<u>Airport Information</u> - The nearest airport is Baltimore-Washington International (BWI) approximately 40-45 minutes south of APG.

Directions from BWI to Swan Creek Inn on APG - From BWI, take I-195 to I-95N (towards Baltimore). You will go through the Ft. McHenry Tunnel which is a \$1.00 toll. Take the Aberdeen Exit (Exit #85) and take the second right onto Rte 22E.

Rte 22E takes you to the most direct gate at APG. (Closed 2100-0400) Use Rte715 gate, south on Rte 40, for 24 hr access. (see map in concept brief on web page) After passing through the Rte 22 gate, go to the third traffic light and bear to the right. At the next light, turn left onto Aberdeen Blvd. Go to the third
