TRADOC Reg 1-8 Operations Reporting

- Prescribes policy and procedures for reporting significant incidents to HQ TRADOC
 - Reporting requirements are more stringent than the DA SIR requireme
 - Installations report OPREPs immediately once informed of an incident
 - Follow up e-mail required of the installation within two hour of initial notification to the TRADOC IOC

AR 190-40 Serious Incident Report

- Prescribes policy and procedures for reporting serious incidents within DA
 - <u>CAT 1</u> requires telephonic notification by the installation immediately and a msg within 12 hours (after finding out about the incident)
 - <u>CAT 2</u> requires message notification by the installation within 24 hours (after finding out about the incident)



Internal TRADOC Reporting

URGENT

- Death of a Soldier while Training
- Aircraft Accident
- Suicides
- FPCON Change
- Explosions/Fire on an Installation causing significant damage or injury
- Terrorist Incident
- Arrest of Senior Officer or Senior NCO

NON URGENT

- Death non training related
- Life threatening training injuries
- Family member deaths (unusual circumstances such as criminal related
- Serious Domestic Violence
- Trainee Abuse or Drill Sergeant Misconduct
- Minor Fire/damage to installation



The Process

TRADOC Watch Team

- Receives initial notification from installation/school
- Conducts analysis of information
- Determines notification requirements
- Team chief
 - Verifies watch team analysis
 - Conducts staff notifications
 - Notifies the AOC if OPREP meets AR 190-40 requirement



TRADOC soldier training deaths require additional informable forwarded by the installation – covered in TR 1-8 (Operations Reporting)
