**TASK:** Command and Control OPFOR Elements

**CONDITIONS:** During the conduct of a Battle Command Staff Training Exercise using any of the FAMSIM systems in conjunction with a standard scenario and training objectives of the Exercised Unit.

**TASK STANDARDS:** Portray a capabilities based OPFOR. Utilize current OPFOR doctrine, tactics, organization, equipment and operational art. Provide a realistic, versatile, and challenging, uncooperative sparring partner representative, but not predictive of actual threats.

### **TASK STEPS AND PERFORMANCE MEASURES:**

- 1) Effectively manage forces in combat.
  - a) Apply measures to represent a systematical and scientific approach to staff planning and decision-making processes.
  - b) Obtain maximum combat effectiveness of all resources in order to fully exploit the combat situation.
  - c) On a continuous basis, receive, collect, study, report, and analyze information
  - d) Make decisions regarding on-going operations.
  - e) Issue missions to subordinate forces.
  - f) Organize and conduct control activities using normative planning.



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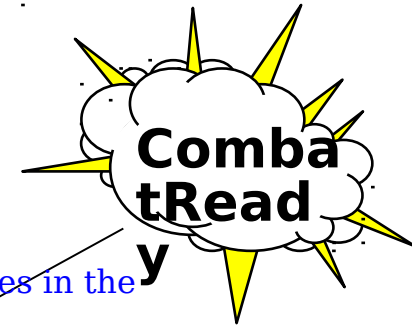
