



FY05 LLC CoC Priorities

- Integrate Blackboard with ALMS
- Resolve Architecture issues:
 - Determine streaming video hosting site
- Deliver guidance on the suite of tools for LLC collaboration to include the Sharepoint architecture
 - Document the operational requirements of an LLC
 - Determine authentication/authorization process
- Collaborate with AKO/PEO-EIS to resolve access by foreign and international students
 - Determine LLC access through enterprise directory services
 - Determine centralized policy server locations
 - Conduct monthly architecture working group VTC, starting late Jul 05

FY05 LLC CoC Priorities

- Resolve metrics issues:
- Evaluate ARI study of Communities of Practice for LLC performance metric development
 - Develop metrics/use cases
 - Conduct metrics workshop, following commercial metrics conference
- Finalize LLC operational capability at Fort Leonard Wood MANSCEN and Fort Leavenworth CGSC to include uploading content
- Issue guidance to "other schools" on the LLC Pilot process
- Identify meta-tagging elements
- Include as LLC team member a Senior NCO provided by ATSC
- Complete LLC contract
- Develop standard template for document meta-data

Attain LLC initial Operational Capability (IOC) 1 Oct 06

The LLC attains IOC when:

- Web portal, professional forums, and online training content/courseware are tested and deployed
- Collaborative tools are selected, approved, and implemented
- IT personnel staffed to support LLC functions
- Hardware & software are operational

Attain LLC Full Operational Capability (FOC) 1 Oct

Upon attaining FOC the LLC:


- Offers a robust web portal for entry into the school LLC
- Provides student management capability
- Provides a functional support desk, and integrates with the Army Learning Management System (ALMS)
- Supports the individual pilot school objectives for training and education, using approved toolkit of collaborative tools and services
- Supports Assignment Oriented Training/Lifelong Learning (AOT/LLL) training and education strategy
- Distributes web-based simulations/content/courseware
