GENERAL TRENDS

ISSUES AND CONCERNS THAT WERE COMMON ACROSS MULTIPLE CMFs

MULTI-YEAR POI

(1 of 2)

- Impacts
 - Decreases Readiness students in training pipeline longer
 - Increases instructor funding requirements
 - Increases student funding requirements
 - Increases TDA structure requirements
- Scope
 - All proponents for NCOES
 - 7 of 16 proponents examined for RECLAS



MULTI-YEAR POI

(2 of 2)

- COA 1 HQDA G-3 fund multi-ADT years (instructors & students) SMDR Solution
 - limited to TPU/M-day soldier availability
- COA 2 HQDA G-1 accepts 50% DMOSQ throughput
- COA 3 Proponent develop single year solutions/POIs Preferred

INCREMENTAL

CHANGES OF POIs

- Multiple incremental changes at or below 30% results in POIs evolving beyond funded design.
- Impacts:
 - RC version of MOS
 - Unfunded resource requirement
 - Accreditation issues
- Recommendation
 - TRADOC further limit the allowable POI changes
 - Errata sheets are approved by and distributed through TOMA



NATIONAL TRAINING OORDINATION

ATRRS ACCESS MANAGEMENT

(1 of 2)

- Issue: RC3 Courses and TATS-Courses listed for same Reclassification Program
- Impacts
 - Quota management confusion
 - Inappropriate Requirements in TACITS
 - Dual tracking of classes schools/students



ATRRS ACCESS MANAGEMENT

(2 of 2)

- Issue: NGB & USARC have limited access to critical ATRRS management functions
- Impacts
 - G-1 has to do all work at the quota and requirement level for any course/phase changes
 - NGB & USARC have the responsibility without the authority
- Solution G-1 will set date and host workshop, JUL/AUG time frame, to clean ATRRS. G-1, TOMA, NGB & USARC

2093ACK OF DL EMPHASIS

(1 of 2)

- No consistent DL strategy among proponents
- Proponent reversal of DL strategy
- Inconsistent phased programming
 - IDT phase
 - Pre-requisite phase
 - component of other phase

2003 ACK OF DL EMPHASIS

(2 of 2)

Impacts

- Dis-incentive for proponents to develop DL courseware
- 0 resources against DL phased class
- student pay/credit for participation

Solutions

- TRADOC driven comprehensive training development review for DL program integration where appropriate
- IDT phase strategy matching resources to DL delivered phases

TAFFING CONTINUITY WITH TOMA

(1 of 2)

- Proponent changes without coordination with TOMA
 - POI changes/errata sheets
 - Force structure changes
- Impacts
 - School house resource changes
 - Accreditation resource battles
 - Major CMF change without MOCS
 - PM and DAMPL problems

TAFFING CONTINUITY WITH TOMA

(2 of 2)

- Solution
 - DCST management of proponent issued changes
 - Timely and consistent push-back by NGB and USARC of proponent changes that affect resourcing

SSUE- Proponent Level

- Course/MOS: 11B
- Issue: Consolidation of 11H and 11M into 11B
- Discussion:
 - No consolidated 11B10 POI
- Position (Single RC): Requirements will be placed against 11H and 11M through FY06
- Resolution
 - USAIS will submit a consolidated 11B TATS program
 - Update 11B consolidation MOCS to include ASI strategy for mechanized and anti-armor infantrymen
 - Host a conference to resolve critical task selection and CMF career path issues

SSUE- Proponent Level

- Course: 21M10 Reclassification Course
- Issue: No reserve component course
- Discussion:
 - AF is the DOD executive agent
 - Taught as a 13 week resident course only
 - Army MTOE firefighter requirements not necessarily identical to AF
 - AF reluctant to adapt/develop and Army specific course
- Position (Single RC): Program Reclass against a 13week resident course
- Resolution: RC SMEs in conjunction with EN School develop the Army training strategy

SSUE- Proponent Level

- Course: 21N40 P2 TATS Course
- Issue: Multi-Phase POI
- Discussion:
 - P2 is 4 day IDT, P3 is 9 day ADT plus 24 hour FTX
- Position (Single RC): Program all phases at SMDR while supporting field recommendation for phase consolidation
- Resolution: USARC to request and proponent to approve change consolidation to a single phase ADT course.
