- -- Doctrine is virtually there but will undergo minor changes during implementation.
- -- Units and Training Centers require additional training.
- -- COE requires Division/Brigade Commander "buy-in" to properly execute.



# Conference Expectation

- Defining COE Implementation
- -- The basic tenets of implementation have been defined.
- -- CTCs are prepared for near-term initial implementation
- -- Additional training is required, especially for Operations Groups and Training Support Divisions
- -- Full implementation will be a long-term process
  - HICON/ Infrastructure
  - OPFOR material



### Conference Expectation

#### CTC OPFOR Organizations

- -- Current CTC Order of Battle (revised) will implement near term COE requirements with DCSINT approval
- -- Basic organizations defined (by DCSINT) for the future CTC force must have ability to replicate the desired effects.
- -- Identifying the materiel requirements to meet the capability replication requirements
- -- Always resource constrained must establish priority systems/requirements



#### The Road Ahead

- Synchronize implementation across the training domain
  - -- TRADOC Institutions
  - -- Home Station
  - -- USAR/ARNG
- Requirements development
  - -- Doctrinal Compliant
  - -- CTC specific
  - -- Meets the intent of the CTC-MP
- •Continue assistance/assessment visits and begin accreditation visits
