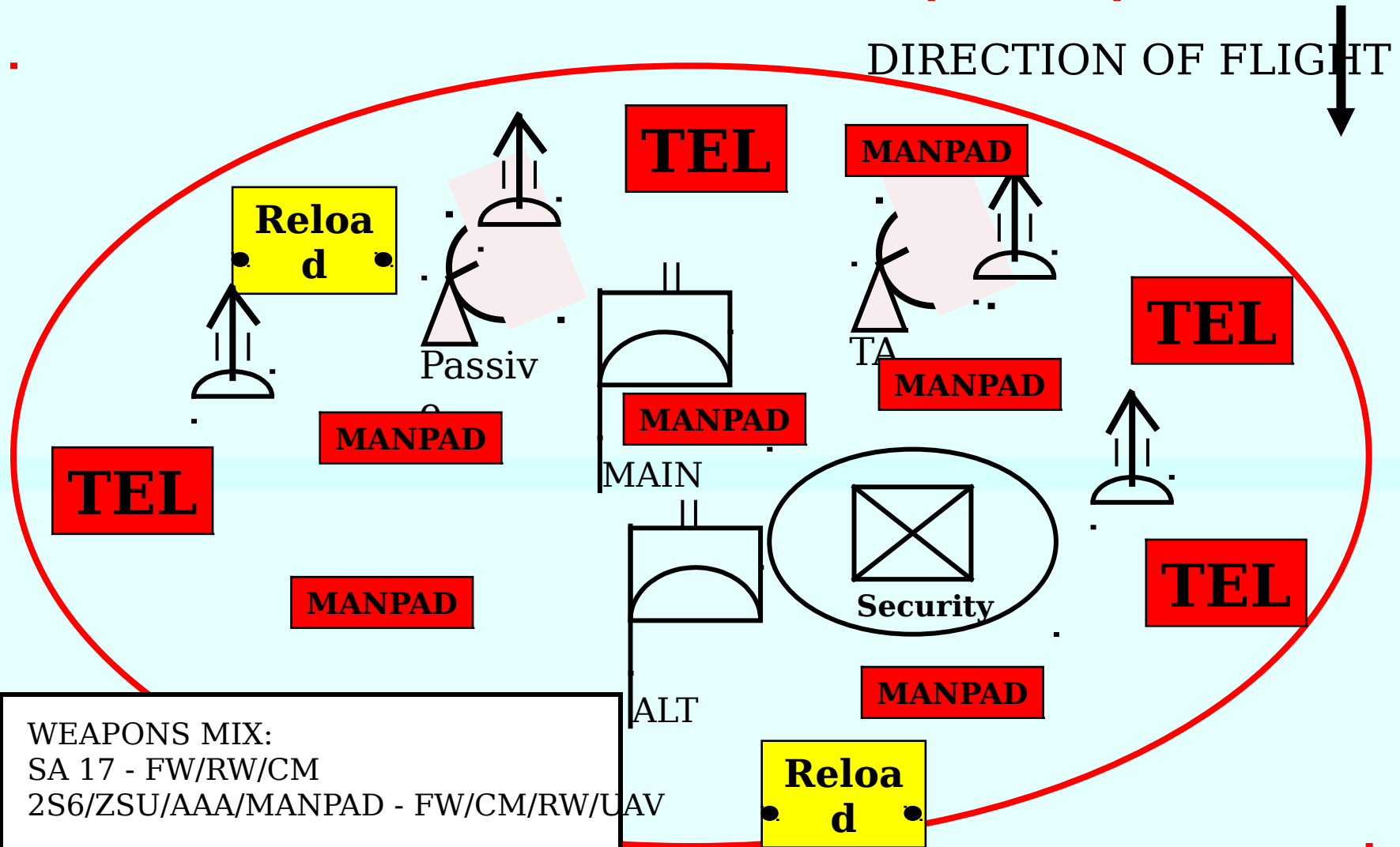
AIR DEFENSE SECTOR (Detail)

WEAPONS MIX:

SA 17 - FW/RW/CM

2S6/ZSU/AAA/MANPAD - FW/CM/RW/UAV

Weapons remain in location for Daylight Period.
Displace to alternate positions by echelon during
periods of darkness/limited visibility. **Able to
maintain continuous AD coverage.**

THREAT AIR DEFENSE EARLY WARNING

- CONUS/Europe-based agent network
- NIR coast watchers
- Elevated Passive/Active Sensors
(Voice of Allah-- Airborne Warning)
- Ground mounted Passive/Active Sensors
- Battery Organic Sensors

All Transmitted by fiber-optic wire (radio as last resort)
