Preparing Cables

- As an part of the first phases of Cisco labs, students are shown the proper technique for slicing, organizing and crimping CAT-5E cabling.

- The cable is then checked with a multi-check cable tester.
- These CAT-5E cables will be used to connect Cisco routers to student computers.

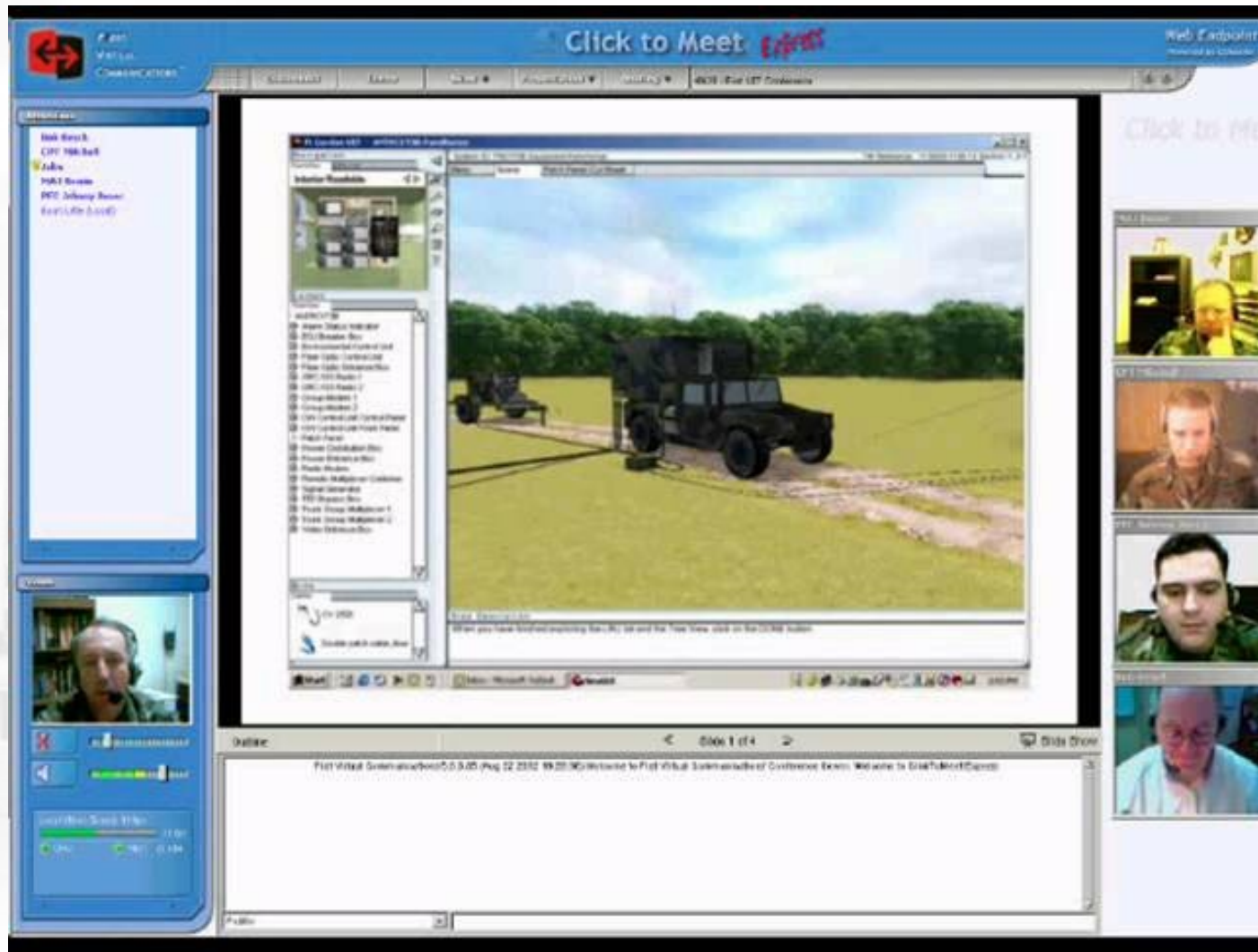

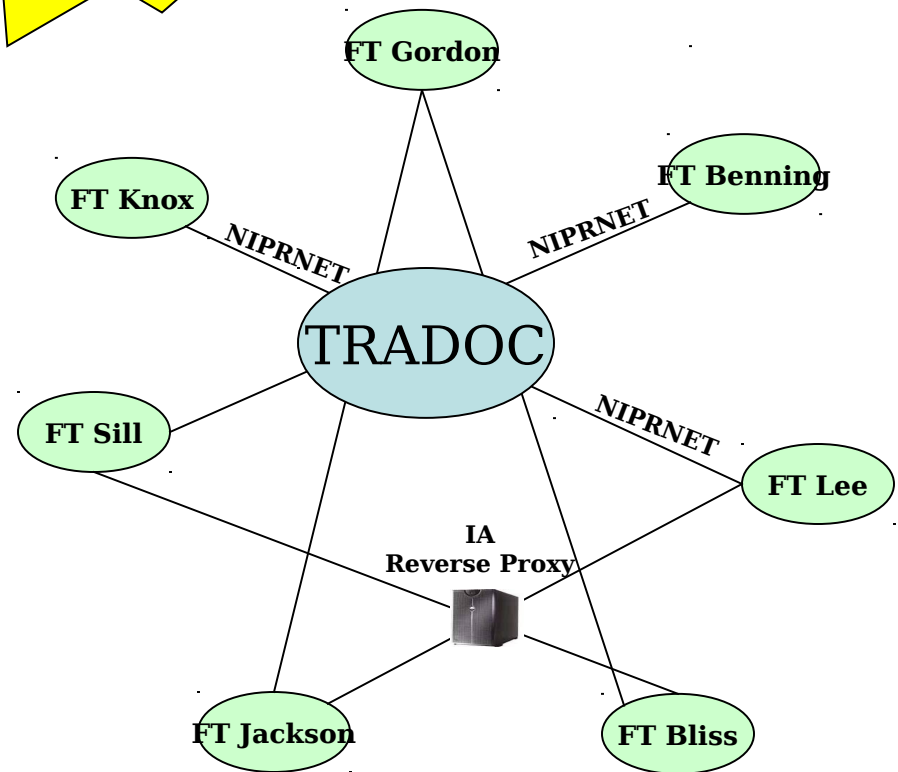

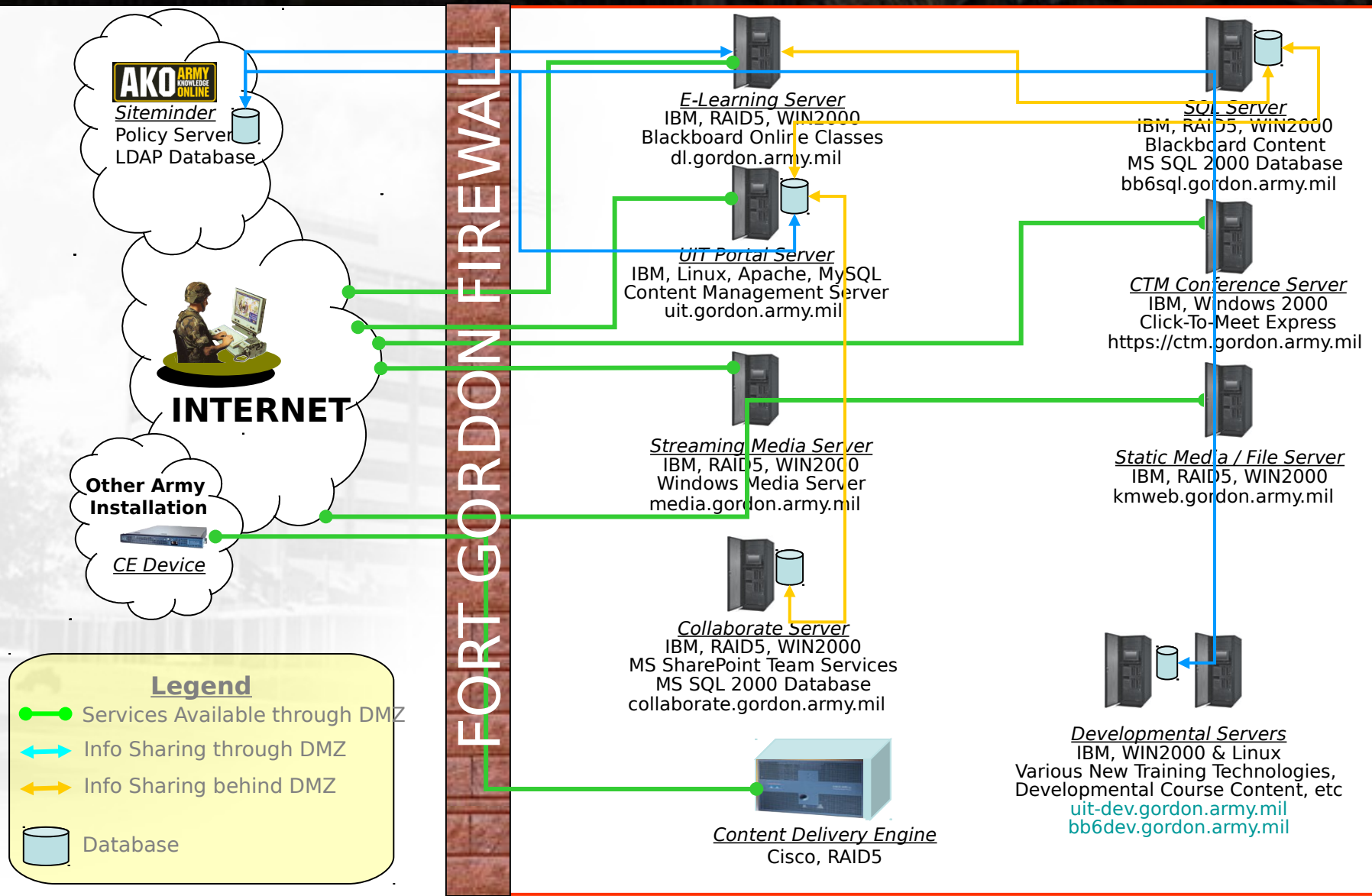
Advantages of a Proponent Lifelong Learning Center

*One hour NIPRNET
downtime for 2000 resident
students = 2000 hours
of training downtime*

- Resident training supported with content on the Installation Community Area Network (ICAN)
 - Avoids NIPRNET downtimes
 - Avoids IA related downtimes
- Local support for the system through the Help Desk
- Each TRADOC Installation Resource Center is tailored to the training requirements
