A - Tehran	Protect C <sup>2</sup>
B - Sanandaj	Protect TBM (1st Bn Shahbiu)
C - Assigned to VIII Corps	

### 2nd SA 10 (FW/CM/RW Defense)

A - Bagdhad	Protect C2 Nodes
B - Al Hillah	Protect TBM (1st Bn Akram)
C - Assigned to VIII Corps	

### 3rs SA 10 (FW/CM/RW Defense)

A - Yazd	Protect TBM (1st Bn Taepo)
B - Kermanshaw	Protect TBM (1st Bn Fakri)
C - Assigned to VIII Corps	

#### NOTE: Each Corps:

\*\*Maintains command of its SA 17 and SA 12 Bns to provide TBM/FW/CM defense of organic assets.

\*\*Responsible for allocating assets for the Air Defense Ambushes.

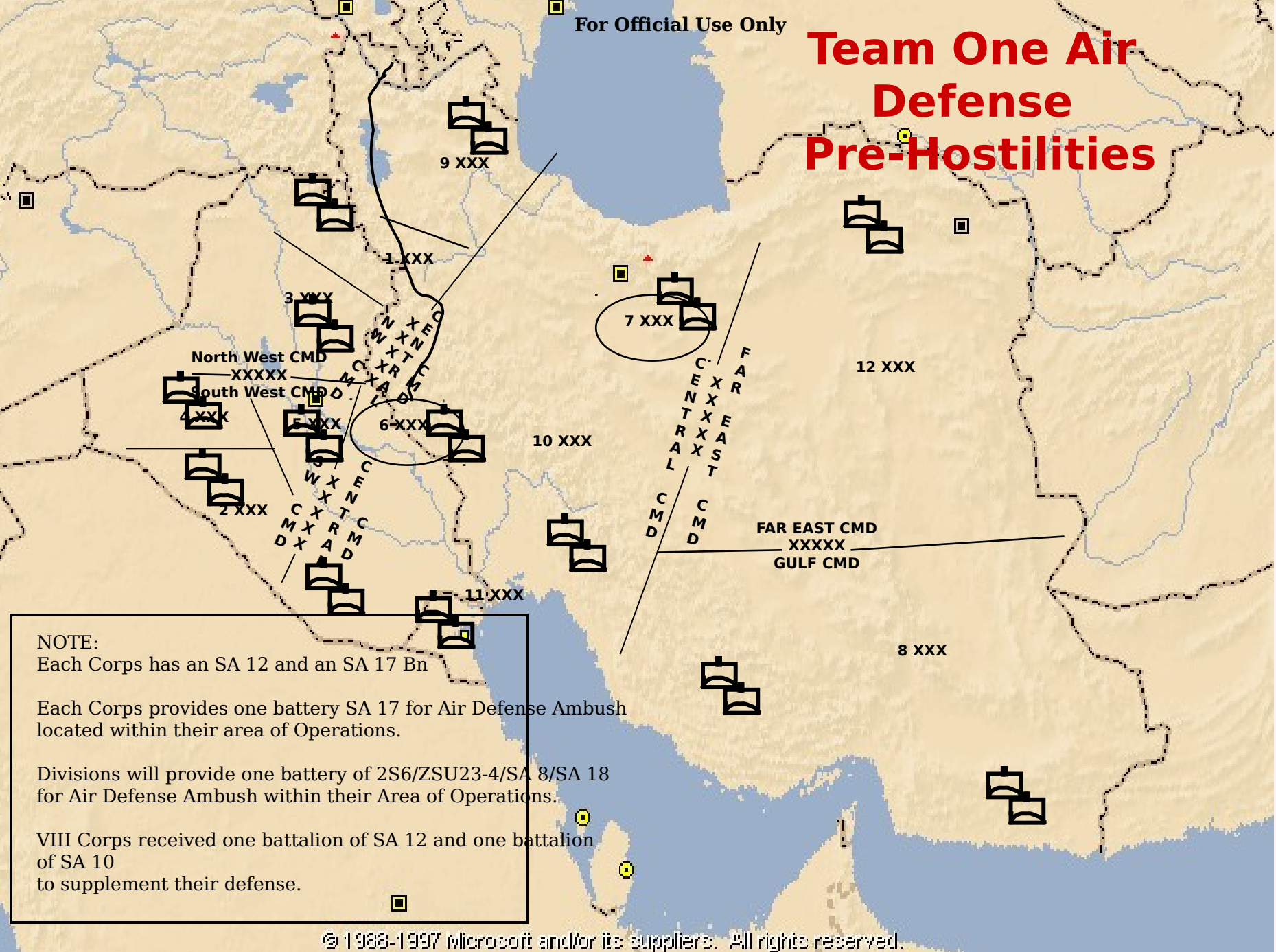
\*\*Pass operational control of Air Defense forces to Air Defense Zone Commander when established.

