DA Award

- TRADOC set the HQDA SRS Change Window Standard
 - In 2002, the first MACOM to conduct Change Window
 - By 2004, conducted 4 Level 1 and Level 2 Change Windows
- Best Practice MACOM ----
 - Initial SRS Alignment; first to achieve 100% alignment of Strategic Objeton all Level 2 Subordinate Command Scorecards.
 - SRS Initiatives; HQ TRADOC Initiative Process was briefed, taped, and now included in the HQDA SRS Web-Based Training Course.
 - Data Reporting; only MACOM to achieve 100% Data Reporting for 6 consecutive months.

QA Data Reported Via DA SRS Database

- **Measure C3-b:** Percentage of tasks trained to standard as expressed by the superior of the soldiers and leaders six months after completion of training in the institution.
- **Measure P6-a:** Percentage of tasks trained to standard as expressed by the superior of the soldiers, and leaders, six months after completion of training in the institution.
- Measure P7-b: Percentage of tasks trained to standard as expressed by the graduates six months after completion of training in the institution.
- **Measure P7-c:** Percentage of tasks trained to standard as expressed by the superior of the, leaders six months after completion of training in the institution.
- Measure P16-a: % of schools reaching full accreditation (when accreditation starts)
- Measure P16-b: Percentage of courses that have had a self-assessment conducted

New guidance

- Previously emphasis on reporting data
- New emphasis is on the quality of the data reported
- Rather than percentages report hard numbers
 - Number of courses for which school is proponent
 - Number of courses surveyed
 - IMT
 - PMF
 - functional
 - Number of tasks trained in each course
 - Number of tasks soldiers can perform to standard
 - Reported by graduates
 - Reported by supervisors
- TRADOC will sum all data and produce averages for command