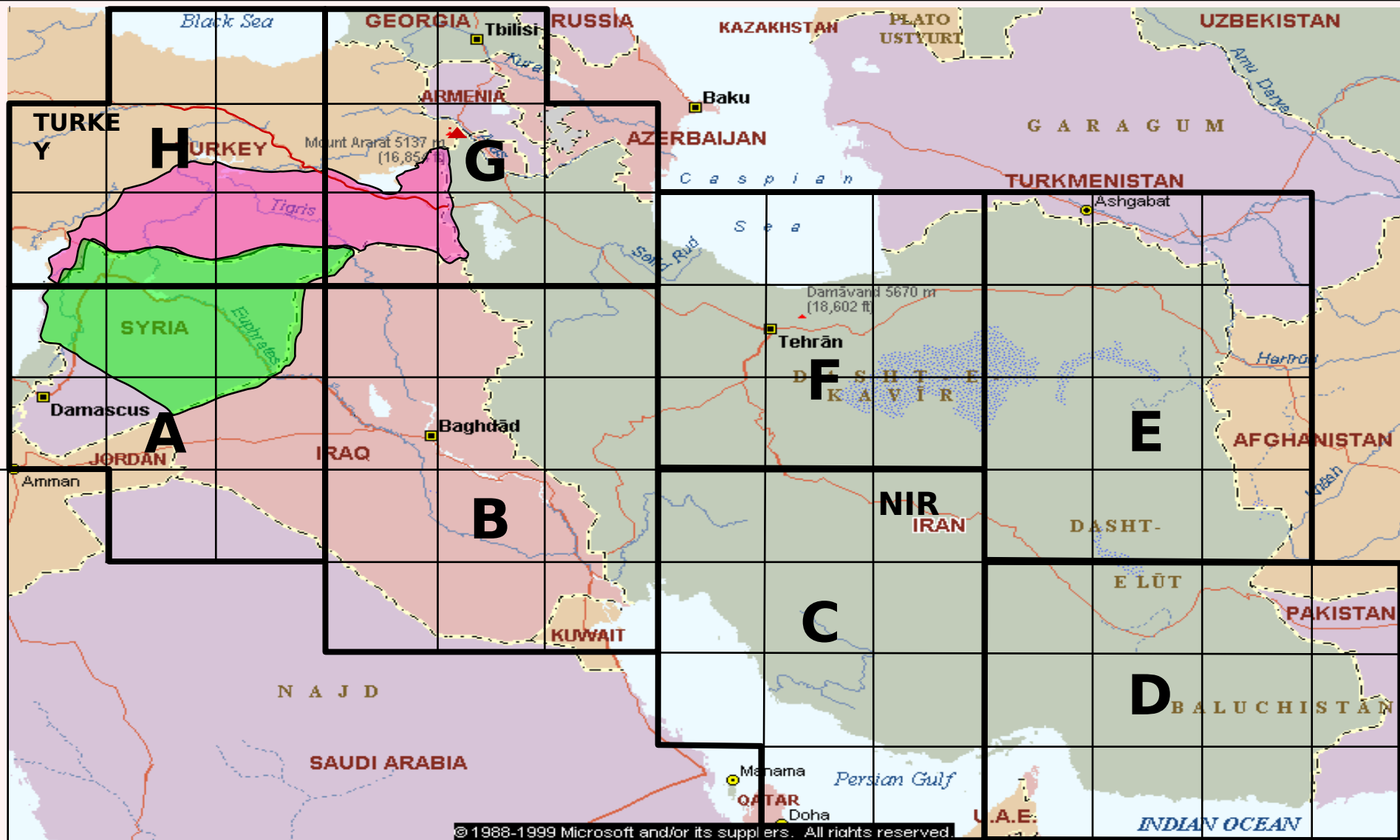

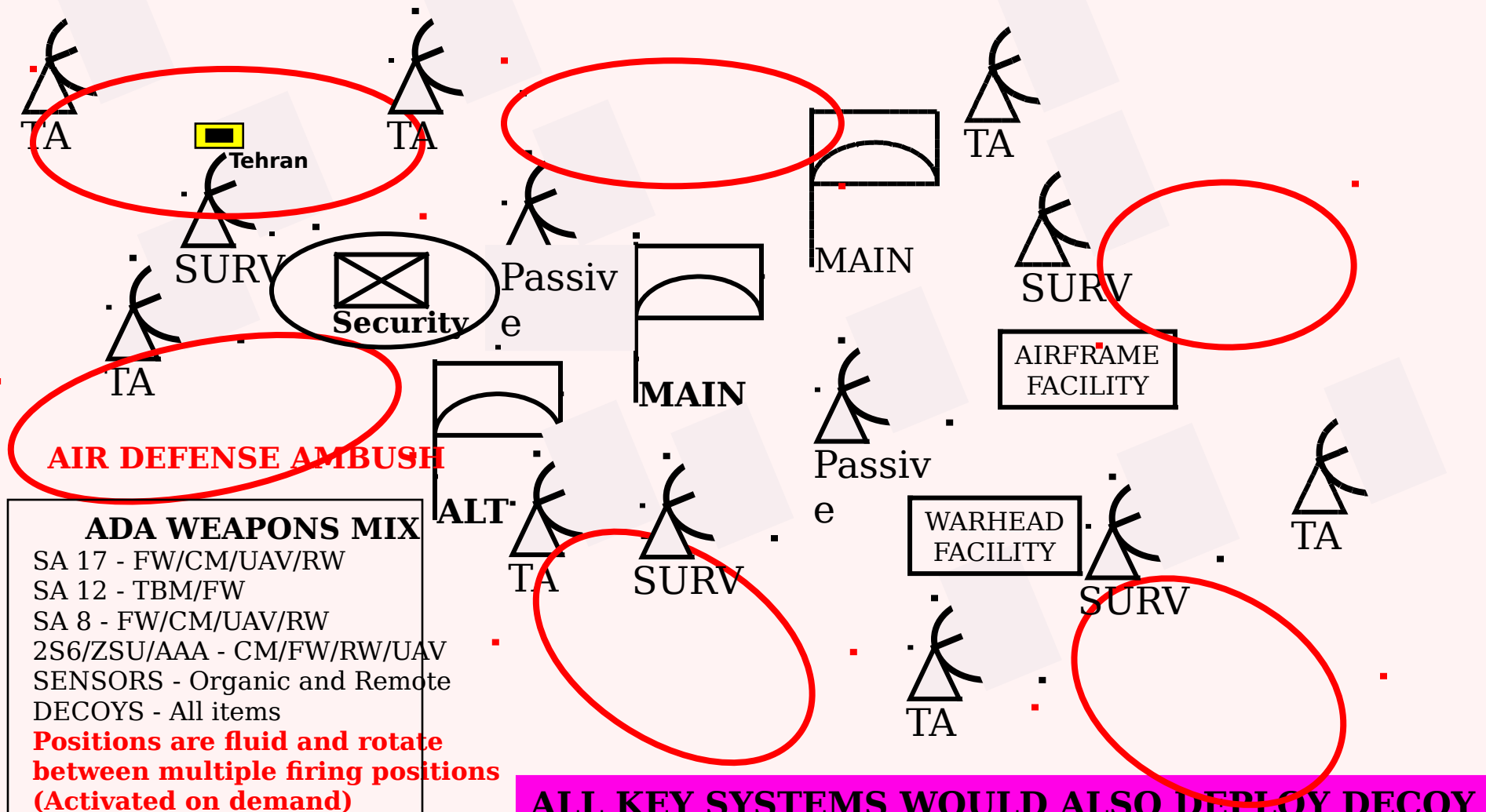

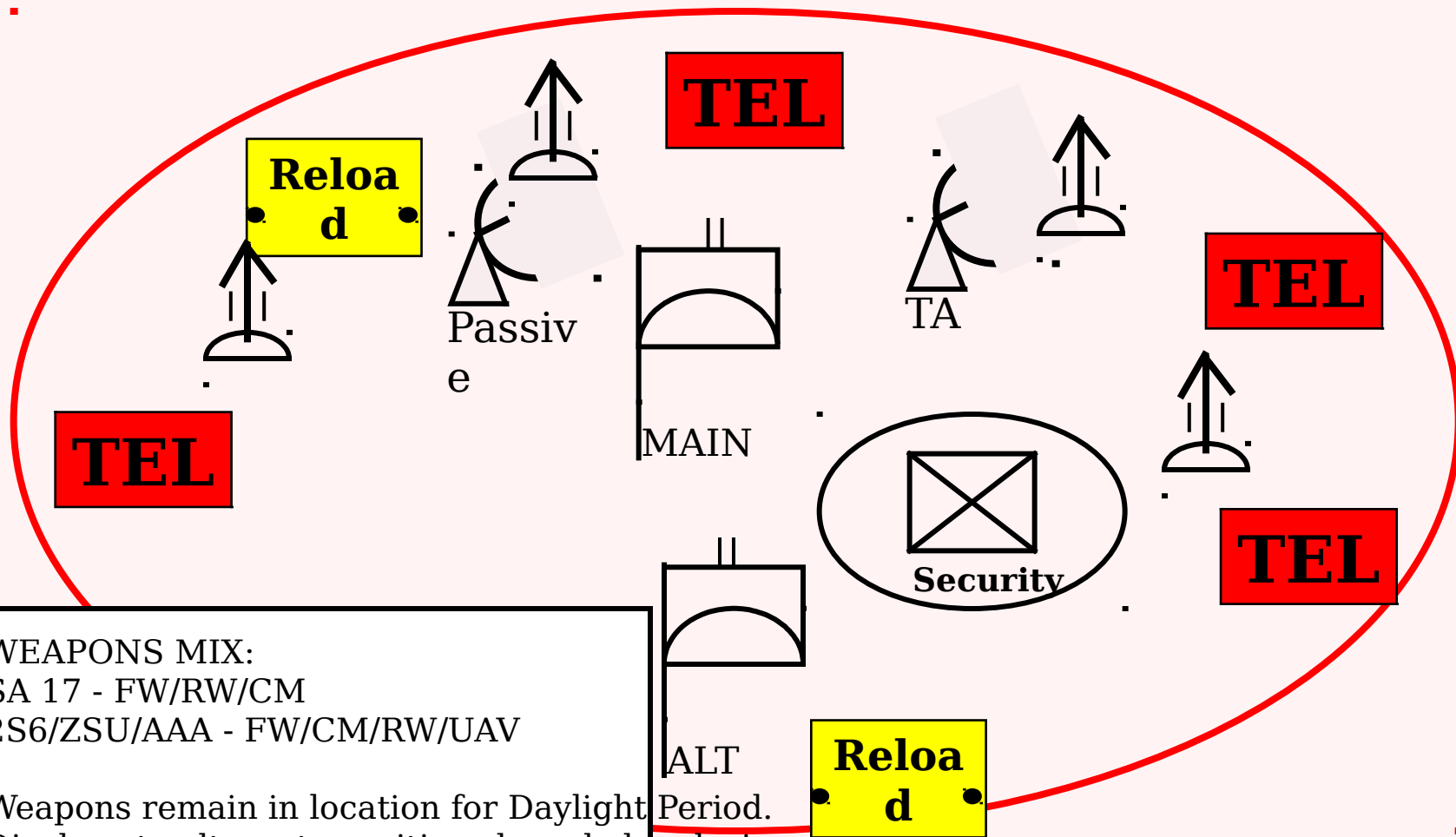

DIRECTION OF FLIGHT  


## WEAPONS MIX:

SA 17 - FW/RW/CM

2S6/ZSU/AAA - FW/CM/RW/UAV

Weapons remain in location for Daylight Period.  
Displace to alternate positions by echelon during  
periods of darkness/limited visibility. **Able to  
maintain continuous AD coverage.**
